WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Much hard work enabled Carshalton's Premier Division derby against Sutton to go ahead and it was Sutton who made the most of it with a 2-0 victory which takes them six points clear at the top of the table.

They made the breakthrough moments before half-time with a header by Andy Forbes and Bradley Woods-Garness added the second, also with his head, ten minutes after the restart.

Carshalton's reward for their efforts was a four-figure crowd, with 1.052 fans going through the Colston Avenue turnstiles.

The only other Premier Division game also produced a 2-0 away victory, for Cray at Margate. It was goalless for 62 minutes until Mark Willy claimed the opener, and Laurent Hamici hit his 17th goal of the season two minutes later. Of those, 14 have come in the league and he is three clear of Kingstonian's Bobby Traynor in the race for the Premier Division's golden boot.

The victory means that Cray finish their 150th anniversary year in third place, the highest they have ever been.

Division One North

All games were postponed in Division One North.

Division One South

Three matches were played in Division One South and there was no joy for new Horsham YMCA manager John Cumberbatch. The former Ashford Town boss took over a team at the foot of the table, with the league's worst defensive record by a distance.

Cumberbatch had an early chance to assess his side's defensive woes as they crashed to a 6-1 defeat at Whitehawk, who themselves moved into second place, a point behind leaders Leatherhead who have two matches in hand. Four Hawks players netted their tenth goals of the season in all competitions during the afternoon.

It could have been worse: Josh Jones, Paul Armstrong and Jamahl Hughes made it 3-0 after only 19 minutes, each of them taking their personal tallies into double figures. Armstrong's strike made Hawks the third team to reach 50 Ryman League goals. Hughes struck again on the half-hour but there was some consolation for YM when Gavin Gordon scored three minutes before half-time.

Wes Tate restored Hawks' command with goals in the 50th and 56th minutes, the second of them being his tenth of the season as well.

Hawks thus became the league's top scorers with 54, one more than Leatherhead and four more than Division One North side Needham Market.

It was a different story for the side above YMCA in the table as managerless Whitstable grabbed all three points at home to Ramsgate with a dramatic Stuart Vahid goal in the fourth minute of added time. They should have gone ahead in the first half when James Gregory brought down Lloyd Blackman. But Rams keeper Jack Smelt parried Ian Pulman's penalty and blocked his follow-up effort. Smelt pulled off another fine save from the same player shortly afterwards, and Pulman's unhappy first half was complete when his lob hit the bar.

A Mark Lovell header that flew narrowly wide in the second half was as close as Rams would come and the game looked destined to finish goalless as it passed the 90-minute mark. The Oystermen then introduced Vahid for Pulman and the switch paid off as the newcomer turned in a cross from Michael Yianni to win it.

The points were not enough to lift Whitstable out of the relegation zone. They remain

behind Corinthian-Casuals, but now by just a single goal.

One fixture guaranteed to attract a big crowd is a Sussex coast derby between Worthing and Bognor, and 676, almost 300 more than the previous best crowd in the division this season, turned up at Woodside Road to see the renewal of their rivalry. It was their first league meeting for eight seasons and finished with honours even at 2-2.

Bognor started brightly but it was Worthing who took the lead in the 28th minute with a curling 20-yard free-kick by John Lansdale. Luke Nightingale headed the equaliser soon after half-time, only for Rebels to regain the lead in the 64th minute through Callum Saunders, who followed up to score after his initial effort had been parried by keeper Craig Stoner.

Promotion-chasing Rocks saved a point with six minutes left when the ever-reliable Jason Prior headed his 16th goal of the season from a cross by former Worthing favourite Ben Johnson.
