#### WEEKEND REVIEW

##### Premier Division

Kingstonian closed the gap on Premier Division leaders Dartford to just four points with a 2-1 home win over Billericay on Saturday. No-one has been as close since early September; but it was not to last. K's kicked off at 1pm because of the installation of new lights by their landlords at Kingsmeadow, and by five o'clock the lead was back to seven points.

Bobby Traynor opened the scoring for Kingstonian with a 27<sup>th</sup> minute penalty, becoming the second player, and the first in the Premier Division, to reach 20 league goals.

Billericay drew level nine minutes after the interval through Lee Kersey but were soon behind again as Matt Gray buried a free-kick from 30 yards. Rob Sheridan's goal line clearance from Danny Green clinched the points.

At half-time it seemed as if Dartford might suffer a third successive defeat. They turned round 1-0 down at Tonbridge thanks to an 18<sup>th</sup> minute goal from Paul Booth. Ryan Johnson equalised soon after the restart and three goals in the last 18 minutes from Danny Harris, Elliot Bradbrook and Rob Haworth put the leaders back on track with a 4-1 victory. As well as their seven-point lead, Darts have three games in hand on their nearest rivals.

Kingstonian did, however, open up a six-point gap between themselves and third-placed Hastings. The Sussex side drew 2-2 at Sutton, having threatened to do better after Ross Treleaven, recently signed from Worthing, put them ahead in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute. There was no more scoring until Sonny Cobbs equalised in the 82<sup>nd</sup> minute, triggering a hectic burst of action. Matt Hann gave Sutton the lead two minutes later but Hastings shook off their disappointment and Harry Pell immediately levelled it again.

Sutton are fourth, with goal difference putting them on top of a pile of four clubs with 40 points, none of whom managed a win in what is becoming a slow-bicycle race for the play-off spots.

Boreham Wood slipped to fifth with a 4-2 home defeat by Cray, who now look capable of

staying out of the relegation places after four wins in five games. Tommy Tyne opened the scoring after ten minutes and a clearance by keeper Tony Tucker cannoned into the net off George Porter to make it 2-0 nine minutes later. Porter struck again four minutes after half-time and, although Danny Brathwaite pulled one back shortly afterwards, Cray were cruising to victory until Jon Clements made it 3-2 in the 90<sup>th</sup> minute. There was time for one more goal and it was the relieved Cray men who scored it as Porter unselfishly passed up a chance for his hat-trick to set up Ross Lover, who made no mistake.

The other two 40-pointers, Tooting and Ashford (Middx) both reached that mark with draws. All the goal action came in the space of a minute at Harrow, where the hosts went ahead through Kurt Morlese in the 77<sup>th</sup> minute and Jason Henry headed an instant reply. Ashford were denied victory, and fourth place, by Luke Nightingale's 92<sup>nd</sup> minute penalty for visiting Bognor. Nightingale had also replied to Davis Haule's opener for Ashford, set up by brother Brian, in the first half. Warren Harris headed what was so nearly Ashford's winner with 12 minutes to go.

The late, late goal also kept Bognor off the bottom as Waltham Abbey drew level with them on points by beating Carshalton 2-1 at Capershots. Goals early in each half, from James Elmes and Ricci Crace, did the trick for Abbey although Jordan Bostock's own goal on the hour made it a nail-biting finish.

Margate, who went down to a 17<sup>th</sup> minute Jo Flack goal at Hornchurch, are one point above the bottom two with Billericay a further point ahead of them, all having played 25 games. Flack could have scored again three minutes later but his penalty was saved by Luke Garrard.

Wealdstone launched an early assault at Hendon, despite falling behind, and held on to win 3-2, their first success in six outings. They are back within a point of a play-off spot and have games in hand. Anthony Thomas scored for Hendon after six minutes but by the 27<sup>th</sup> minute they were 3-1 down thanks to a goal by Darren Locke and a double from Callum Martin. Casey Maclaren got Hendon's second with 17 minutes to go.

Aveley chalked up their third win in a week and, to show how closely-contested this division is, they have moved from a point above the relegation zone to within five points

of a play-off place. Their latest success was by a convincing 4-1 margin at Canvey. The sides exchanged first-half penalties, Ryan Doyle scoring in the third minute for Aveley and Craig Davidson replying in the 36<sup>th</sup>. Added time at the end of the half brought the decisive swing. Martin Tuohy hit his 19<sup>th</sup> goal of the season for Millers and the bar denied Robbie King an immediate reply. The visitors added two goals in the last eight minutes, with Ryan Edgar scoring against his old club before Junior Dadson smashed in the fourth.

Maidstone's home game against Horsham was postponed after heavy snow in east Kent during the week.

### **Division One North**

There is not usually anything noteworthy about a 3-0 victory for a team in second spot against visitors lying 19 places below them, but Thamesmead's win against Redbridge stood out on Saturday. Why? Because it was the only home victory in the division. Two matches were drawn and no fewer than eight went the way of the visiting teams. There was an unusually high number of seven red cards in the division and six of them were shown to home players, as indeed were the day's other two, both in Division One South.

Even Thamesmead had to work hard for their points. It was the 58<sup>th</sup> minute before Lee Barnett headed them into the lead with his first goal since his move from Chatham and, although outplayed, Redbridge stayed in the hunt until the last eight minutes, when Lea Dawson and Lewis Tozer made sure.

Thamesmead remain six points behind Lowestoft, who have played five games fewer. Gary McGee put the Suffolk club ahead after only two minutes at Harlow and, in a final flurry at the end of the first half, Adam Smith and Craig Bussens hit the woodwork either side of a Bussens goal. Matt Nolan scored the Trawlerboys' 100<sup>th</sup> goal of the season in league and cup matches, his own 24<sup>th</sup>, after 69 minutes and Joe Francis completed a 4-0 win two minutes later.

That scoreline was also recorded by third-placed Concord at Leyton. Former Brentwood penalty specialist Danny Glozier opened his account for his new club with a pair of spot-kicks, midway through each half, with substitute Kayan Kalipha adding two more goals in the last 15 minutes. Leyton played with ten men for the whole second half; Lheureux Menga was given marching orders two minutes before the break.

East Thurrock had Kris Newby sent off nine minutes after half-time in their 0-0 draw at home to Enfield Town. Rocks stay fourth and the point was enough to lift Enfield into the final play-off spot, ahead of Great Wakering who were beaten by a 27<sup>th</sup> minute Nick Hegley goal for visiting VCD. Wakering also had a man dismissed, Anthony Hogg in the second half.

Wingate are right on the heels of the top six after their 2-1 victory at Heybridge, who lost Wayne Semashia to a red card after only 15 minutes. James Edgerley netted the resultant free-kick and Ahmet Rifat doubled the lead on the hour. Tom Broadhurst pulled one back with ten minutes left but it was Wingate who should have scored again when Jordan Fowler missed a penalty.

It was a similar story at Potters Bar, who conceded a goal in each half to Brentwood before a late goal gave them hope. Kris Lee put the visitors ahead after 25 minutes and the hosts had Luke Croll sent off just before half-time. Dee Okojie stretched the lead seven minutes after the break but Potters Bar will be aggrieved not to have taken a point. Jordan Watson pulled one back after 85 minutes and he had a chance to equalise in added time but was brought down by Darren Blewitt, who was also dismissed.

The other red card came at Ware, whose goalkeeper Ricky Wiseman made his exit after bringing down Danny Gabriel with four minutes left. Gabriel scored from the spot to complete Waltham Forest's 3-1 win. Their first-half opener by Peter Smith was quickly wiped out by Matthew Mitchell's long-range effort before Gabriel put the visitors ahead to stay soon after half-time.

Tilbury scored twice in the last eight minutes to snatch a 2-1 victory at Romford, who had broken the deadlock through Chris Thomas after 70 minutes. Joe Keith's free-kick squared it again and, after the bar had denied Romford's Matt Toms, Christian Wheeler headed a 90<sup>th</sup>-minute winner.

Cheshunt also came from behind to win 2-1, though they needed some help from hosts Ilford who had taken the lead with a 40<sup>th</sup> minute strike by Victor Omogbehin. A misdirected header by Ilford defender Anton Trice made it 1-1 midway through the second half and Ian Cooper's careless foul on David Hicks allowed the victim to score from the spot with three minutes left.

Eugene Ofori's header gave Northwood a 37<sup>th</sup> minute lead in their 1-1 draw at home to Maldon, who replied through Shawn Beveney soon after the interval.

## **Division One South**

Fleet Town suffered a setback in their promotion bid when they went down to a last-minute goal at Horsham YMCA on Saturday. The Sussex club, now unbeaten in nine games and up to seventh in the table, were provided with an early lead by Matt Geard only to be stunned in the last three minutes of the first half when Fleet defender Luke Evans headed home a corner for his first league goal of the season and enjoyed the feeling so much that he promptly did it again. Tony Timms made it 2-2 after 57 minutes and Tom Manton netted the late decider.

That made Fleet, who are third, the only side in the top six to lose, though leaders Folkestone had their home game against Whyteleafe postponed and fourth-placed Worthing's visit to Whitstable suffered the same fate. Also off was Ramsgate's game against Walton Casuals as the snow refused to melt in east Kent.

Croydon Athletic beat Sittingbourne 2-1 with a goal deep into added time, chalking up their fourth successive league win and closing the Folkestone from 11 to eight points; a significant change, with Folkestone expecting to suffer a ten-point penalty. Gareth Williams gave Croydon the lead three minutes after half-time but Elie Kayembe's reply on the hour looked certain to earn the Brickies a draw until Leslie Thompson scrambled the ball over the line in the 94<sup>th</sup> minute.

Another Williams, top scorer Phil, earned Godalming all three points at home to Corinthian-Casuals. He headed his 15<sup>th</sup> of the season in the 64<sup>th</sup> minute, the only goal of the game. There was late disappointment for the winners when Graeme Purdy was sent off for time-wasting.

Victory kept Godalming in fifth place and a point ahead of Walton & Hersham, who beat Merstham 2-1. It was 2-0 after only 14 minutes thanks to Kevin Lock and recent signing Martin Grant, who now has 22 goals for the two Walton clubs. There was to be no more scoring until the 90<sup>th</sup> minute, when Craig Vernon converted a penalty for a deserved consolation goal.

At the other end of the table there was a welcome victory for bottom club Ashford, their

first since 14<sup>th</sup> October and only their third of the season. It came at Dulwich, where they were aided by the 12<sup>th</sup> minute dismissal of home keeper Phil Wilson. Defender Calvin Morath-Gibbs took over the jersey and was beaten only by a Paul Jones header two minutes before half-time. Ashford, three points behind Whitstable and four behind Eastbourne Town, will hope to take advantage of the fact that 13 of their remaining 18 games are at home.

Eastbourne failed to follow up an encouraging midweek victory over Walton Casuals as they went down 2-0 at home to Metropolitan Police. Both goals came in the first half from Ron Edwards.

Chipstead moved further away from the drop zone with a 1-0 home win over Chatham. The goal came on the hour from Sean Rivers, his 19<sup>th</sup> since joining the club in the autumn. It was all square at Burgess Hill, where Will Berry put the home side ahead in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute only for Leatherhead to earn a point when Greg Andrews replied nine minutes later.

### Youth League

Central Division leaders Tooting were edged out by an 88<sup>th</sup> minute Sonny Ayres goal in their Ryman Youth League visit to Carshalton this week. Tooting took the lead in each half, Elliott Phipps and Rohan Clarke scoring, but the hosts drew level with goals from Paul Knight and Oliver Hinkley before Ayres struck to complete a 3-2 victory.

With three defeats on their record, Tooting are not among the three unbeaten clubs in this division. Croydon Athletic are, and they are now two points off the pace with a game in hand after a 2-0 home win over Whyteleafe. Cody Best and Dean Grant, with a penalty, scored in the latter stages of the first half. Leafe are still seeking their first win, having started the season with five successive draws and before going on a losing streak which has now reached six games.

Kingstonian, also unbeaten, drew 2-2 with Corinthian-Casuals to stay in third place, six points behind Tooting with three games in hand. Delano Henry and Dominick Modesir gave K's a 2-0 lead at the interval. Matthew Robinson pulled one back and Aaron Weston grabbed the leveller at the death.

The other Youth League games during the week were in the West Division, where Woking improved their title hopes with a 2-0 victory over Staines. Third place was the prize for the

winners of this one and a superb first-half goal by Ola Sogbanmu set Woking on their way. Rob Carr notched the second.

Jonathan Walsh was the hero for Harrow. His 55<sup>th</sup> minute equaliser at Hampton earned them their first point of the season at the sixth attempt, and also prevented Hampton going to the top of the table. Josh Guichard had put the hosts ahead in the 1-1 draw.

On Sunday morning, Bromley entertained and beat Welling United through scoring the only goal of the game – Thomas Skelton scoring the all important winner just eight minutes from full-time.

### LEAGUE RULE 8.6 – RE-DATING POSTPONED MATCHES

*From Alan Turvey, League Chairman:*

“As discussed at the recent EGM, this Rule has caused a problem for all Leagues in the National Leagues System with the requirement to play a rearranged match within 42 days of the original date.

“This League has been so concerned that the matter has been raised at a recent meeting of the Rules Working Party of The FA where changes for next season were discussed. We have been able to get agreement for the inclusion of the words “save in exceptional circumstances” in the Rule and this must now be approved by the relevant Committee and the FA Council.

“Following this and having reviewed the implications of the strict interpretation of Rule 8.6, and the need to maintain the integrity of the Competition while taking into account the needs of its member clubs, the Board has agreed that it will consider the merits of each case where Clubs request the dating of matches outside the 42 day period.

“Matches must be dated, where possible, within the 42 day period on the normal match night of the home club. Any variation to this must be referred to Bruce Badcock with reasons to play the game outside the 42 day period. Bruce will then refer to the Board, which already has the power to order Clubs to play on a date it considers suitable, and Bruce, as League Secretary will determine the new date in accordance with the existing provision.

“However, in the end it must be remembered that the season will conclude on Saturday, 24th April, 2010, and all matches must be completed by that date.

"We look forward to the continued support of all clubs in this particularly difficult and disrupted season."

## MY SPORTING LIFE – THEO PAPHITIS



**Before withering the hopes of contestants on the BBC's *Dragons' Den*, Theo Paphitis (net worth: £145m) was the chairman who took Millwall FC out of administration and into the Championship. His stationery company sponsors the Ryman League.**

### **What's your first sporting memory?**

When we arrived in the UK on the banana boat we settled right by Old Trafford. So the first recollections I have, as a six-year-old, in 1966, are of people milling around on a Saturday afternoon, and wondering what the hell was going on. England won the World Cup that same year: it just didn't get any better than that. After that I went to football as often as I could. I bunked off school to go to reserve games because you could get in for free. I was always useless at playing the game. It didn't ruin my enjoyment of it though.

### **How did you end up owning a club?**

I got approached 20 years ago to put a few bob in my local club, Walton and Hersham, in the Ryman League. I'm still a director and part-owner.

### **What has been your favourite match?**

The 2004 FA Cup semi-final between Millwall and Sunderland. I thought we'd end up losing because of the error of a player or referee. To win, and to know you're in the final against Man United, it brought to mind schoolboy memories of watching the FA Cup final on TV. And we were going to be part of it.

### **Given your performances on *Dragons' Den*, you must be quite an intimidating prospect as chairman?**

Nah! I'm a pussycat. Plus football managers have this arrogance and think they know everything. It's stupid.

### **Did Millwall's fans give you a hard time?**

Their reputation is a little unjust. I had a great eight years. I was a first-generation immigrant, and when I was just about to take over, someone told me that they looked at me and thought: "Are you mad? They're going to string you up from the rafters." But I didn't get one bit of racial abuse. Lots of abuse about the team playing rubbish, by the way, and rightly so.

### **In *Dragons' Den* you invested in a firm that made inline skates, but hadn't sold a single pair. Have you tried them out?**

You've got to be joking! Have you ever seen a baby giraffe trying to walk for the first time? That would look a lot more elegant.
