THE CORINTHIAN LEAGUE - A SHORT HISTORY

The immediate post-war period saw the formation of several new senior leagues in the Home Counties. Many emerged from the desire to maintain the higher standard of soccer clubs had enjoyed during wartime competition when mixed with opposition from, among others, the well established Isthmian and Athenian Leagues. One such was the **CORINTHIAN LEAGUE**, formed so soon after the cessation of hostilities that the fixture programme had already started by the time the F.A.'s formal sanction was given. Not only was their League competition introduced, but a knock-out competition was also established for the first season. The 'Memorial Shield' was a trophy dedicated to the crew of the bomber 'N for Nan' lost over enemy territory in September 1944.

The nine members in 1945-46 came from diverse backgrounds: included were a former F.A. Amateur Cup finalist, an entrant in the first F.A. Cup, and former members of the London and Spartan Leagues.

GRAYS ATHLETIC, whose secretary had been prominent in the competition's establishment, were the first champions. The Essex 'Thameside' club had been born out of Grays Juniors, playing only local football, emerging as Grays Athletic on the disbandment of Grays United in 1906. They had been members of the London League between the wars apart from two seasons in the Kent League. Not only had they been London League champions three times, but they had also won the Essex Senior Cup twice.

SLOUGH UNITED, who emerged during the war when Slough Centre amalgamated with Slough F.C., were inaugural season runners-up. Cup progress that season saw them reach the last sixteen of the F.A. Amateur Cup and the First Round Proper of the F.A.Cup. The first peacetime F.A.Cup attracted around 300 entries and ties were played over two legs: Whilst Slough won their First Round home match against Bromley 1-0, they had already lost the first leg, away, 6-1.

ERITH & BELVEDERE reformed from Belvedere & District in 1922, joined the League with a very good F.A. Amateur Cup pedigree. They had twice reached the final, losing in 1924 to Isthmians Clapton and in 1938 to Athenians Bromley. In 1941-42 the club, which played in the London and Kent Leagues before the war, established an extraordinary goalscoring record for senior amateur soccer in scoring 253 goals in 44 League and Cup games. 1945-46 saw them take the Corinthian League name to the Amateur Cup quarter final stage where they lost on Merseyside 2-1 to Marine.

A club called **WINDSOR & ETON**, having been formed in 1892, had participated in the first FA Amateur Cup competition in 1893. That club appeared to have disbanded in 1901, but Windsor & Eton Temperance FC, formed on the amalgamation of two junior clubs in 1900, dropped the 'Temperance' in 1902 and most

of the earlier club's officials, etc became involved in the 'new' club. Pre-Second World War members of the Athenian and Spartan Leagues, they were in the Great Western Combination (1939-45) and had won the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup on five consecutive wartime seasons.

MAIDENHEAD UNITED had been F.A. Cup semi-finalists in 1873 and in the immediate pre-war period had been Spartan League members and the competition's champions in 1926-27, 1931-32 and 1933-34. They had also been Berks & Bucks Senior Cup holders and, in 1936, Amateur Cup finalists. At the turn of the century they had been Southern League members.

WALTON & HERSHAM were formed on the amalgamation of Walton (1896) and Hersham (1926), in 1945, as the latter had lost their ground during the war. The clubs had been Surrey Senior League members and were both due to compete in the 1939-40 London League campaign.

Three clubs failed to re-appear after the first season all because of ground difficulties. **TWICKENHAM**, previously of the Middlesex Senior League and joint champions in 1945, played some of their games at Kneller Hall and were hoping for a ground share agreement with Brentford, but this failed to materialise. **LONDON FIRE SERVICES** which had no regular home ground, and played all of their matches on their opponents' grounds. and **EPSOM TOWN** (which were not connected with a later League member of the same name), who played at Lavender Hill, were forced to withdraw from the league owing to the loss of their ground.

There were, however, ample suitable replacement clubs from elsewhere and the League was able to recruit seven new clubs, stretching the competition's geographical range as far south as the Sussex coast and as far north as Bedford, some 50 miles from London.

From West London, however, came **UXBRIDGE** another club with F.A. Cup participation dating back to the 1870's. They had been Southern League members and Amateur Cup finalists before the turn of the century and had spent many of the 'inter war' seasons in the Athenian League. They had been London League members in 1945-46, where they had finished runners up in that League's Western Section.

From the newer suburbs of North West London came **EDGWARE TOWN**. They had been founder members and first champions of the Middlesex Senior League in 1939-40 and, in 1945-46, had been champions of the London League Western Section.

HOUNSLOW TOWN were another West London side. They had been founded in 1884 and were Spartan League members before the War. In the first post-war

season they were Spartan League Divisional champions.

CARSHALTON ATHLETIC had been formed in 1905 on the amalgamation of Mill Lane Mission (1903) and Carshalton St Andrews (1897). Once members of the Southern Suburban League, they were founder members of the Surrey Senior League in 1922, moving to the London League after just one season. In 1945-46 they finished 8th in the London League.

BEDFORD AVENUE overstretched themselves in joining the Corinthian League for the 1946-47 season. The club known originally as Bedford Queen's Park Rangers, was founded in 1905 and had made progress from modest beginnings. 1945-46 saw a change in name, the championship of the United Counties League and an F.A. Cup run which took them to the Final Qualifying Round.

From the Sussex coast came **EASTBOURNE** and **HASTINGS & ST. LEONARDS**. Both had been long term members of the AFA (Amateur Football Association) Southern Amateur League, the first mentioned since the Association's formation in 1907.

Hastings & St. Leonards left at the beginning of the 1948-49 season due to ground difficulties, but **CHESHAM UNITED** brought the participating clubs up to 14 for the third season.

Spartan Leaguers Chesham United had been formed on the amalgamation of Chesham Town (1879) and Chesham Generals (1887) in 1919 and had League championships and Senior Cup wins to their credit. In their last Spartan League season, Chesham United had finished 8th. Another new name appeared for 1947-48 as a split at Slough saw **SLOUGH TOWN** continue as a Corinthian League team and Slough Centre join the Spartan League.

At the end of the 1947-48 season, Bedford Avenue moved to the Central Amateur Alliance, a competition for senior amateur clubs in the Midlands. They were replaced by eight times Sussex Senior Cup winners **WORTHING**, a club formed by the coming together of several local clubs in 1900, a Worthing F.C having been around since the 1880's. The coastal club were previously Sussex Senior League members.

1948-49 also saw the establishment of a **RESERVE SECTION**. Initially operating with nine of the thirteen clubs in membership, from the following season all clubs played in both the Senior and Reserve Section. A knock-out competition for reserve teams, the **NEALE TROPHY**, was also introduced for the 1948-49 season.

The following season, 1949-50, **EPSOM**, founded in 1917 as Epsom Town and one

time Surrey Senior Leaguers, joined from the London League where they had finished 3rd.

1949-50 also saw the formation of the Metropolitan & District League, a competition which also had a large geographical spread, having clubs as far north as St. Neots and as far south as the Sussex coast. Unlike the Corinthian League however, reserve sides were included. 1950-51 was the inaugural season of the Delphian League.

Three times champions Walton & Hersham joined the Athenian League for the 1950-51 season, the first Corinthian League club to do so. Windsor & Eton moved to the Metropolitan & District League, while two additional clubs came in for the new season.

TILBURY were another Essex Thames-side club. Like founder members Grays Athletic they were from the London League and also had some Kent League experience. 1949-50 had seen them runners-up in the London League but spectacular progress in the F.A. Cup had seen them reach the First Round Proper (where they lost to Notts County 4-0) having started in the Extra Preliminary Round.

The other newcomer was **MAIDSTONE UNITED**. Founded in 1897, the club had played semi-professional football in the Kent League for some time, but were re-formed as an amateur club after the Second World War, participating in the same competition. In 1949-50 they were 9th in the League's first division.

The Middlesex County League sought to widen its geographical spread to other counties and in 1951-52 became the Parthenon League. The Hellenic League was formed for the 1953-54 season. Although many of its members were from the Oxfordshire Senior League, there were three Spartan League sides and one from the Parthenon. At this time, however, the Corinthian League experienced some stability, the first change in membership since 1950, coming in 1954.

Meanwhile one of the inaugural seasons' achievements had been equalled as a Corinthian League side reached the First Round Proper of the F.A. Cup for the first time since 1945-46. In the Amateur Cup Slough's inaugural season achievement of reaching the last 16 had been bettered.

In season 1952-53 Grays Athletic played Llanelli in the First Round Proper of the F.A. Cup. In the early stages of the qualifying competition they beat Harwich & Parkeston, Dagenham, Clacton Town and Kings Lynn. The Southern Leaguers from Wales were, however, far too strong for them and Grays went out 5-0.

A Corinthian League side usually got to the Amateur Cup last 16 in the League's early years. Grays Athletic and Hounslow Town got there in 1946-47; Walton &

Hersham in 1947-48; and Erith & Belvedere and Walton & Hersham again in 1948-49. 1949-50 saw Hounslow go further than any Corinthian League side had before, reaching the quarter finals where they lost 2-1 to Barking. Slough Town equalled that achievement in 1952-53 losing to eventual winners Pegasus 2-0, and Hounslow Town did it again the following season going out 4-2 to eventual runners-up Bishop Auckland.

In 1954 **YIEWSLEY** joined from the Delphian League.

1954-55 was in fact to be a very notable season as in the F.A. Amateur Cup Hounslow Town got to within one match of Wembley. They beat Redhill, Hitchin Town, Bromley and fellow Corinthians Carshalton Athletic (in a replay) to win a semi-final place against Hendon at Tottenham. There they lost to the eventual losing finalists 2-1.

Hounslow Town also reached the first round proper of the F.A. Cup that season. They beat Uxbridge, Kingstonian, Met Police, Hayes and Canterbury City to qualify for a tie against Southern League Hastings United. There they lost 4-2. Hounslow were 1954-55 champions and moved to the Athenian League for 1955-56. Carshalton Athletic went the same way for the 1956-57 season. For 1957-58 Maidstone United also went to the Athenian League whilst Tilbury reverted to the London League.

Newcomers in 1956 were **WEMBLEY** and **DORKING**. Delphian League runners-up in 1955-56, Wembley had been founder members of that competition. Dorking dated from the 1880's and in 1955-56 had been Surrey Senior League Champions.

There were also two new clubs for the 1957-58 competition. **DAGENHAM** came from the Delphian League where they had been Champions in 1957. **HORSHAM**, founded in the 1880's, had been champions of the Sussex Senior League seven times before joining the Metropolitan & District League in 1951, the competition from which they joined the Corinthian League.

Yiewsley turned professional in 1958 and joined the Southern League. In their penultimate Corinthian League season, 1956-57, they had reached the First Round Proper of the F.A. Cup where they became the first Corinthian League club to play Football League opposition. Hendon, Uxbridge, Finchley, Southall and Clacton were all beaten before Yiewsley met Gillingham. It took the Third Division (South) side a replay to beat the amateurs.

Founder members Grays Athletic also left in 1958 when they became the fourth Corinthian League club to join the Athenian League. There was, however, only one replacement for the two departures, **LEATHERHEAD** from the Delphian League, the fourth club to join from that competition.

There were two newcomers for the 1959-60 , the last change in membership. Both came from the Delphian League. **WOKINGHAM TOWN**, who in 1957-58 had reached the last eight of the Amateur Cup where they lost to Crook Town having progressed through all the qualifying rounds, and **LETCHWORTH TOWN**, the champions in 1958. In 1960-61 Epsom Town became Epsom & Ewell.

At the end of the 1962-63 season the Corinthian League was absorbed into the Athenian League, with Dagenham and Maidenhead United joining the Premier Division.

THE MEMORIAL SHIELD

The 'Memorial Shield' as its name implies, is a 'Trophy in memory of those who made the supreme sacrifice in the last War, typified by the crew of the plane "N for Nan", lost over enemy territory on the night of September 13/14th 1944.

The parents of these lads conceived the idea of perpetuating their memory by this Trophy in the interests of sport, and through the Grays Athletic Football Club, offered it to the Corinthian League in 1945. It was competed for annually as 'knock-out' competition, by clubs in membership of the Corinthian League.

The Shield was dedicated with due solemnity and reverence by the late Rev. Sir Herbert Dunnico, J.P., Presidents of the Essex County Football Association in September 1945.

When the Corinthian League was absorbed into the Athenian League in 1963, the "Memorial Shield" was presented to the Athenian League Cup Winners until 1969, when the "Shield" was presented to that Competition's Runners-Up.

THE DELPHIAN LEAGUE - A SHORT HISTORY

The **DELPHIAN LEAGUE** came into being for the 1951-1952 season drawing its membership from the Spartan League (Nine Clubs), the London League (Three Clubs) and the Metropolitan & District League (Two Clubs). A **RESERVE SECTION** was also formed for 1951-1952 with the same clubs.

The first Delphian League Champions were Essex club **BRENTWOOD & WARLEY** formed just after the First World War from an army team from Warley Barracks and Brentwood Mental Hospital, they had played in the Spartan League for a handful of inter-war seasons and immediately after the Second. They had been Eastern Division Champions in 1947-48, Premier Division runners-up in 1948-49, and in 1950-51 had reached the Third Round of the F.A. Amateur Cup.

The Champions reached the last 16 of the Amateur Cup again in the League's first season. In the competition proper they beat Salisbury and Eastbourne before losing to Briggs Sports, Spartan League Champions that season, in the Third Round. It was to be five seasons before the feat was repeated by a Delphian League side.

Runners-up were another Essex club, **DAGENHAM**. Formed in 1949, they had been Metropolitan & District League founder members and, in 1950-51, had been League champions, runners-up in the League Cup, and had reached the Second Round of the Amateur Cup, having coming through the whole of the qualifying competition. Over 7,000 saw the Second Round tie versus Walthamstow Avenue at Dagenham's home, the Arena, Old Dagenham Park, Vicarage Road which ended in a 0-0 draw. Walthamstow won the replay 3-1.

YIEWSLEY from West London finished third. Founded in 1872, they had achieved much junior success before becoming members of the Great Western Suburban League just after the First War. This competition closed down in the 1920's and Yiewsley next emerged in the Spartan League immediately after the Second World War. Western Division champions in 1949-50, they were Premier Division champions in 1950-51.

AYLESBURY UNITED were founded in 1897 on the amalgamation of the Printing Works and Night Schools football clubs. Via the Bucks & Contiguous and South Eastern Leagues they became Spartan League members in that competition's second season, 1908-09, winning the championship at the first attempt. In 1950-51 they were 3rd in the Spartan League. In their first season as Delphians an F.A. Cup run took them to the First Round Proper. Marlow, Banbury Spencer, Wycombe Wanderers and Hendon were beaten before Aylesbury met Division Three (South) Watford. 7,500 spectators saw them go down at their home since 1958, the Wendover Road Stadium, 0-5.

BERKHAMSTED TOWN were another ex-Spartan League club, having finished 7th in their final season. Although they had been an earlier 'Town' club, the club were formed in 1919 as Berkhamsted Comrades by serviceman returning from the War. The Comrades name was dropped and Town substituted when the club gained admission to the Spartan League in 1922.

BISHOP'S STORTFORD were founded in 1874 and played in the Stansted & District and East Herts Leagues before joining the Herts County League in 1908. They became Spartan League members in 1929. In their final season they had finished 3rd in Division One (Eastern Section).

CHESHUNT were a relatively new club, being founded in 1946 as Crossbrook Sports. They joined the London League and were Premier Division champions in 1949-50. Their penultimate London League season also saw them reach the last 16 of the Amateur Cup. They were 3rd in their final season.

LEATHERHEAD were formed in 1946 by the amalgamation of two local clubs, Leatherhead Rose and Leatherhead United. The new club were elected to the Surrey Senior League and made an immediate impact by taking the League championship for four successive seasons. They joined the Metropolitan & District League for the 1950-51 campaign and finished 9th of 16 clubs.

There had been a pre-War **RAINHAM TOWN**, but the post-War club was formed in 1945 and, playing on the Rainham Working Men's Club ground, they joined the South Essex League. League Cup winners once and runners-up twice, they joined the London League for the 1948-49 season, as their new home, Deri Park was opened.

Corinthian League side Slough United, itself an amalgamation of Slough FC and Slough Centre FC in 1943, split into two at the end of the competition's second season, 1946-47. Whilst Slough Town stayed in the Corinthian, **SLOUGH CENTRE** joined the Spartan League. They were Division One champions in 1948-49 and in their final season before being Delphian League founder members, finished 9th of 14 in the Spartan League Premier Division. 1951-52 saw Slough Centre win the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup by beating holders Chesham United 1-0 at Wycombe.

Hertfordshire side **STEVENAGE TOWN** had spent much of the time fighting their way up to Spartan League standard, joining Division One for the first time in 1947-48. They moved up to the Premier Division the following season and 1950-51 saw them finish 2nd in Division One (Eastern Section).

From north west London came **WEMBLEY**, who had been formed in 1946 when two junior clubs, Sudbury R.P.A. and Sudbury Rangers amalgamated. At first they competed in the Middlesex Senior League and, after winning the 1948-49

championship, they moved on to the Spartan League. They were Spartan League Division One Western Division champions in the season before being Delphian League founder members. In the 1951-52 Amateur Cup, Leyton took three attempts to beat Wembley in the Qualifying Competition's Preliminary Round before going all the way to the Final where they lost in the Final at Wembley Stadium.

Middlesex club **WILLESDEN** had been members of the Spartan League since the War (finishing 11th in their last season) and Essex club **WOODFORD TOWN**, founded in the 1930's had been London League runners-up in their last season before joining the Delphian League. 1950-51 had also seen Woodford reach the Fourth Qualifying Round of the FA Cup, further than any of the League's founder members that season.

Membership was increased by 2 to 16 for the competition's second season, 1952-53. **HEMEL HEMPSTEAD TOWN** had been founded in Apsley in 1885 and had changed their name in 1947. They had joined the Spartan League in 1922 and had got as far as the first Round Proper of the FA Cup in the last full season before the Second World War. In their last Spartan League season, they finished 5th of 14 clubs and won the Herts Charity Shield.

The other newcomer was **HORNCHURCH AND UPMINSTER** from metropolitan Essex. Initially founded in 1923 as Upminster, they joined the Spartan League just before the War. They had no senior honours before joining the Delphian League, Upminster having finished 9th in the Premier Division in their final Spartan League Season.

Slough Centre retained the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup in 1952-53 beating Slough Town 2-1 in a replay. Berkhamsted won the Hertfordshire Senior Cup by beating St Albans City from the Isthmian League 4-2 at Barnet in front of a 2,500 crowd. Berkhamsted and Stevenage shared the Herts Charity Shield after drawing 0-0 in a Final that went to extra time.

At the end of the second season, 1952-53, Willesden moved to the expanding Parthenon League but were not replaced. At the end of the third campaign, Yiewsley became the first Delphian League side to join the Corinthian League.

The replacement side for 1954-55 were **TUFNELL PARK EDMONTON** from the Spartan League. They had spent just two seasons there having lost their Isthmian League place in 1952, a position held since 1919. Founded in 1907, they had lost their Holloway Road ground in 1939 and had lead a nomadic existence for several years before amalgamation with Edmonton Borough in 1950.

The season saw Stevenage Town reach the Second Round of the Amateur Cup, the first Delphian League side to get that far since the inaugural season. They were

beaten there by the famous Pegasus.

At the end of the 1954-55 season, the Spartan League provided a replacement for Cheshunt who joined the London League. **WARE**, also from Hertfordshire, had been formed in the 1890's and, via the County League, had joined the Spartan League in 1922. They had been champions in 1952-53, in 1953-54 had won the County Senior Cup and in both 1953-54 and 1954-55 had reached the Second Round of the Amateur Cup. In the League in 1954-55 they finished 12th.

Elsewhere in Hertfordshire, Stevenage Town amalgamated with Stevenage Rangers and the new club became simply Stevenage FC. The 'Town' was added back to the club's name for 1959-60.

1956-57 saw the establishment of a knock-out competition, the Delphian League Cup but also saw a reduction in membership with Slough Centre disbanding and Wembley joining the London League. Just one club, **LETCHWORTH TOWN** joined to give a membership of 14 clubs. The club had been formed in 1906 shortly after the Hertfordshire Garden City itself. They had been in the Spartan League since 1924 and in their final season had finished 8th.

The membership increased by one for the 1957-58 season. Whilst Dagenham became the second Delphian League side to join the Corinthian League, there were two newcomers.

AVELEY were the first club to join from the London League since the Delphian League's first season. Founded in 1927 and confining themselves to local football, Aveley closed down during the War, reforming in 1946 and joining the Thurrock Combination. Twice Essex Junior Cup winners, they joined the London League in 1949-50 being champions in 1954-55 and runners-up the following year. In their final season they finished 3rd before being elected to the Delphian League in 1957.

The other new club was **WOKINGHAM TOWN**. The Berkshire club were formed in 1875 and after several ground moves ended up at Finchampstead Road in the mid 1900's. In 1910-11 the second team of Wokingham Athletic joined forces with the Club and, within a season, were the top local club. By way of local junior Leagues, they joined the Great Western Combination. In 1952-53 they were Berks & Bucks Intermediate Cup finalists, the following season they were Combination champions and, in 1954-55 members of the Metropolitan League.

The season saw newcomers Wokingham Town go further on the Amateur Cup trail than any Delphian League club had ever done before. Having come through the qualifying competition, they beat Histon and Norton Woodseats and, in the Third Round, they beat West Auckland twice, the first game having to be replayed because an ineligible player was fielded. In the Fourth Round, the last eight, they

lost to Crook Town in front of 10,000 spectators.

Leatherhead moved to the Corinthian League for 1958-59 and were replaced by **HARROW TOWN** from the Spartan League. They were formed as Roxonian in 1933, moving on to the Spartan League and a new ground, Earlsmead in 1934. Four years later they became Harrow Town. Their highest ever position in the competition was runners-up, achieved in the season before joining the Delphian League.

1958-59 saw founder members Woodford reach the Fourth Qualifying Round of the FA Cup. Having beaten Grays Athletic, Barking and Rainham Town, they lost to Athenian League side Hitchin Town in a replay. Bishops Stortford won the Hertfordshire Senior Cup the same season beating Barnet 2-0 at St Albans City FC.

At the end of the season, there were three departures from the League. Hornchurch became the first Delphian League side to join the Athenian League direct. Letchworth Town and Wokingham Town joined the London League.

With only one replacement coming in, 1959-60 saw the competition operate with 13 clubs, its smallest ever number. The new club **HERTFORD TOWN** from the Spartan League, where they had originally finished fourth in their last season. Founded in 1908, Hertford had originally joined the Spartan League from the Herts County League in 1921. Bishops Stortford retained the Herts Senior Cup, again beating Barnet in the final.

With two new clubs for 1960-61 and no departures, the League returned to 15 clubs. Cambridgeshire club **HISTON** were the 17th club to join the competition from the Spartan League. They had been formed in 1904 and had joined the Spartan League just after the Second World War when known as Histon Institute.

The other new club was **WINDSOR & ETON**, the fourth club to join direct from the Metropolitan League since the Delphian League's inaugural season and the competition in which they had participated since leaving the Corinthian League in 1950.

1960-61 saw two Delphian League clubs reach the Fourth Qualifying Round of the FA Cup. Founder members Brentwood & Warley beat Aveley, Ilford and Tilbury, but lost 4-0 to Southern League Oxford United. Harrow Town beat Wealdstone, Hertford Town and Bishops Stortford, but lost to Corinthian League Club Maidenhead United 3-2.

The competition's penultimate season, 1961-62, saw another reduction in members. Rainham Town and Woodford Town both joined the Metropolitan League, with **HARLOW TOWN** coming in from the London League. One of the oldest

clubs in Essex, having been formed in 1879, Harlow had just moved to a new home, Harlow Sports Centre. In 1932 they had joined the Spartan League, moving on to the London League in 1953. They finished third in the table in their final season behind Tilbury and East Ham United.

In Senior Cup competition in 1961-62, Hemel Hempstead Town got to the Hertfordshire Final, but lost to Hitchin Town. Windsor & Eton, however, won the Berks & Berks Senior Cup.

For the final, somewhat weather affected, season, the introduction of two new clubs brought the numbers back up to 16 to equal the record size of 1952-53. Both came from the London League.

WINGATE, an all-Jewish side, founded in 1946, had been Middlesex Senior League champions in 1952 when they joined the London League. In their final season they had finished 8th of 13 clubs.

TILBURY had been Corinthian League members up to 1957 and had spent the intervening period in the London League. In 1961-62 they had reached the Fourth Qualifying Round of the FA Cup and had finished as League champions with 43 points from 24 games, seven points ahead of runners-up Chingford.

Whilst the 1962-63 League campaign was disrupted, the Delphian League was represented for the second time in the last eight of the Amateur Cup and for the fifth time in the final Qualifying Round of the FA Cup.

Bishops Stortford got to the Fourth Round of the Amateur Cup beating Vauxhall Motors, Norton Woodseats and West Auckland Town in the Competition Proper before losing to the Cup's eventual winners, Wimbledon. Tilbury nearly got to the FA Cup Competition Proper again. Having beaten Grays, Aveley and Ilford, they were beaten by Corinthian League's Maidenhead 2-1.

Elsewhere Hertford Town won the East Anglia Cup and were runners-up in the Herts Senior Cup; Bishops Stortford won the Herts Charity Cup; and Ware beat Berkhamsted in the Herts Charity Shield.

At the end of the 1962-63 season, with the exception of Stevenage (who turned professional and joined the Southern League), the Delphian League clubs became founder members of Division Two of the Athenian League.
