### **WEEKEND REVIEW**

### **Division One North**

THERE were only two games in Division One North on Saturday, and Heybridge made the most of it by climbing from seventh place to second with a 2-1 home win over Ware.

Sam Berry gave Ware the lead shortly before half-time but Chris Bryan equalised within a minute and Tom Broadhurst netted the winner on the hour. Ware keeper Obey Murefu denied Swifts a late third, saving Danny Barber's penalty.

Waltham Abbey, who visited Leyton, also came from behind to win 2-1. Sol Patterson-Bohner put Leyton ahead in the 47<sup>th</sup> minute, Steve Cawley levelled it eight minutes later and Tyler Campbell got the decider on 69 minutes.

### **Division One South**

SITTINGBOURNE extended their remarkable run against neighbours Chatham with a 2-1 away victory in Division One South on Saturday. Chatham have now lost 11 successive derbies, including one FA Trophy game, and they have not beaten their rivals in 15 meetings since 2003.

All the goal action came in the space of five minutes early in the second half. Hicham Akhazzan missed a penalty for the visitors but a retake was ordered and Paul Semakula stepped up to score. Leroy Huggins quickly made it 1-1 only for Tom Bradbrook to put Sittingbourne ahead to stay.

Leaders Leatherhead moved five points clear of Met Police, who have four games in hand, with a 2-1 home victory over Walton & Hersham. Once again it was Greg Andrews, with his 12<sup>th</sup> goal of the season, and Tommy Hutchings, with his tenth, who did the damage.

They are the division's leading scorers in league matches; Andrews has scored all his goals in Division One games, Hutchings all but one of his. Andrews netted midway though the first half, Kenny Ojukwu replied with a header midway through the second and Hutchings converted a penalty four minutes later.

All five matches in the two Division Ones finished 2-1. Chipstead's game at Whyteleafe completed the sequence, with two goals in four second-half minutes doing the trick for Chipstead. Jason Thompson, having missed a penalty, had another chance 12 minutes later and made no mistake. Dominic O'Shea then headed a second before Chipstead were reduced to ten men by Jason Goodchild's second yellow card and Freddie Fleming pulled one back.

### **FA Trophy**

FINISH of the day in Saturday's FA Trophy ties was undoubtedly at Wealdstone, where Division One North side Potters Bar were celebrating a shock 2-1 victory after Tom Pett's goal in the third minute of added time – until, straight from the kick-off, Scott Fitzgerald let fly from the halfway line and the ball rocketed into the net to make it 2-2. Elvis Balic had given the visitors a half-time lead, wiped out by Peter Dean in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute.

Earlier this season Canvey's Rob King scored a hat-trick of penalties at Hornchurch. Tommy Black would have done the same, this time for the home side, had he not blasted his second kick over the bar. His first put Urchins on terms in the 37<sup>th</sup> minute, 11 minutes after Dean Green had scored for Brentwood. The miss suggested that the tie would go to a replay. just as the recent FA Cup clash had done, but in the 78<sup>th</sup> minute Brentwood keeper Andy Hall grabbed Martin Tuohy's ankle to prevent him scoring in an empty net and, after he was sent off and replaced between the posts by Nicky Pyne, Black made it two out of three. It was the third time in a year that Brentwood had been beaten 2-1 in a cup match at Hornchurch.

Six ties pitted Ryman League clubs against Zamaretto League opposition, resulting in four

Ryman wins and only one defeat; Ramsgate earned a replay with a goalless draw at Arlesey.

One goal by Sean Bonnett-Johnson on the stroke of half-time was enough for Billericay at Biggleswade while Bury Town netted two unanswered goals at home to Barton, Craig Nurse and Sam Nunn the scorers. Nunn had earlier denied Barton the lead with a goalline clearance.

Ismael Welsh gave Grays a 32<sup>nd</sup>-minute lead at Soham, who had been reduced to ten men nine minutes earlier, and Simon Thomas made it 2-0 in the 88<sup>th</sup> minute, Soham pulling one back in added time.

Bedford twice fought back to level terms at Harlow after David Cowley and Clark Akers had scored for the hosts. Leo Roget made it 3-2 in the 82<sup>nd</sup> minute and saw the Hawks through.

A defensive mix-up left Aveley a goal behind in the first minute at Cambridge City, second in the Zamaretto Premier, and despite a brave effort by the Millers it proved to be the only score of the afternoon.

Returning to domestic battles, Hendon avenged Monday's home defeat in the Championship Manager Cup with a 1-0 victory at Harrow. Lee O'Leary scored after 63 minutes.

That was one of three all-Premier ties; Sutton and Tonbridge advanced with home victories in the others. Cup matches have brought Sutton nothing but misery so far this season and it looked as if they would face a replay at Tooting until Sam Page and Kennedy Adjei scored in the last six minutes to make it 3-1. A first-half opener by newcomer Andy Forbes, a prolific scorer for Hampshire clubs over the years, was answered by Tooting's Rob Haworth just after the hour.

Frannie Collin gave Tonbridge the lead on the half-hour against Concord and within five minutes it was 3-0. Collin scored again and Claude Seanla made it three. A Jamie England own goal gave Concord hope before half-time but they could not score a again until the 88<sup>th</sup> minute, when Jacob Erskine further reduced the arrears, to no avail. Collin's afternoon was spoilt when he was shown a second yellow card in the dying moments.

Only two Division One clubs defeated Premier opposition. Bognor left it late against Croydon Athletic; there were 89 minutes on the Nyewood Lane scoreboard when Luke Nightingale got the game's only goal.

Sudbury were the other 'giantkillers' with a 2-1 win at Canvey. Chris Moore gave Canvey an early lead which was soon wiped out by Rhys Darg, and Dave Wareham headed the winner before the interval.

The day's top scorers were Margate. They, and Shaun Welford in particular, are enjoying the visits of Sussex clubs. Having scored a hat-trick in their 6-1 win over Horsham the previous Saturday, Welford did it again as Whitehawk were beaten 5-1. Dean Grant and Jay Saunders put Margate 2-0 up at half-time, Joe Gatting pulled one back soon after the restart and then Welford took over.

The six-goal aggregate was matched in another game between Kent and Sussex coastal clubs. Frankie Chappell gave Folkestone an early lead against Worthing, who responded with two goals in three minutes, the first a penalty, from Michael Huckett just before the half-hour. A penalty miss by Darren Smith kept Rebels ahead until the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute, when they conceded another spot kick and James Everitt converted. He scored again in the 76<sup>th</sup> minute, with Simon Austin completing a 4-2 victory.

Suffolk rivals Needham Market and Lowestoft must meet again at Crown Meadow on Tuesday after a 2-2 draw. Adrian Forbes gave Lowestoft a half-time lead from the spot and scored his second after Craig Parker headed an equaliser, his 16<sup>th</sup> goal of the season. Nathan Stone squared it again with 12 minutes to go.

There was another 2-2 draw at Dulwich, where goals came early and late. Michael Owezu's third-minute opener for the hosts was wiped out by Hastings' John Beales five minutes later. There was no more scoring until the 81<sup>st</sup> minute, when Fraser Logan put Hastings ahead only for Lewis Gonsalves to respond.

Ilford went down 2-0 at Carshalton, who took the lead just before half-time with a deflected shot by Chris Henry and clinched it with a late goal from debutant Leon Noel, the former Croydon Athletic striker.

Ilford's neighbours Redbridge were beaten 3-0 at Horsham, who took the lead in the 13<sup>th</sup> minute; unlucky for visiting keeper Lee Newcomb, whose clearance hit Steve Davies and cannoned into the net. Davies potted another in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute and Allan Tait nabbed the third in added time.

A last-minute penalty by Ross Lover gave relieved Cray a 2-1 home win over Wingate, who had taken the lead on the stroke of half-time through Leon Smith and held it until only five minutes remained, when Aaron Day headed the equaliser.

It was the same score at Enfield Town, where Walton Casuals were beaten by a Liam Hope double. He opened his account on 42 minutes and added another from the spot, after his own shot had been handled, six minutes into the second half. Kristian Webb quickly pulled one back and Casuals were denied a replay only by the excellence of home keeper Darren Bonfield.

There were two other 2-1 wins, both for away teams. Kingstonian were grateful for two second-half penalties, converted by Matt Gray and Dean Lodge, at Faversham who replied with 15 minutes left through Dane Luchford.

Thamesmead scored both their goals in the first half at Great Wakering, Andy Constable and Ashley Probets the marksmen, but a 52<sup>nd</sup>-minute reply by Bradley Walsh made it a tense second half for the visitors.

The three remaining games all finished 2-0. Glenn Stanley, with a penalty, and Richard Shittu, with a header, scored second-half goals for Godalming at Fleet while a goal in each half, from Toran Senghore and Danny Rafis, saw Romford through at Waltham Forest.

Maidstone took the lead two minutes after halftime against Burgess Hill. Adrian Stone was the scorer, making up for an earlier effort which hit both posts and came out. Danny Hockton added the clincher.

### Ryman Youth League

A hat-trick in the first 18 minutes by Leigh Penny led Fleet Town to their first Ryman Youth League victory. Newcomers to the competition this season, Fleet got off the mark with a 4-2 win at Hayes & Yeading which ended their hosts' 100 per cent record in the West Division.

Hayes stayed top, ahead of Staines on goal difference, while Northwood moved up to third place with a 5-0 romp at Barnet (Black). Romaine Walker and Zain Khan each scored twice.

Another hat-trick came from Whyteleafe's Chris Webster, which he completed in the last minute of their 5-2 home victory over Leyton, who remain at the foot of the Central Division.

At the top are Kingstonian, who came from behind to beat Chipstead 2-1 on Monday and then drew 1-1 at Thamesmead on Thursday. Alistair Dewar scored the winner in the first game and the equaliser in the second.

Metropolitan Police also came from behind to win in this division, coming out on top by the odd goal in five at Sutton. Jacob Flynn put them 3-1 up with three minutes left, which meant that a last-gasp strike by Ryan Halls for Sutton was in vain.

Lewes lead a tightly-contested South-East Division in which the top six are covered by a single point. Sebastian Saunders got the only goal of their home game with Worthing, keeping them one goal ahead of Welling for whom a fifth-minute goal by Ryan Walls set up a 3-1 win at Horsham.

It was the same scoreline at Whitehawk, where the hosts suffered their first defeat. Jack Funnell wiped out their half-time lead within two minutes of the restart and Tonbridge went on to collect their first points of the season.

The other two matches in this section finished 1-1 thanks to late goals. Louis Mash netted in the 88<sup>th</sup> minute to earn Horsham YMCA a home point against Eastbourne Town while Burgess Hill left it until the third minute of added time for their equaliser at Maidstone, who were seconds away from going to the head of the table.
