WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

They say a change is as good as a rest, and it certainly seems to be true of Sutton marksman Richard Jolly. Sent on a one-month loan to Wealdstone after a lean spell, Jolly scored ten goals during his stay at Grosvenor Vale and struck twice more as he returned to his parent club on Saturday.

His double helped the Premier Division leaders to thrash Maidstone 5-1, opening up a tenpoint gap at the top, and it also made him the division's top scorer with 18 league goals between his two clubs. Maidstone, 21st in the table, thought it might be their lucky day when they conceded a penalty after only 15 seconds and Craig Dundas's kick was saved by Andy Walker. Dundas followed up, Walker saved again and Leroy Griffiths, who had won the penalty, fired the loose ball against a post.

But it was false hope for the visitors. Darren Ebsworth's free-kick put Sutton ahead after 24 minutes and Jolly opened his account seven minutes later. He got his second in the 56th minute, Leroy Griffiths made it four shortly afterwards and although substitute Gary Wharton managed a consolation for the visitors it was Sutton who had the last word through Bradley Woods-Garness.

That was one of only three Premier Division games to take place as heavy rain again ravaged the programme – and in all three of them the eventual winners missed a penalty at a potentially crucial stage.

Lowestoft's culprit at Horsham was Matt Nolan, whose weak kick was saved by Mark Zawadski shortly after Michael Frew had given the Trawlerboys a tenth-minute lead. It looked as if the miss might be costly when Williams Peauroux levelled matters just before halftime. But Frew struck again 11 minutes after the break and superb goalkeeping by Andy Reynolds did the rest as the Hornets pressed for an equaliser in the closing stages. The 2-1 victory allowed Lowestoft to regain third place.

Duane Jackman's misfortune proved to be a stroke of luck for Hornchurch as they climbed three placed to eighth by winning 3-1 at Concord. The game was no more than ten seconds old when Jackman slid heavily into a fencepost and suffered a knee injury which required a hospital trip. But his replacement, Jonathan Hunt, proceeded to score twice.

His first came after 15 minutes, although he then had a penalty saved by Dale Brightly and it was 1-1 when Tony Stokes replied five minutes before the interval. Hunt restored the lead midway through the second half with a cross that was over the line before Rickie Hayles made sure. Martin Tuohy added the third eight minutes from time, ending a run of 13 games without a goal for the usually-prolific scorer.

Division One North

Earlier this month Enfield Town won 6-0 at Brentwood in Division One North. The teams met again at Enfield on Saturday and Brentwood gained a measure of revenge with a 1-0 victory. But it would have been no great injustice if Brentwood had reversed that previous scoreline.

They dominated the game, with Ryan Edgar and Steve Butterworth both hitting the inside of a post, but could not find the net until the 83rd minute when Edgar was brought down and Ryan Doyle converted the penalty.

Brentwood moved up to fifth and into the playoff places, while Heybridge maintained their progress with a 2-0 home win over Potters Bar which lifted them to sixth spot. They scored midway through each half with Luke Callander playing a part in Reece Morgan's opener and heading the second himself.

The only other game to beat the rain was at Tilbury, where Sudbury maintained their playoff hopes by coming from behind to win 2-1. Debutant Chas Liddiard put Dockers ahead after 14 minutes with a goal originally credited to Ben Bradbury and they stayed in front until two minutes after half-time, when Dave Wareham squared it.

It was not to be Bradbury's day: he was sent off after 65 minutes and Wareham struck again ten minutes later with a 20-yard drive to give his side all three points.

Division One South

A goal by James Field four minutes into added time earned Metropolitan Police a 3-2 win at Chatham yesterday (Saturday) and lifted them to within a point of Division One South leaders Bognor with a game in hand. Jason Barton gave Chats a half-time lead which was wiped out 12 minutes after the break by Matt Gray, his first goal since his recent move from Kingstonian.

Steve Sutherland then headed the Met into the lead but Barton thought he had salvaged a point for the home side when he notched his second in the 84th minute. Field had other ideas, latching on to a free-kick to grab the last-gasp winner.

Faversham had a chance of moving into the top five but went down 2-1 at Chipstead, for whom Lee Coburn claimed an 81st-minute decider. Liam Grier had given Chips a first-half lead which they retained until the break thanks to Coburn's goalline clearance. Justin Ascheri made it 1-1 in the 65th minute, only for Coburn to leave them pointless.

Worthing, twice two goals behind, rallied to draw 3-3 with Merstham at Woodside Road. Sean Rivers scored after six minutes for the visitors and struck even earlier in the second half. Callum Saunders pulled one back in the 54th minute only for Harry Ottaway to make it 3-1 moments later. Saunders struck again on 61 minutes and Terry Dodd headed the equaliser with 20 minutes to go. Further goals seemed likely but the score remained deadlocked.

The only other action in this division was at Eastbourne, and that lasted only an hour before persistent rain brought proceedings to an end with the match against Horsham YMCA all square at 1-1. Dean Brooks put Town ahead after 15 minutes and Ashley Robinson replied nine minutes later against the club with whom he started the season before a brief spell at Hastings.

Ryman Youth League

Woking went to the top of the Ryman Youth League's West Division this week after a 3-1 home win over Hayes & Yeading. Two second-half goals by Jack Mazzone saw them home after George Isaac had put Hayes on terms at the interval, replying to George Frith's opener. Hampton scored twice in added time at the end of the first half to take a 3-1 lead at Harrow, which proved to be the final score. Gustave Sousa put Hampton ahead after only two minutes and Dan Tomlin equalised in the 40th minute. Then came those quickfire efforts from Sousa and Ryan Petruzziello.

South-East Division leaders Whitehawk cemented their position with a home victory over Maidstone, who would have taken over at the top themselves had they won. Matt Daniel claimed the only goal of the game midway through the first half.

The chief threat to Hawks could now come from unbeaten Lewes, who remained five points behind them with two games in hand after their 4-1 win at Worthing. Layton Schaaf gave Lewes a first-minute lead but there were no further scoring until the 70th minute, when George Murphy made it 1-1. That provoked a final flourish from the visitors with Seb Saunders, Schaaf and Max Howell all finding the net.

The weather had the final word elsewhere as seven league games and three in the Lucas Fettes Cup were added to the season's lengthy list of postponements.
