CROYDON ATHLETIC FOOTBALL CLUB

Since the Ryman Football League's Press Release dated 5th September, the League and the Football Association have been working closely with both the Club and interested parties in efforts to assist Croydon Athletic Football Club with its present problems.

The League have re-scheduled the Premier Division match Aveley vs. Croydon Athletic from Monday 20th September to Friday 24th September, 2010, kick-off 7.45 p.m., to allow the Club a few more days to finalise any arrangements regarding the future of the Club and satisfy the various requirements of both the Ryman Football League and the Football Association.

Ryman Football League Chairman Alan Turvey commented, "Every effort has been made to assist the club at this difficult time in the best interest of everyone. It is unlikely that the League will extend the deadline that has been given and fully understood by the Club and all interested parties. The Club must be able to demonstrate that it will be able to complete the current season and place a financial bond with the League prior to the deadline."

WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Premier Division strikers dozed off for the second time this season on Saturday. At least on opening day, when 12 of the 22 teams failed to score, the rest managed 23 goals between them.

This weekend there were just 13 goals in a 10 match programme and half the teams were unable to find the net. Only five were scored in the first half and three came in the last five minutes.

Two of those were at Harrow, where home keeper Nick Jupp and his Billericay counterpart Nicky Morgan shone. The deadlock was finally broken by Rocky Baptiste in the 85th minute, only for new Billericay signing Hakeem Araba to make it 1-1 with a 90th minute penalty.

Another goalkeeper in form was Bury Town's Marcus Garnham as he defended a third-minute lead provided by Chris Henderson in their home game against Hastings. Bury-born James Scowcroft, veteran of 494 Football League appearances, netted his first goal for his home-town club in the 75th minute and although Sean Ray replied in the 89th minute Bury survived a lengthy period of added time. Unbeaten Bury moved into third place, a point behind leaders Sutton who had no game.

Second spot, ahead of Bury on goal difference, belongs to their Suffolk rivals Lowestoft for whom a scorching shot by Jamie Forshaw on the half-hour was enough for the points at home to Aveley, still seeking their first win.

Aveley are down to 21st after Maidstone recorded their own first win of the season, a surprise but deserved 1-0 success at Kingstonian. Ant Bodle scored after 16 minutes and Bobby Traynor missed the best chance to equalise for K's, who had Tom Bird sent off towards the end.

Carshalton wondered if they were set for a frustrating afternoon when Paul Johnson and Chris Henry hit the Tooting bar in the space of a single early minute. Johnson, however, put them in front with a 26th minute header and, after they hit the bar again through David Ray, Byron Harrison made it 2-0 midway through

the second half. He and Johnson have scored four league goals apiece, the rest of the Carshalton squad just one between them.

Lee Browning's goal on the stroke of half-time paved the way for Tonbridge's 2-1 victory at Concord. Frannie Collin added another in the 64th minute. Harry Elmes pulled one back with 11 minutes left and, although Concord had Ashley Miller sent off shortly afterwards, it took two fine saves by Lee Worgan to deny them a point.

Margate were another Kent club to collect a maximum. Ishmail Kamara missed a penalty shortly before half-time in their home game with Wealdstone but James Pinnock made up for it when he headed home in the 69th minute.

Hendon had a chance to draw level with Sutton at the top but could only manage a goalless draw at Hornchurch. Lubo Guentchev hit a Hornchurch post in the second half and later missed the most open of goals. In between those two incidents Hendon keeper Berkley Laurencin dived full length to save Jonathan Hunt's penalty.

There were two other goalless draws, both uneventful; at Cray, where Canvey were the visitors, and at Horsham, where Folkestone provided the opposition. Horsham might have wished for a little more entertainment for a crowd of 650, the Ryman League's biggest of the day, boosted by a 'kids for free' promotion.

Division One North

Saturday's match of the day was at Sudbury, where a last-gasp own goal allowed Grays to escape with a 3-3 draw. After a poor, scrappy first half the afternoon came to life when Jared Small gave the visitors a 54th minute lead. Simon Thomas made it 2-0 and Sudbury looked doomed until Ryan Henshaw opened their account with 15 minutes left. Henshaw then equalised in the 84th minute and when Lee Townrow put Sudbury ahead two minutes later a superb comeback seemed complete. Not so: Jack Wignall got his head to an Ishmael Welsh free-kick and the ball sailed into his own net to leave it all square.

East Thurrock remain a point clear at the top after a comfortable 3-0 home win over Ware, who had Matt Turpin sent off in the second half. Kye Ruel gave Rocks a half-time lead and several more might have followed before Steve Sheehan made it 2-0 on 75 minutes and Martin Llewellyn added a late third.

Needham Market remain a point adrift in second place after a 2-1 win at Harlow. Rhys Barber put them ahead midway through the first half and Craig Parker claimed his eighth goal of the season from the penalty spot after 35 minutes. Harlow replied two minutes later through Clark Akers and would have been level soon after half-time but for Sos Yao's penalty miss.

Heybridge are up to third after romping to a 4-1 victory at Ilford. But it took a goal by Ilford's Josh Coulson three minutes after the interval to spark Swifts into life. They were soon ahead with two goals in as many minutes from Chris Bryan and Ricky Griggs and the same pair later repeated the quickfire double act, this time with Griggs getting the first of them.

Ilford remain at the foot of the table, with just a single point, and neighbours Redbridge are ahead of them only on goal difference after their 1-0 defeat at Waltham Abbey. The 13th minute of the second half was unlucky for Motormen as Kieran Ogunkoya netted to give Abbey their first league win of the season at the seventh attempt, though they have banked four draws.

Tilbury have released forward Ben Boyce after his 27th minute dismissal in their home game with Enfield Town. It was his second red card in three games and Tilbury's fifth of the season. Dockers held out until half-time, but Craig McKay broke the deadlock in the 54th minute and Danny Forward doubled Enfield's lead two minutes later. Rudi Hall converted a penalty on 86 minutes, his 100th goal for Enfield, and Forward made it 4-0.

There were four goals, too, for Maldon, and the day's only hat-trick. Joe Sweeney was the marksman, with goals after 15, 22 and 54 minutes in their 4-1 home win over Waltham Forest. Lawrence Yiga pulled it back to 2-1 on the half-hour, following up after his penalty was saved, only for Dean Standen to reestablish the two-goal gap four minutes later.

There were two penalties and a red card in the first half of Thamesmead's 1-1 draw with Romford. The visitors were reduced to ten men after only ten minutes when James Ishmael was harshly dismissed for a handling offence, though sympathy did not prevent Gabriel Momodu converting the penalty. Romford replied five minutes before half-time when Paul Kavanagh scored from the spot and

the home side could not make their extra man count in the second half.

Another 1-1 draw was at Leyton, where Billy Johnson rescued Great Wakering with five minutes left. The lively Sol Patterson-Bohner hit the bar in the first five minutes for the hosts but they had to wait until the 68th minute for their goal, which came from Stefan Cox.

Potters Bar were on top for long periods in their game at Cheshunt but it was the hosts who scored the only goal seven minutes after the interval through Graeme Dearie.

Brentwood had the chance to climb into the top four by winning at Wingate on Sunday but they went down 2-1 after Dean Green put them ahead in the 23rd minute lead against the run of play. Josh Cooper's angled shot levelled the scores ten minutes later and a 66th minute penalty by Gary Burrell proved to be the winner thanks in part to his own goalline clearance as the visitors launched a late assault.

Division One South

Horsham YMCAS became the last Ryman League team to open their account for the season with a 2-1 home win over Whyteleafe on Sunday. They began to think it might be their day when Gavin Gordon scored just before half-time. Jory Collewijn doubled the lead in the 75th minute and, although Chris O'Flaherty pulled one back with eight minutes left, YM held on to three points which lifted them off the foot of the table.

It was an eventful Saturday for Ramsgate's Warren Schulz, who scored twice is as many minutes early in their home game with Burgess Hill. Alas for Schulz, the score after his quickfire double was 1-1, his first strike having put the visitors ahead. Lloyd Cotton put Hillians ahead again five minutes before half-time and Schultz was denied an unusual hattrick by the bar – at the right end – before Steve Harper completed a 3-1 win which lifted the Sussex club into third place. Mitch Sherwood missed a penalty for Ramsgate but it was, anyway, too late to give them a chance of a point.

Out in front are Metropolitan Police, who made it six wins out of six with three unanswered goals at Merstham. They were kept at bay until the last minute of the first half, when Craig Watkins made the breakthrough. James Field added two in the second half and

a late goalline clearance prevented Merstham doubling the total in the Met's 'against' column.

Leatherhead's Greg Andrews became the first player this season to reach the seven-goal mark in Ryman League matches this season, burying two first-half penalties in a 2-1 home win over Whitehawk which kept the Tanners in second spot. The first came after 18 minutes when Liam Pestle was brought down, an offence for which Sam Fisk saw red. Rob Hill was fouled to provide Andrews with his second shortly before the interval. The ten men pulled one back with a Jamahl Hughes solo in the 72nd minute and Ben Godfrey almost grabbed a late leveller.

Glenn Boosey also scored twice from the spot. The Corinthian-Casuals forward, who scored 18 goals last season, opened his account for the current campaign with a 33rd minute penalty and repeated the trick after 74 minutes. But visiting Whitstable replied on each occasion, through lan Pulman and Danny Wisker, to claim a 2-2 draw.

Sherwood was not the only reliable penalty-taker to suffer a rare miss. Godalming's Glenn Stanley failed to convert from the spot in the second half and that was their best chance of recovering from two goals by visiting Sittingbourne in the first 12 minutes. Hicham Akhazzan and Tom Bradbrook were the men on target, and 2-0 it stayed.

Bognor's Jason Prior, who netted 22 goals last season even through they were relegated from the Premier Division, scored his first league goals this time round – he has three in the FA Cup – as they beat Chatham 3-1 at Nye wood Lane. Both came in the first half, and Luke Nightingale added another on 75 minutes before Uche Ibemere managed a late reply for Chatham – slim consolation for their third defeat in a week after a promising start to the season.

Managerless Walton & Hersham were beaten 2-0 at Dulwich Hamlet, conceding a goal in each half. Teenager Nyren Clunis got the first and Sol Pinnock clinched it.

Worthing's Terry Dodd hit his eighth goal in all competitions to give his side the lead after 23 minutes at Faversham. He has notched his tally – matched only by Johnnie Dyer of Fleet and Needham Market's Craig Parker – despite

missing three games after a dismissal. Matt Geard made it 2-0 five minutes later and it was plain sailing for the Rebels until an own goal by Tony Timms gave Faversham hope with ten minutes left. Dane Luchford made it 2-2 three minutes later and Worthing finished on the back foot.

Walton Casuals left it late to claim their 2-1 home victory over Chipstead. Danny Buckle's eighth-minute strike for the hosts was answered by a Jason Thompson penalty after 18 and it looked as if that would be that until Alex Brown headed in an 89th minute free-kick.

Eastbourne Town left it even later. Visiting Fleet, who gave a debut to New Zealand international Chad Coombes, were set to take the points with a 67th minute effort from Mark Anderson, only for Danny Simmonds to make it 1-1 with a free-kick in added time.

Ryman Youth League

A hat-trick by Hampton's Dwaine Critchlow was the best individual feat of the week as the Ryman Youth League campaign moved into full swing. The treble led Hampton to a 4-0 home win over Barnet (Amber) in their West Division opener.

Match of the week was at Carshalton, where the hosts led 3-1 at half-time after conceding an early goal. Visiting Whyteleafe hit back and. after Chris Webster made it 3-3 with 15 minutes left, late strikes by Peter Sherlock and Webster gave Leafe a 5-3 victory.

The top scorers were Sutton, who thumped Leyton 6-0 with two goals apiece for Ope Fashoro and Michael Bello.
