FA Trophy

Wealdstone produced a superb rearguard action in Wales on Saturday to book themselves a place in the draw for the second round of the FA Trophy.

The Ryman Premier side battled their way to a 0-0 draw at Newport, lying fourth in the Conference Premier under former Redbridge boss Dean Holdsworth. Centre-back Alan Massey was at the heart of the resistance and keeper Jonathan North pulled off three superb saves as Stones held out to earn a Monday replay at Grosvenor Vale.

The only other Ryman League club to survive were Premier Division leaders Sutton, who drew 1-1 at Conference South outfit Eastleigh. Manager Paul Doswell looked set to record a victory over his former club after Craig Dundas gave Sutton a fifth-minute lead. But Tony Taggart volleyed the equaliser with five minutes left and the sides will meet again at Gander Green Lane on Tuesday.

There was no joy for the two Division One North sides left in the competition. Elvis Hammond gave Woking a 14th minute lead at Harlow and struck again with a penalty four minutes later. That was enough to give Woking a 2-0 victory, although James Peagram almost pulled one back before half-time with a shot that was cleared off the line.

Sudbury fell behind to an Ian Hodges header after only three minutes of their home tie against Hampton. They drew level against the run of play through Ryan Henshaw in the 18th

minute and then matched the visitors until Lawrence Yaku punished a defensive error shortly before half-time. Hampton took an iron grip on the tie with a James Simmonds penalty two minutes after the restart and Craig Tanner completed a 4-1 victory in the 62nd minute.

Lowestoft were on the wrong end of one of the day's shock results, going down 3-2 at home to lowly Zamaretto Division One side Uxbridge. It was a scoreline that no-one could have predicted with five minutes left, when the only goal had been a Chris Moore header for the visitors after an hour.

The Premier Division title-chasers had missed a number of chances and they were fully punished in the last few minutes as Stuart Farrell and Moore struck in quick succession to make it 3-0. Lowestoft then found their shooting boots, with Adrian Forbes and Greg Crane raising hopes of a remarkable comeback. Uxbridge had Gavin Brown sent off after the second goal but held out under heavy pressure in the closing moments.

The other contest between a Ryman Premier side and Zamaretto Division One opposition also went the way of the underdogs. Hornchurch dominated their game at Ashford (Middx) but could not break through, with Rickie Hayles and Michael Spencer both hitting the woodwork. A replay looked certain but in the 90th minute Jones Awuah, once of Aveley, fired home from ten yards to see Ashford through.

Premier Division

Horsham moved out of the bottom four in the Premier Division with a 3-2 victory at Sussex rivals Hastings – but the bare facts do not do justice to one of the most bizarre games of the season. Gary Charman fired a hat-trick for Horsham, scoring in the 12th, 42nd and 55th minutes to give them a 3-0 lead. That was remarkable enough, given that Horsham's previous 12 league goals had been shared by 11 players and Ben Andrews was their undisputed top scorer with two.

It was to get stranger. Horsham had Michael Hector and Charman sent off before Russell Eldridge pulled a goal back in the 66th minute. Nine became eight shortly afterwards when Paul Kennett was dismissed but Hastings somehow failed to profit from their three-man advantage until the 89th minute, when Kenny Pogue made it 3-2. Six minutes were added but the depleted Hornets held out.

Folkestone dropped back into the relegation zone after their 2-1 defeat at Hendon, a game which also finished with 19 men. Lubo Guentchev gave Hendon a 21st-minute lead which was wiped out by Josh Vincent early in the second half. A flare-up 18 minutes into the half brought red cards for Vincent and Hendon's Casey Maclaren. Brian Haule restored Hendon's lead on 71 minutes, his first goal since returning to the club, and Folkestone had Darren Smith sent off in the closing stages for a wild challenge.

Leigh Bremner returned to the Cray side after a six-week absence through injury and promptly hit a hat-trick as they moved up to fourth with a 4-0 home win over bottom club Croydon Athletic. The scoreline was harsh on Croydon, who conceded two goals to Bremner in the first nine minutes but then enjoyed a fair share of the game until Bremner struck again with only three minutes left. Nathan Ashton quickly added the fourth.

James Scowcroft did the damage as Bury Town moved into second place with three unanswered goals against Billericay. He scored the opener on 35 minutes, then headed against a post two minutes later for Tom Bullard to net the rebound. Sam Reed completed the scoring with eight minutes left.

The day's comeback kings were Concord, who won 4-2 at Carshalton after finding themselves 2-0 down in 13 minutes. Byron Harrison

opened the scoring with a penalty and Joel Ledgister's solo effort quickly doubled the lead. A Harry Elmes double squared it by the interval, however. Tom Stokes gave Concord a lead, by then deserved, in the 73rd minute and James Elmes wrapped it up in the closing stages.

Two much-travelled strikers were on the mark in Maidstone's 1-1 draw with Tooting. Rob Haworth headed the visitors into a 38th minute lead and Tony Boot saved a point with his first Maidstone goal in the 83rd minute.

Kingstonian had the chance to reclaim second spot on Sunday but slumped to a 3-1 home defeat by Harrow, who scored all the goals. They led 3-0 at the break through Dean Marney, Ryan Watts and Kenta Nakashima. Although Calvin King's own goal eight minutes into the second half gave K's some hope, they could not close the gap further.

Canvey entertained Division One North side Heybridge in their delayed Championship Manager Cup tie on Saturday and it was the underdogs who went through thanks to a lone goal by Tom Broadhurst with five minutes left.

Division One North

Newcomers Needham Market are on course to smash the league's goalscoring record after thrashing Leyton 8-0 in Division One North on Saturday. That made it 15 goals in two games and they reached the 50 mark in only their 14th game. If they can maintain that average they will finish with 150, eclipsing the record of 138 set by Arlesey Town in 2000-01 and equalled by Croydon Athletic the following season, both in the old Division Three.

Top scorer Craig Parker started the rout in the 13th minute with his 16th league goal and 23rd in all, but it was to be his only contribution to the scoresheet. Connor McCloskey, Daniel Thrower and Bradley Barber made it 4-0 and Christy Finch netted the fifth on the stroke of half-time, then struck again 24 seconds after the restart. Leyton then held out until Thrower scored in the 75th minute, leaving Finch to complete his hat-trick in added time.

The Marketmen are only in third place, though with plenty of games in hand. East Thurrock are the new leaders after their 3-1 home win over Potters Bar, a thrilling game decided by two late goals. Elvis Balic put the visitors ahead on the half-hour and Reiss Gilbey

replied ten minutes later. Somehow there was no more scoring until the last four minutes, when Kris Newby hit his 15th of the season and Kye Ruel clinched it.

Rocks are indebted to tenants Grays for their 1-1 draw at previous leaders Wingate & Finchley. Leon Smith missed several chances before giving Wingate the lead on 33 minutes, his 15th of the season as well. Emiel Aiken replied before the break and Grays had the better of the second half without conjuring a winner.

Maldon & Tiptree slipped out of the top three after letting a 3-1 lead slip at ten-man Thamesmead, who had Marcus Perona sent off in the seventh minute. Maldon were soon 2-0 up through Zubair Haleem and Grant Cooper and, after Ashley Probets replied with a 34th minute penalty, Joe Sweeney netted his 16th of the campaign five minutes later to restore the two-goal gap. Thamesmead made light of their shortage of manpower after the break, Richard Avery reduced the arrears with 20 minutes to go and Andy Constable made it 3-3 moments later.

Thamesmead's comeback, though, was topped by Enfield Town, who scored three times in the last five minutes, also with ten men, to snatch a 3-2 victory at Waltham Forest. It looked as if a red card for Jon Stevenson in the 62nd minute would be the decisive moment of the game, for Forest then scored twice through Ade Cole and Danny Francis. They looked set for the win that would have lifted them off the foot of the table but Liam Hope converted an 86th minute penalty and Wahid Matata made it 2-2. Much worse was to follow for Forest as Joe Ellul suffered a suspected broken leg and, in the time added on, Matata hit the winner.

Waltham Abbey moved into the top half of the table with a 4-0 home win over Tilbury. Kieron Ogunkoya almost gave them a first-minute lead, hitting the bar, and did find the net on 17 minutes. Tyler Campbell struck twice in three minutes around the half-hour and Liam Farrell wrapped it up with a 68th minute penalty after Michael Toner had become the latest Tilbury player to be sent off.

So it was Redbridge who fared best among the five teams adrift at the bottom as a Tom Stephen double earned them a 2-1 home victory against Great Woking. He netted in

each half, with Tony Martin equalising for Woking before Stephen's second.

Brentwood also won 2-1, a 79th minute goal by Steve Butterworth giving them the points against visiting Ilford. Ellis Remy had put them ahead on 33 minutes and Sam Adejokun replied 13 minutes into the second half.

Division One South

It was an action-packed Saturday in Division One South, where nine games produced 43 goals. The top three accounted for 16 of them, including another feast for leaders Leatherhead. They became the first Ryman League club to reach the 50-goal mark and Greg Andrews became the first player to hit 20 league goals as they beat Eastbourne 7-3.

It was Andrews who opened the scoring with a third-minute free-kick and Marc Elston added another before Sam Crabb netted for the visitors. Jack Macleod made it 3-1 and Tommy Hutchings completed the half-century with another free-kick on the stroke of half-time. Andrews and Hutchings stretched the lead still further after the break. Tim Rivers pulled it back to 6-2 and Matt Ferdinando grabbed another consolation in the 90th minute, though there was still time for Andrews to complete his hat-trick with a long-range shot and reach the 20 mark.

Second-placed Metropolitan Police, beaten for the first time this season in midweek, bounced back to trounce Whitstable 5-2, taking just 34 seconds to regain their confidence with a Nicky Humphrey strike. Eddie Smith, Ron Edwards and James Field made it 4-0 by the 24th minute, and Field added a fifth ten minutes into the second half. The Oystermen managed some consolation with a late Gareth Cornhill double.

Whitehawk followed up their win over the Police by beating Chatham 4-1. Joe Gattling scored twice in the first half, Wes Tate twice in the second, with Billy Shinnars replying for Chatham when they were 3-0 down.

Burgess Hill were the only team in the top nine to drop points, although Bognor's game at Chipstead was postponed. The Hillians went down 2-0 at Worthing, where they recently won 6-1 in the Championship Manager Cup. Rebels gained revenge with a second-minute header by Callum Saunders and a shot by Luke Gedling just after the hour.

Sittingbourne are within a point of the play-off spots after a comprehensive 5-0 victory at bottom club Horsham YMCA. Hicham Akhazzan put them ahead after 19 minutes and only the heroics of keeper Connor Gough prevented several more goals before the interval. Joe Horlock beat him with a free-kick early in the second half and top scorer Tom Bradbrook took his tally to 13 with two in as many minutes before substitute Jack Hooper wrapped it up.

Walton Casuals came from behind for a 4-1 home win over Whyteleafe, who made a real mess of things after Kwabena Agyei gave them an 18th minute lead. Daryl Coleman had the chance to increase their lead with a penalty but fired wide, Alec Brown was sent off just before half-time and Fred Fleming joined him in the dressing room shortly after Danny Buckle headed the equaliser. Buckle got his second from the spot, Craig Lewington made it 3-1 and Leafe's miserable day was completed when they conceded another penalty in the last minute and Buckle made the most of it to complete a hat-trick.

It was goalless for 70 minutes at Faversham before Damian Abel put the home side ahead against Godalming. Alex Waugh added another and, after Ashley Groombridge replied for G's in the 90th minute, Waugh made it 3-1.

Walton & Hersham did themselves a big favour with a 3-1 victory at Corinthian-Casuals. With the game between Fleet and Dulwich being postponed, it made them the only team in the bottom half of the table to collect any points at all. There was an exchange of penalties in the first half, Daniel Morris for Walton and Mu Maan for Casuals. Recent

signing Jean-Michel Sigere restored Walton's lead four minutes after the break and Phil Williams added the third midway through the half.

Ramsgate became the first team to complete the first half of their league programme but their 21st game finished on a low note for them as Harry Ottaway nabbed the only goal of the afternoon in the 89th minute to keep visiting Merstham in touch with the leading group.

Ryman Youth League

It was a second week without any matches in the Ryman Youth League, although Harrow Borough and Woking did manage 29 minutes on Wednesday evening, when the match that probably should never have started was halted by the referee with the scoreline goalless.

DULWICH HAMLET FC

Following the postponement of Dulwich Hamlet's FA Youth Cup Third Round match at home to Newcastle United this week, the game will now be played on Thursday, 6th January, 2011.

Another significant point of spice added to this match has been the appointment of Alan Pardew this week as the Manager of Newcastle United Football Club, as he previously was a player with the London club in 1986.

Pardew started his career in football as a part-time player in non-league football at Whyteleafe and Epsom & Ewell, whilst working as a glazier and a cab driver. He grew up as a Fulham fan and at one stage gave up football for six months whilst working in the Middle East. He returned to football at Corinthian-Casuals before later having a spell at Dulwich Hamlet. From there, in February 1986, he moved to Yeovil, then an Isthmian club, and spent just over a year in Somerset before being snapped up by Crystal Palace.

Peter Butcher recalls seeing him play for Corinthian-Casuals on a very wet night at Horsham in November 1983. Pardew scored in a 4-3 win, as did future England midfielder Andy Gray and south London legend Bernie Merron.

HASTINGS UNITED FC

Hastings United Chairman Dave Walters on Sunday afternoon confirmed that Tony Dolby's second stint as manager of the Club had come to an end, twenty-four hours after the U's 3-2 defeat against eight man Horsham at the Pilot Field.

Having assembled what was widely considered to be a much improved squad during pre-season, Dolby had been confident of building on last year's seventh place finish in the Premier Division, and a five match unbeaten start to the 2010/11 campaign seemed to support the notion that United could even challenge for automatic promotion.

But after suffering their first defeat of the season against title favourites Sutton, the U's were dumped out of the FA Cup at the first hurdle by Division One South side Bognor, and a run of just two wins in twenty games in all competitions has seen them slide down the table to the brink of the relegation zone, and

exit the FA Trophy and the Sussex Senior Cup at home to lower league opponents.

Yesterday's extraordinary Sussex derby defeat proved to be the final straw for Dolby, and the Club itself, with the two parties agreeing by mutual consent to go their separate ways, whilst it is sadly anticipated that one or two other members of the current playing squad may follow Jamie Cade's decision to quit the Club, with budgets still being closely monitored in light of increasingly dwindling attendances.
