LEAGUE NEWS

LEYTON FOOTBALL CLUB

An Extraordinary General Meeting of Ryman Football League clubs voted unanimously on Sunday morning (20th February) to expel Division One North club Leyton.

The club have been suspended for some time because of debts to the League and had indicated their wish to withdraw their first team while continuing to play in the Youth League, a proposal the other clubs found unacceptable.

Leyton joined the league in 2002 as champions of the Essex Senior League and were promoted in the next two seasons before finishing fifth in the Premier Division in 2004/05 and reaching the play-off final, where they lost to Eastleigh.

Three years later they were 33 points adrift at the foot of the Premier Division and, with their off-field problems growing, they finished 21st in Division One North last season, escaping relegation because VCD Athletic were expelled for failing to meet ground grading requirements.

WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Lowestoft ended their six-match winless run in gr-eight style on Saturday, thrashing Hendon 8-1 at Crown Meadow. Seven players shared the goals, beginning with Michael Frew who converted Scott Mitchell's cross in the fifth minute.

Mitchell was again the supplier when Matt Nolan headed the second on 16 minutes but Hendon were still in the picture until they were hit by a burst of three goals in as many minutes either side of half-time. Joe Francis and Nolan made it 4-0 at the break and Mitchell added the fifth 40 seconds after the restart.

Belal Aite-Ouakrim pulled one back in the 53rd minute to provide the visitors with some consolation. But the rout continued in the 65th minute when substitute Russell Stock scored with his first touch. James Burgess deflected a cross into his own net for the seventh on 80 minutes and Jamie Godbold wrapped it up a minute later.

The Trawlerboys moved up two places to fourth, while Kingstonian made the opposite move, falling behind Billericay on goal difference after going down 3-1 at home to Wealdstone. A long-range shot by Kurtney Brookes gave Stones an early lead which Peter Dean doubled before half-time after good work by Richard Jolly, who now returns to Sutton after his productive one-month loan spell which yielded ten goals.

Paul Vines pulled one back six minutes after the break, his first goal since joining K's, and the home side looked capable of taking a point until the second minute of added time, when Alex Dyer was brought down and Dean scored from the spot.

Sutton reopened the eight-point gap at the top with a lone Leroy Griffiths goal at third-placed Tonbridge. Craig Dundas went close more than once and was involved in the move from which Griffiths netted the all-important goal 11 minutes after half-time.

With seven matches falling victim to heavy rain, the only other action was at Colston Avenue, where Carshalton and Horsham failed

to score. Horsham's Billy Dunn came closest, hitting the bar in the second half.

Division One North

Both Division One North games to survive the weather on Saturday were drawn, with three of the top five involved in those matches.

Third hosted fifth at Wingate where the home side scored in the 90th minute to snatch a 2-2 draw with Enfield Town. David Laird gave Wingate the lead with a penalty on the half-hour. Liam Hope replied ten minutes later and then put his side ahead with a 75th minute penalty, only for Lewis Jones to square it again after a good move.

It was 1-1 at fourth-placed Maldon, where struggling Ilford picked up a useful point. Jan Skonieczki gave them the lead from a corner moments before half-time and Dean Standen replied for Maldon in the 63rd minute.

Division One South

Leaders Bognor took a first-minute lead against lowly Corinthian-Casuals on Saturday but could only draw 2-2 after an equaliser deep into added time. Luke Nightingale's header gave Rocks their flying start, only for Glenn Boosey to level matters on 28 minutes. Casuals almost went ahead when Shaun Lucien hit the bar, but Bognor thought they were off the hook when Jason Prior restored their lead with an 87th-minute penalty.

The visitors refused to surrender, however, and Scott Hassell punished some careless defending in the 93rd minute to earn his side a point which was not enough to lift them out of the bottom two.

Only five matches survived in the division, but most of the clubs fighting relegation were in action and there were important wins for Fleet and Godalming.

Fleet let a two-goal lead slip at home to fellow-strugglers Whitstable before Jamie McClurg struck a 73rd-minute winner. Darren Campbell scored one and made the other for McClurg as Fleet went two up inside half an hour but the Oystermen, much improved of late, hit back with a Lloyd Blackman double, the second a penalty, in the first five minutes of the second half.

Dave Stevens broke the deadlock a minute after half-time and struck again midway through the half to earn Godalming a 2-0

victory at Horsham YMCA, who are now nine points adrift at the bottom.

Third-placed Whitehawk were 3-1 home winners over Dulwich. Sam Gargan put them ahead after two minutes and Craig Richards notched the second in the 25th minute. It looked as if it would finish like that, but Karl Akehurst added a third on 89 minutes and Calvin Morath-Gibbs provided last-gasp consolation for the visitors.

Burgess Hill, in fifth place, allowed visiting Chatham to escape with a 1-1 draw. Will Berry put Hillians ahead nine minutes before half-time but they could not manage another goal and Joe Fuller levelled it with 19 minutes left.

Ryman Youth League

The top four teams in the West Division of the Ryman Youth League went head to head this week, and the action certainly did not disappoint those who watched it as the two games yielded 16 goals.

Nine of those were at Staines, where George Isaac's hat-trick for Hayes & Yeading was trumped by Troy Raymond's foursome as the hosts won 5-4. Raymond and Che Masroh-McDowell gave Staines a 2-0 lead inside 20 minutes and although Isaac opened his account on the stroke of half-time, Raymond struck again in the 53rd minute to put Staines 3-1 up.

Far from downhearted, Hayes pulled one back through Bobby Cumber and took the lead with 11 minutes to go as Isaac completed his treble. Raymond promptly equalised and then claimed a last-minute winner which kept his side on top of the table.

Woking beat Ashford (Middx) 4-3, with Jack Mazzone scoring twice for them and Mitchell Fountain doing the same for the visitors. Perry Luckins brought Ashford level in the 90th minute but there was still time for Woking to snatch a winner.

When the dust had settled Staines, Woking, Hayes and Ashford were the top four in that order, with a tidy three-point gap between each of them.

One other match in the division pitted the two Barnet sides against each other and a double by Junior Lawrence enabled the Ambers to keep their Black clubmates at the foot of the table with a 3-2 victory.

With the weather again biting deeply into the programme, only two other fixtures took place, both in the Central Division. Matthew Robinson got both goals as runaway leaders Kingstonian went ten points clear with a 2-0 win at Metropolitan Police, while Brendan Murphy-M'cKey netted twice in Carshalton's 3-1 victory at Thamesmead.
