WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Horsham, the last Premier Division team without a victory to their credit this season, broke their duck on Saturday with a 1-0 victory at Maidstone in a battle of the bottom two. Mark Knee claimed the vital goal with a wind-assisted free-kick from long range in the 18th minute. It was not enough to lift Hornets off the foot off the table but they now trail their victims only on goal difference.

LEAGUE NEWS

Aveley had achieved their first win on Friday night, scoring three late goals to beat a valiant Croydon Athletic side consisting of one player who was with them at the start of the season, Jeremy Williams, a 39-year-old goalkeeper in Glyn Shimell who has played only veterans' football for the past three years, and nine eager youngsters.

Dave Garland and Bob Langford, who were the club's management team for most of 2008, have returned as caretakers. They are working free of charge and want to hear from any players who are happy to turn out for nothing while taking the opportunity to put themselves in the shop window.

The side they fielded for Athletic's first outing since 4th September certainly gave a good account of themselves and, apart from a header by David Knight that was cleared off the line, Aveley rarely threatened until they managed to open their account in the 81st minute when Luke Stanley hit a post and Kurt Smith was first to the rebound. The disappointed visitors then conceded two more in the next five minutes, a header by Marc Gorbell and an Orlando Smith penalty.

Division One North

AFC Sudbury had the chance to improve their position in Division One North on Saturday when they were the only team in the top ten with a league fixture. But they failed to capitalise, moving up only one place, to seventh, after a 1-1 draw at Leyton. The hosts have started the season better than many expected and they took the lead through Taurean Roberts in the 33rd minute. Dave Collins fired in a free-kick to square matters

just before half-time but that was the end of the scoring.

Thamesmead moved into the top half of the table with a 3-0 home win over Waltham Abbey. Andy Constable, who scored 25 times last season, broke his duck for the current campaign when he put them ahead after 19 minutes and Gabriel Momodu soon added a second. Constable struck again soon after half-time and missed several chances to complete a hat-trick.

Tilbury, who have had six players sent off this season, for once found themselves with a man advantage in their game at Cheshunt, who had David Hicks dismissed early in the second half. Dockers had taken the lead through Bobby Port eight minutes before the break but Cheshunt seemed to have shaken off their shortage of manpower when Asare Osei-Owusu equalised in the 89th minute. The celebrations were halted when Ibrahim Conteh struck in the third minute of added time to give Tilbury a 2-1 win.

Potters Bar goalkeeper Shane McWeeney was the hero of their 2-2 home draw with Great Wakering, charging forward to get his head to a 90th minute free-kick and set up the chance for Jake Parratt to make it 2-2. Wakering had taken the lead in each half through Bradley Walsh and Joe Gardner, with Elvis Balic getting the first leveller for the hosts.

A desperate challenge by Waltham Forest's Des Thomas five minutes before half-time effectively settled their game at Ware. Thomas was dismissed for his attempt to halt Luke Marshall, who converted the resultant penalty to open the scoring. Marshall struck again on the hour to complete a 2-0 victory, though his afternoon finished on a stretcher after he suffered a calf injury.

Division One South

Leatherhead made the most of Metropolitan Police's FA Cup involvement to take over at the head of the Division One South table with a 3-0 home win over Faversham. Tommy Hutchings gave them a half-time lead and Greg Andrews maintained his prolific form with his ninth goal of the season after 70 minutes. Marc Elston wrapped it up from long range.

The top two now have a considerable advantage over third-placed Godalming, who crashed to a 4-0 defeat at Dulwich. The first

goal did not arrive until the 69th minute, when Jason Pinnock broke the deadlock. Godalming then had Graeme Purdy sent off and Dulwich profited with three goals in the last ten minutes. Impressive youngster Nyren Clunis made it 2-0 before Sol Pinnock celebrated his 100th appearance for the club with the third and Alim Sesay wrapped it up.

Sittingbourne, who failed to win any of their first four league games, climbed to fourth place with their fourth successive victory, 2-0 at Ramsgate. Joe Hurlock's solo goal gave them the lead after 32 minutes and Ryan Golding added the second 12 minutes after the break.

Dale Marvell lived up to his name for Merstham, scoring late in each half to secure a 3-1 home win over bottom club Corinthian-Casuals. Tony Reid had opened the scoring midway through the first half and Marvell's second goal ended a brief Casuals rally in which Mu Maan reduced the arrears after 76 minutes.

Horsham YMCA were seeking their third win of the week when they travelled to Walton Casuals but went down 2-0. Both goals came in the first half-hour; Laurie Walters suffered an injury shortly after opening the scoring and substitute Craig Totton netted the second.

Whyteleafe were bitter after their 3-2 home defeat by Eastbourne, claiming that Peter Cooper had handled before hitting the 87th minute winner. Leafe had taken the lead in each half, though Josh Smith and Dean Gunner, but conceded two penalties which were converted by Ashley Robinson, taking his goal tally for the season to eight.

Struggling Walton & Hersham also led twice before going down 3-2 at ten-man Chatham. Bernard Asante and Kenny Ojukwu had put Swans ahead but on each occasion Chatham replied quickly, Jason Barton and Joe Fuller their marksmen. The dismissal of Kevin Watson made it harder for them but Nick Hegley notched the decider with nine minutes left.

FA Cup

Play it again . . . that was the theme of Saturday's FA Cup action, when ten of the 19 ties involving Ryman League clubs went to replays. Only four Ryman clubs booked their place in the third qualifying round, and banked

the £4,500 prize money, at the first attempt, and three of them beat fellow Ryman clubs.

Whitehawk stood alone by beating outside opposition, and even their 6-2 victory at Zamaretto League side Burnham was closer to a replay than it looks. The gap was a slender one until Hawks netted three times in the last five minutes, two goals by Joe Gatting – completing his hat-trick – sandwiching one by Jamie Brotherton.

Burnham took a first-half lead which Gatting wiped out a minute before the interval. Then Karl Akehurst put Hawks in front after 66 minutes only for Burnham to reply within seconds with Ryan Bird's second of the game. Ben Godfrey's 75th minute effort put Hawks ahead to stay and their final flourish gave them their second six-hit in five days and took their tally of FA Cup goals to 15.

Two Premier Division sides went through against Division One strugglers. Canvey took 85 minutes to score the only goal of their home tie against Whitstable, Alex Rhodes the marksman, while a goal in each half, from Rocky Baptiste and Kurt Morlese, saw Harrow through at Redbridge who pulled it back to 2-1 with a last-gasp goal from the pleasantly-named Pele Salmon.

The other winners, almost inevitably, were Metropolitan Police. They took their perfect season's record into double figures, though they had to come from behind to beat Division One South rivals Burgess Hill 2-1. Steve Harper's 22nd minute penalty gave Hillians a lead they held for 16 minutes. Then Edeie Smith levelled the scores, and Craig Watkins nabbed the winner just after the hour. It took the Met until February to achieve their tenth win in league and cup matches last season.

Six of the drawn matches were all-Ryman affairs, with perhaps the most surprising result coming at Needham Market where the free-scoring Division One North leaders were held to a 0-0 draw by mid-table One South side Chipstead. It meant an end to Craig Parker's scoring run: he had found the net in each of his side's nine matches this season but the crossbar denied him late in this game.

Concord held the lead for most of their Essex derby at Billericay thanks to a seventh-minute effort from James Lawson. A twice-taken Dave Collis penalty squared it with nine

minutes left, though the hosts had Ian Cousins sent off shortly afterwards.

Grays left it later: Alex Osborn netted with six minutes left to give them a 2-2 draw at Bury Town. Stephen Demetriou put the Division One side ahead five minutes before half-time but the Premier hosts replied through Sam Reed just after the break and took the lead ten minutes later with a Chris Henderson penalty.

Two other One North clubs held Premier opposition. Kris Newby's 78th minute goal for East Thurrock earned them a 1-1 home draw with Carshalton, who had taken the lead with an Anthony Joseph goal in the 37th minute.

Brentwood battled out a dull 0-0 draw at Hornchurch, where the only noteworthy event was a fine full-length save by Brentwood keeper Andy Hall from a Martin Tuohy header.

Both goals came in the space of one minute in the middle of the first half of the all-Premier clash at Margate, where James Pinnock's goal for the home side was immediately answered by Bobby Traynor for Kingstonian.

Fleet must replay despite taking the lead in each half at Bashley. Marc Kleboe and Darren Wheeler, with a penalty, were their marksmen in a 2-2 draw.

It was the same scoreline in Wealdstone's trip to Chesham, where the hosts had John Kyriakou sent off after only 13 minutes but salvaged a replay with a goal deep into injury time. They had gone ahead soon after the dismissal; Greg Ngoyi equalised in the 35th minute and Scott Fitzgerald made it 2-1 with 13 minutes left. Steve Wales grabbed the 97th minute equaliser, after which Chesham were reduced to nine men when Danny Talbot received a second yellow card.

Cray also drew 2-2 thanks to a last-minute penalty save by Dave King from Ashley Carew. It was a creditable result against high-flying Conference South visitors Gravesend. The Ryman club came from behind with goals by Danny Phillips and Laurent Hamici, his tenth of the season, but were denied victory with nine minutes to go by Calum Willock.

The tenth draw was at Folkestone, where a 19th minute goal by James Everitt was not enough to account for Eastern Counties League side Leiston. Danny Smy made it 1-1

before the interval but Folkestone almost snatched a late winner when Frankie Chappell headed against a post.

Five Ryman clubs were beaten by Conference South opponents. Among them were Lowestoft who lost 2-1 at last season's Ryman League champions Dartford. Dale Cockrill netted for the Trawlerboys with six minutes left after Dartford had scored twice soon after half-time. Harlow were beaten 2-0 at Lewes, Chris Breach heading both goals in the space of six first-half minutes, and Bognor went down by the same score at Eastleigh.

Romford were beaten 4-0 at home by Alan Devonshire's Hampton while Tooting did only slightly better against Staines, losing 4-1. Phil Williams got their consolation goal with four minutes left, making it 3-1, but Staines had time to strike again.

Sunday's games, both all-Ryman ties, produced definite results with home sides Hendon and Enfield Town going through to the third qualifying round.

Enfield have reached that stage for the first time in their history after a 1-0 win over Worthing. Skipper Mark Kirby scored after 11 minutes and Worthing, who rested a number of regulars, rarely looked likely to respond although Zac Beda headed against a post with ten minutes left.

Hendon, the only Premier Division club in action on Sunday, went ahead at almost the same time through Jamie Busby. Aaron Morgan made it 2-0 six minutes after half-time and, although Lee Blackburn hit back two minutes later, Hendon held on to win 2-1.

Ryman Youth League

Whyteleafe were soon in trouble in their FA Youth Cup tie against Tooting on Thursday. Tooting's kick-off was touched sideways to Reece Hall who promptly fired it into the net, a goal estimated to have been scored in just THREE seconds!

The game's other goals, oddly enough, came in added time at the end of each half with Michael Tia doubling Tooting's lead and Conor Symon pulling one back at the death.

The top scorer among Ryman Youth League clubs involved in this week's FAYC ties was Worthing's Shaun Charles, who netted four times in their 6-1 home win over Dorking.

Dwaine Crichlow claimed a hat-trick for Hampton in their 6-2 victory at Kentish Town but a double for Fleet's Alfie Lynch was not enough for his side, whose second-half rally from 5-1 down fell short in a 5-4 defeat at Basingstoke.

Woking duo Adam Bicknell and Jack Mazzone netted two apiece in their 4-1 home win over Cobham and Jack Simon contributed two goals to Maidstone's 5-1 victory over Croydon.

Among the Ryman Youth League matches played during the week was a 'derby' between Barnet's two teams. Jamal Akua Lowe hit a hat-trick and Andrew Manitou scored twice as Barnet Amber beat Barnet Black 5-1.

Chipstead's Cameron Watt scored in the first and last minutes of their 3-2 success at Leyton and Mario Quiassaca netted both goals as Staines won 2-0 at Harrow. Top league scorers of the week were Kingstonian, who hit five unanswered goals at Walton & Hersham.
