THE ATHENIAN LEAGUE: A SHORT HISTORY -1945-1966

The League resumed after the war, season 1945/46, without any changes in the fourteen club membership from the incomplete 1939/40 season, the two newcomers for that season, Finchley and Hitchin Town starting in a new League for the second time. After the first season, when Sutton United won their second championship, Golders Green changed their name to Hendon.

It was four seasons before there were any changes in League membership.

The F.A. Amateur Cup restarted in September 1945 and the Athenian League supplied the trophy's first post war winner, Barnet beating Bishop Auckland 3-2 at Stamford Bridge in front of a crowd of 53,832 in the final. The holders were eliminated at the semi-final stage the next season, going down to Leytonstone, the eventual winners, at Brentford. These two clubs were up against one another in the 1948 final, the Isthmian leaguers retaining the Cup winning 1-0, again at Stamford Bridge, where the attendance was 59,605.

While there had been few Athenian League clubs to rival Barnet in the Amateur Cup, it was two other Athenians who had the honour of taking part in the first Amateur Cup final at Wembley, Bromley and Romford. Bromley won the 1949 competition with the game's only goal in a match seen by 93,000. The next season both the previous season's finalists went out in the Second Round. It was left to Barking to carry the League's name into the latter stages and in the semi-final they lost 2-1 to eventual winners Northern League Willington at Middlesbrough. Meanwhile Finchley had reached the last eight.

The 1950/51 season saw an increase in membership to sixteen clubs with the addition of Walton & Hersham and Cambridge Town.

WALTON & HERSHAM were founder members of the Corinthian League in the 1945/46 season when they had finished seventh. They had won that League's championship in each of the next three seasons and came to the Athenian as league runners-up behind Hounslow Town. The club had been formed in 1945 on the amalgamation of Walton (1896) and Hersham (1926), both pre-war members of the Surrey Senior League and due to take part in the 1939/40 London League campaign.

CAMBRIDGE TOWN emerged from an older team, Cambridge St. Mary, in September 1908 and played in local soccer before moving to the Southern Amateur League then the Spartan League. They had been Spartan League Premier champions in three of the post war seasons and Eastern Division champions in another. In April 1951 the King bestowed the title of City upon the town and the football club changed its name to Cambridge City.

Third placed in 1951/52 Bromley, and 10th placed Barking were the first post war departures, moving to the Isthmian League in 1952. They were not replaced.

Hendon and Bromley, were the League's most successful clubs in the 1950/51 Amateur Cup competition, both reaching the semis. There Bromley fell to Northern League Bishop Auckland 3-2 at Leeds, while Hendon took eventual winners Pegasus, to a replay losing 3-2 despite being ahead twice. The next season Leyton went all the way from the Preliminary Round to Wembley, beating Wembley, Harrow Town, Bata Sports, Eton Manor, Uxbridge, Cambridge City, Oxford City, Dulwich Hamlet, Briggs Sports, and in the Semi-Final at Tottenham, Barnet 2-1. Walton & Hersham also reached the semi-final but were beaten 3-0 at Fulham by Walthamstow Avenue. 100,000 saw the Isthmian Leaguers win the final at Wembley 2-1, the game being the first Amateur Cup final there to go to extra time.

HOUNSLOW TOWN made the move from the Corinthian League in 1955, a competition they had joined for its second season. Three times champions, including 1954/55, they had also been runners-up three times in their nine seasons' membership. Founded in 1884, they had been Spartan League Divisional champions in 1946 having been pre-war members of that League.

The addition of Hounslow Town brought the numbers up to 15 and the following season, 1956/57, that number was retained but with Tooting & Mitcham, who left for the Isthmian League, being replaced with another Corinthian League side, CARSHALTON ATHLETIC

The Surrey club had also joined the Corinthian League in its second season. In their ten seasons they had been champions twice, in 1953 and 1954, but had finished 8th in their final season. Formed in 1905 on the amalgamation of Mill Lane Mission (1903) and Carshalton St. Andrews (1897), they had been Surrey Senior League founder members in 1922 but had spent all but that first season in the London League.

The 1952/53 Amateur Cup competition saw Walton & Hersham and Southall as losing semi-finalists, the former going down 3-1 at Brentford against Harwich & Parkeston and the latter taking Pegasus to a replay but losing 2-1 at Fulham. Hounslow who had the misfortune of meeting Crook Town at their best and being hammered 10-1.

Hendon reached their first Amateur Cup final the next season but lost 2-0 in front of 100,000 at Wembley to Bishop Auckland. Hendon had beaten Hounslow 2-1 in the semi-final at Tottenham. In 1955/56 three Athenian League sides, Hitchin, Tooting & Mitcham and Finchley all reached the last eight but were all knocked out. Hayes were losing semi-finalists in 1957, going down 2-0 to Bishop Auckland at Newcastle.

In 1957 the League's numbers were brought up to 16 again with the addition of MAIDSTONE UNITED, Corinthian Leaguers since 1950/51. Champions in 1956, they had finished 5th in their final season. Founded in 1897 and semi-professionals for a period, they had been Kent League members before the war and after when they re-formed as an amateur club.

Cambridge City turned professional the next season, entering the Southern League. They were replaced by GRAYS ATHLETIC, a founder member and the first champions of the Corinthian League, who had been formed in 1906 on the disbandment of Grays United. They had been members of the London League between the wars and were 3rd in the Corinthian League in their final season.

Maidstone made the move to the Isthmian League after only two seasons and for the 1959/60 season were replaced by HORNCHURCH, the first club to join direct from the Delphian League. The Essex club owed their roots to Upminster (founded in 1923) and had formerly been members of the Spartan League until joining the Delphian League in its second season, 1952/53.

Barnet were losing semi-finalists in the Amateur Cup in 1958, losing 3-2 at Brentford to eventual winners Woking. The following season, however, they got to Wembley but, in front of a 60,000 crowd, lost 3-2 to Crook Town. The 1959/60 final saw Hendon win the competition for the first time, coming from behind to beat Kingstonian 2-1 at Wembley in front of 60,000. Hendon had beaten Enfield 2-0 at Brentford in the semi-final.

Hitchin Town were a losing Amateur Cup semi-finalist in 1960, going down 1-0 to eventual winners Walthamstow Avenue at London's White City. Hounslow were losing finalists the next year, a crowd of 43,000 seeing a 1-1 draw at Wembley with 18,279 at the Ayresome Park replay won by Crook Town 4-0. Sutton were losing finalists in 1963 going down 4-2 against Wimbledon in the Wembley final attended by 45,000.

At the end of the 1962/63 season the Athenian League underwent massive change. Four clubs, Enfield (1st), Sutton United (4th), Hitchin Town (5th) and Hendon (7th) all went to the Isthmian League. The League absorbed the Corinthian and Delphian Leagues and reorganised into three divisions, the Premier, First and Second Divisions.

The top Division operated with 14 clubs, with Dagenham, 4th in the Corinthian League, and Maidenhead United, 7th in that competition, being the new clubs. DAGENHAM were relative newcomers, moving from the Delphian League, of which they had been founder members, in 1957. Founded in 1949 they had been founder members of the Metropolitan and District League and its champions in 1951. They also had a Corinthian League championship to their name. MAIDENHEAD UNITED had been Corinthian League founder members and had been champions three times. Founded in 1869 they had been early members of the Southern League and between the wars prominent Spartan League members.

Division One was made up of the remaining Corinthian League sides.

LEATHERHEAD, champions in the League's final season went on to win the new Division's first championship. They were formed in 1946 on the amalgamation of Leatherhead Rose and Leatherhead United and had been Delphian League founder members in 1951. They had finished 4th in the first season, a position never bettered, yet moved to the Corinthian League in 1958 where they finished in the bottom half of the table each season until the competition's last.

ERITH & BELVEDERE, runners-up in the League's final season, were League founder members but had never won the championship. The club emerged from the Belvedere & District team in 1922 and in the inter-war period had twice been F.A. Amateur Cup runners-up and member of the London and Kent Leagues.

WOKINGHAM TOWN, 3rd in the final season, were relatively new to the League, having joined from the Delphian League in 1959. They had been Delphians for just two seasons, prior to that being members of the Metropolitan League. They had been formed in 1875 and, although they rarely achieved a great deal, in their first Delphian season, 1957/58, reached the last eight of the F.A. Amateur Cup, the farthest a club from the League had reached, a feat all the more noteworthy as they had come through the Qualifying Competition.

UXBRIDGE had joined the League from the London League in its second season, were champions in 1959/60, and finished 5th in the final league table. They had been F.A. Cup participants in the 1870's and had been F.A. Amateur Cup runners-up and Southern League members before the turn of the century.

LETCHWORTH TOWN, who had finished 6th, had spent four seasons in the competition they won in their second season, 1957/58. Founded in 1906 shortly after the Garden City itself, Letchworth had previously been members of the Spartan League.

SLOUGH TOWN, 8th in the last season, had been League founder members and, in 1950/51, champions. They had emerged during the war when Slough Centre amalgamated with Slough F.C. The Centre club had later split away again.

CHESHAM UNITED joined the League in 1947 and spent most of the time in mid-table or lower. They did, however, finish as runners-up in 1961 and 1962, but were down at 9th in the competition's final season. Formed on the amalgamation of Chesham Town (1879) and Chesham Generals (1887) in 1919, they were formerly champions of the Spartan League.

WORTHING, 10th in the final season, joined the league in 1948, but 7th was their highest ever finishing place, this being achieved in 1961. They had been formed in 1886 and been strengthened in 1900 on the coming together of several local clubs. They were formerly Sussex Senior League members with several championships to their credit.

DORKING were 11th in the last season, 3rd having been their best ever finish. They joined the Corinthian League as Surrey Senior League champions in 1956, the club dating from the 1880's.

HORSHAM, 12th in the final season, had joined from the Metropolitan League in 1957 where, in their final season, they had finished bottom. They were founded in the 1880's and had been Sussex Senior League winners seven times. Their highest finishing placing in the Corinthian League was 3rd.

EDGWARE TOWN, 13th in the final season, had been founder members and first champions of the Middlesex Senior League in 1939/40 and were London League Western Section champions in 1946.

EASTBOURNE, 14th in the final season had been League members since 1946 but had never finished above 7th, a placing achieved twice. They had been A.F.A. members since its foundation in 1907.

EPSOM & EWELL, 15th and one off the bottom in the final season, had joined the League as Epsom (and not connected with an earlier Corinthian League side Epsom Town) in 1949. 3rd was their highest finishing position, achieved in 1952/53. They had been founded originally as Epsom Town in 1917. The club had become Epsom & Ewell in 1960/61.

Bottom club **WEMBLEY** had been League members since 1956/57. They were 4th in 1958/59, but had finished bottom twice. They had been formed in 1946 on the amalgamation of junior clubs Sudbury R.P.A. and Sudbury Rangers. From the Spartan League, they had been Delphian League founder members, a competition of which they were runners-up in 1955/56

The new Division Two of the Athenian League was made up of the 1962/63 Delphian League membership. The conventional championship had been abandoned in the March when only partially completed because of the fixture backlog caused by weather conditions. An emergency competition split into Western and Eastern sections was run instead.

Edmonton won the emergency competition. As Western Section champions they beat Hertford Town, Eastern Division champions, 5-2 over two legs. Hertford were top of the League table when it was stopped and were followed by Bishop's Stortford, Aveley and Stevenage Town. Windsor & Eton were Western Section runners-up followed by Berkhamsted, while Stortford were Eastern Section runners-up being followed by Harlow Town.

Of the sixteen Delphian clubs at the beginning of the 1962/63 only one, Stevenage, did not become Athenian League members in 1963/64.

EDMONTON joined the League in 1955 as Tufnell Park Edmonton from the Spartan League. The club had been formed as Tufnell Park in 1907 and had amalgamated with Edmonton Borough in 1950. They had been Isthmian League members until 1952.

HERTFORD TOWN had only joined the league in 1959. Founded in 1908, they joined the Spartan League from the Herts County League in 1921. League runners-up in 1960, they were champions in 1961 and 1962.

BISHOP'S STORTFORD were founded in 1874 and played in the Stansted & District and East Herts League before joining the Herts County League in 1908 later moving to the Spartan League. They were Delphian League founder members and, in 1954/55, champions.

AVELEY joined the Delphian League from the London League in 1947. Founded in 1927 as a junior club, they closed down during the war, reforming in 1946 and joining the London League, a competition won in 1949/50.

Much-travelled WINDSOR & ETON had been Corinthian League founder members, but had later moved to the Metropolitan League. The club emerged in the early years of the century from a trail involving several similarly named clubs. They had been pre-war participants in the Athenian and Spartan Leagues and had spent three seasons in the Delphian League.

BERKHAMSTED TOWN were League founder members, but 10th place was their highest finishing place, the four seasons from 1957/58 seeing them bottom each time. Founded in 1895, they were re-formed as Berkhamsted Comrades by returning servicemen in 1919. 'Town' replaced 'Comrades' in 1922 on the club joining the Spartan League.

TILBURY, 5th in the uncompleted league table, had been Corinthian League members from 1950/51 for seven seasons, never finishing above 6th. They were London League members just after the war and before joining the Delphian League for the 1962/63 campaign.

HARLOW TOWN were also new for the last season of the Delphian League. Founded in 1879, they had played in the Spartan League from 1932 and in the London League from 1953, they had only recently moved to a new home at the Harlow Sports Centre.

AYLESBURY UNITED were founded in 1897 on the amalgamation of the Printing Works and Night Schools clubs. They joined the Spartan League in its second season, 1908/09 and won the competition's championship. They were founder members of the Delphian League and had reached the First Round Proper of the F.A.Cup where they lost to Watford in that first season.

HEMEL HEMPSTEAD TOWN had been founded as Apsley in 1885 and changed their name to Hemel Hempstead in 1947 on joining with Hemel Hempstead United with 'Town' being added in 1955. They joined the Spartan League in 1922 and had reached the First Round Proper of the F.A.Cup in 1938/39. They joined the Delphian League in 1952 and were runners-up in 1962.

WARE had joined the League in 1955. They were formed in the 1890s and, via the Herts County League, had joined the Spartan League in 1922. They were Spartan League champions in 1953, but their highest finishing place in the Delphian League was 6th, achieved in 1956/57.

BRENTWOOD & WARLEY were Delphian League founder members and the first champions. Formed just after the first war from an army team from Warley Barracks and Brentwood Mental Hospital, they had played in the Spartan League for a period before the second war and also afterwards. They also won the Delphian championship in 1959 and 1960.

HARROW TOWN had been formed as Roxonian in 1933, moving to the Spartan League and to a new home, Earlsmead, in 1934. Four year later they became Harrow Town. Their highest Spartan League position was runners-up, while in the Delphian League they once finished 3rd.

HISTON, one off the bottom of the uncompleted table, had been formed in 1904 and had joined the Spartan League just after the second war as Histon Institute. They joined the Delphian League in 1960/61, finishing last in their second season.

WINGATE, bottom of the uncompleted table, were an all-Jewish side founded in 1946 being named after General Wingate, some of the first club members having fought in Wingate's wartime Chindit campaign. Formerly members of the Middlesex and London Leagues, they had joined the League for the 1962/63 season.

The 1963/64 Amateur Cup competition saw ex-Athenians Enfield reach the final. Barnet lost in the semi-final at Newcastle, 2-1 against eventual winners Crook Town. Grays Athletic and Carshalton Athletic reached the last sixteen.

When the Corinthian League was absorbed into the Athenian League, the "Memorial Shield" was presented to the Athenian League Division One Cup Winners. Division Two clubs compered for the Division Two knock-out Cup.

THE MEMORIAL SHIELD

The 'Memorial Shield' as its name implies is a Trophy of those who made the supreme sacrifice in the last War, typified by the crew of the plane "N for Nan", lost over enemy territory on the night of September 13/14th 1944.

The parents of these lads conceived the idea of perpetuating their memory by the Trophy in the interests of sport, and through the Grays Athletic Football Club, offered in to the Corinthian League in 1945. It was competed for annually as a 'knock-out' competition, by clubs in membership of the Corinthian League.

The Shield was dedicated with due solemnity and reverence by the late Rev. Sir Herbert Dunnico, J.P., President of the Essex County Football Association in September 1945.

The Premier Division was increased in size from 14 to 16 clubs for the 1964/65 season. 5th placed Wealdstone went to the Isthmian League and the three additional places were filled by Division One champions Leatherhead, runners-up Worthing, and 3rd placed Edgware Town. No club was relegated to Division One.

The 14 club Division One was also increased to size to 16. The top five clubs in Division Two were all promoted while no club was relegated. Division Two was increased in size from 15 to 16 but six new clubs had to be brought in to make up the full number.

RAINHAM TOWN had been founder members of the Delphian League. They were formed in 1945 and played in the South Essex League. They moved to the London League and to a new ground, Deri Park, in 1948. They joined the Metropolitan League in 1961 and in their last season, 1963/64, finished 14th, one of only five non-reserve teams in the competition.

EASTBOURNE UNITED also came from the Metropolitan League where they had finished 8th, Charlton Athletic Reserves being the champions. They had finished 3rd in 1960/61, their highest final placing since joining the competition in 1956 from the Sussex County League. They were founded in 1894.

HARWICH & PARKESTON had perhaps their finest hour in 1953 when they had appeared in the F.A. Amateur Cup Final at Wembley in front of 100,000 people. The brilliance of Pegasus, the combined past and present Oxford and Cambridge side, hammered them 6-0. They had been Amateur Cup runners-up in 1899 having been formed in 1877. They were members of the Eastern Counties League, which they had joined in 1938/39, where they had finished third in their final season.

HERNE BAY were founded in 1886 and, from the Kent League, were Aetolian League founder members in 1959. They were runners-up in Division One in their final season a point behind Chatham Town, with their reserves finishing as Division Two champions.

CROYDON AMATEURS were Spartan League champions in their only season, 1963/64, eleven points above runners-up Boreham Wood. They had been Surrey Senior League members since their formation in 1953 until 1963.

CHESHUNT were Spartan League champions in 1962/63 and 5th in their last season in the competition. They had been formed in 1946 as Crossbrook Sports and had spent periods in the London, Delphian and Aetolian Leagues. They had been founder members of the latter and spent two seasons in that competition.

In the 1964/65 Amateur Cup was won by ex-Athenians Hendon who beat Finchley 4-0 in the Highbury semi-final. Harwich & Parkeston reached the last eight.

At the end of the 1964/65 season long standing members Barnet turned professional and went to the Southern League. Southall were preserved from relegation again and the top division was brought up to its full complement by the promotion of the top two Division One clubs. Redhill became the first club to be relegated from the top division.

Epsom & Ewell were relegated to Division Two, Dorking being reprieved. The top two in Division Two were promoted and bottom two clubs Histon and Brentwood & Warley (who became Brentwood Town) left the competition for the Eastern Counties League and the Metropolitan League respectively. Three new clubs were, therefore, needed to bring Division Two up to the 16 clubs for the 1965/66 campaign.

LEWES were founded in September 1885 and, via the Mid-Sussex League, were founder members of the Sussex County League in 1920. Runners-up twice, they never won the County League, but had won the Sussex (Royal Ulster Rifles) Senior Cup in 1962, 1963 and 1965.

MARLOW, founded in 1870, had been members of the Spartan League before the first war and had rejoined in 1928. They had little league success, a sole championship coming in 1938, but finished 8th, 13th and 12th in their final three seasons.

RUISLIP MANOR were founded in 1938 and played in the Middlesex and London Leagues before joining the Spartan League in 1956 having moved to their Grosvenor Vale ground in 1947. They were third in the Spartan League in 1961/62 and 1962/63, but were 16th of 18 clubs in their final season.

Wealdstone and Hendon, both recently Athenian Leaguers but now in the Isthmian League, contested the 1966 Amateur Cup final. Leatherhead made the most progress in the competition of the Athenian League entrants, losing 2-1 to eventual winners Wealdstone in the quarter final.

England won the World Cup during the summer as the Athenian League settled down to a period of relative stability, it being five seasons before there was more seepage of top clubs to the now superior Isthmian League.

ATHENIAN LEAGUE STAR GRADUATES

Dave Armstrong (Hornchurch)

Joined Millwall (December 1965).

Subsequent career; Brighton (September 1968), Dover (July 1970), Wimbledon (October 1971)
Born in Mile End, this versatile forward impressed in the Athenian League with Hornchurch prior to playing in Division Two with Millwall. He quit Wimbledon in May 1973 to become a tailor.

Peter Baker (Enfield)

Joined Spurs (October 1952)

Subsequent career; Durban United - South Africa (July 1965).

Former England youth right-back Peter Baker spent almost 13 years at White Hart Lane - a key figure as Spurs won the F.A.Cup 'double' in 1960/61 and retained the F.A.Cup the following year. He now runs a stationery/office furniture business in Durban.

Jimmy Bloomfield (Hayes)

Joined Brentford (October 1952)

Subsequent career; Arsenal (July 1954), Birmingham City (November 1960), Brentford (June 1964), West Ham United (October 1965), Plymouth Argyle (September 1966), Orient - Player Manager (March 1968), Leicester City - Manager (June 1971), Orient - Manager (September 1977).

Inside-right Jimmy Bloomfield gained England U-23 honours and represented the Football League before moving from Arsenal to Birmingham City for £30,000. He later achieved managerial success with Orient and Leicester City. Died of a heart attack in April 1983.

Peter Burridge (Hitchin Town and Barnet)

Joined Leyton Orient (April 1958)

Subsequent career; Millwall (August 1960), Crystal Palace (June 1962), Charlton Athletic (November 1965), Bedford Town (July 1967).

Inside-left Peter Burridge was top scorer in successive seasons for Millwall, including their 1961/62 Fourth Division title success. Moved to Crystal Palace for £8,000 and was joint top scorer as they clinched promotion in 1963/64. He is now a ladies hairdresser.

Stan Charlton (Bromley)

Joined Leyton Orient (November 1952)

Subsequent career; Arsenal (November 1955), Leyton Orient (December 1958), Weymouth - Player Manager (June 1965).

The son of a pre-war Exeter City player, former England Amateur international full-back Stan Charlton quickly impressed with Leyton Orient before joining Arsenal in a £30,000 joint deal with Vic Groves. He skippered Orient to Division One in 1961/62 after returning to Brisbane Road. Now secretary of Weymouth.

Len Choules (Sutton United)

Joined Crystal Palace (May 1951)

Subsequent career; Romford (August 1962).

Half-back Len Choules gave Crystal Palace fine service during the 1950's - scoring twice in 260 League appearances. Ever-present in 1956/57, he helped them to win promotion in 1960/61. He finished his career in the Southern League with Romford.

Billy Dare (Hendon)

Joined Brentford (November 1948)

Subsequent career; West Ham United (January 1955), Yiewsley (June 1959), Ashford Town (September 1962).

Popular centre-forward Billy Dare was the first player to be transferred on television when he joined West Ham United from Brentford for £5,000. He was the perfect foil for John Dick and Vic Keeble, starring in West Ham's 1957/58 Second Division title success. Died in May 1994.

Ken Pacey (Leyton)

Joined Leyton Orient (June 1952)

Subsequent career; Leyton Orient (Coach).

Formerly with Walthamstow Avenue and St. Albans City, wing-half Ken Pacey gave Leyton Orient excellent service during the 1950's - helping to win the Third Division (South) title in 1955/56. He managed 49 goals in 301 League appearances prior to joining their coaching staff in 1961.

Jack Gregory (Bromley and Hayes)

Joined West Ham United (June 1951)

Subsequent career; Scunthorpe United (June 1953), Aldershot (June 1957), St. Neots Town - Player Coach (June 1958).

England Amateur international inside-forward Jack Gregory gained Second Division experience with West Ham, then was top scorer in successive promotion challenges at Scunthorpe United. His son John played for England and is currently coach at Leicester City.

John Hollowbread (Enfield)

Joined Spurs (January 1952)

Subsequent career; Southampton (May 1964), Mullard Sports (July 1966).

Goalkeeper John Hollowbread understudied internationals Ted Ditchburn and Bill Brown at Spurs, making 67 First Division appearances prior to joining Southampton for £3,000. A serious knee injury effectively ended his career and he became a Romsey publican, now bar manager at a Hampshire golf club.

Tommy McGhee (Wealdstone)

Joined Portsmouth (May 1954)

Subsequent career; Reading (July 1959), Poole Town (July 1960), Fareham Town (June 1967).

England Amateur international full-back Tommy McGhee made 135 First Division appearances for Portsmouth and gained England 'B' honours. He twice helped Southern League Poole Town win promotion - one of several ex-Pompey stars at Wimborne Road during the early 1960's.

David Pacey (Hitchin Town)

Joined Luton Town (August 1956)

Subsequent career; Kettering Town (July 1965), Electrolux (July 1967).

Versatile left-half David Pacey turned professional with Luton Town after completing his National Service. He secured a regular First Division place, scoring in the 1959 F.A. Cup final and gained England U-23 recognition. Managed 16 goals in 246 appearances before following Gordon Turner to Southern League Kettering Town.

Denis Pacey (Walton & Hersham)

Joined Leyton Orient (December 1951)

Subsequent career; Millwall (October 1954), Aldershot (September 1958), Yeovil Town (January 1960), Dartford (July 1961).

Centre-forward Denis Pacey finished top scorer in three successive years for Leyton Orient before joining Millwall for £4,000. Following a spell with Aldershot, he played in the Southern League for Yeovil Town and Dartford.

Gordon Phillips (Hayes)

Joined Brentford (November 1963)

Subsequent career; Hillingdon Borough (July 1973), Burnham (June 1979), Staines Town (Coach).

Goalkeeper Gordon Phillips made over 200 League appearances for Brentford - ever present as the Bees regained Third Division status in 1971/72. Following relegation, he joined Southern League Hillingdon Borough where he made a further 200 appearances - starring in their 1974/75 promotion success and 1976/77 F.A.Cup run.

Stewart Scullion (Chesham United)

Joined Charlton Athletic (March 1965)

Subsequent career; Watford (February 1966), Sheffield United (May 1971), Watford (December 1973), Portland Timbers (July 1976).

Winger Stewart Scullion was a great favourite at Watford as they won the Third Division title in 1968/69 and were F.A.Cup semi-finalists a year later. Sold to newly-promoted Sheffield United for £50,000 he held a regular First Division place before rejoining Watford for £15,000 where he completed over 300 appearances.

Charlie Vaughan (Sutton United)

Joined Charlton Athletic (January 1947)

Subsequent career; Portsmouth (March 1953), Bexleyheath & Welling (August 1954), Millwall (Chief Scout).

England Amateur international centre-forward Charlie Vaughan added England 'B' honours after turning professional with Charlton Athletic. He managed 92 goals in 227 First Division outings, then continued in the top flight with Portsmouth. As player-manager, he guided Bexleyheath & Welling into the Southern League. He died in 1989.

Phil White (Wealdstone)

Joined Leyton Orient (July 1953)

Outside-right Phil White was a great favourite at Leyton Orient during the 1950's. Despite offers from bigger clubs he remained loyal to the O's and helped to win the Third Division (South) title in 1955/56. He created numerous goalscoring opportunities for the likes of Tom Johnston, netting 27 goals in 221 League appearances before retiring after his testimonial in April 1964.

Phil Woosnam (Sutton United)

Joined Leyton Orient (February 1957)

Subsequent career; West Ham United (November 1958), Aston Villa (November 1962), Atlanta Chiefs - Player Coach (June 1966).

Voted 'Amateur Footballer of the Year' in 1955, this constructive inside-forward helped Leyton Orient to win the Third Division (South) title in 1955/56. He moved to West Ham for £30,000 and to Aston Villa for a similar fee - gaining 17 caps for Wales before playing a major role in the development of soccer in the USA as commissioner of the NASL.
