# Ryman

#### **Premier**

LEWES were the only team in the top half of Ryman Premier to see league action on Saturday, and they strengthened their position with a 1-0 victory at Leatherhead.

Michael Malcolm scored the only goal of a dull game with a 20-yard free-kick in the 74<sup>th</sup> minute and although Lewes failed to improve on their fifth place they moved four points clear of their nearest rivals.

In a division where away wins have been more common than home successes this season, it was no great surprise that all four matches went the way of the visitors.

Kingstonian climbed into the top half with a 3-1 win at bottom club Horsham. Bobby Traynor put them ahead with a seventh-minute penalty and Gary MacDonald made it 2-0 with a diving header on the hour. Ian Varley fired in off the bar to pull one back but Clayton's late strike lifted K's to tenth place, though they have played more games than anyone else.

Kwesi Appiah's double gave dominant Margate the points at Harrow and made him the division's top scorer with 12 league goals among his total of 24. His first came after 58 minutes and it should have been all over long before he completed the 2-0 scoreline with a late penalty after he had been brought down.

Hastings maintained their recent improvement, coming out on top by the odd goal in three at Tooting. Their goals came in the first half-hour from Lee Carey, a free-kick, and Zac Attwood. The dismissal of Jordan Woodley after 55 minutes offered Tooting a lifeline and an Ashley Robinson penalty 20 minutes from time reduced the arrears. But the visitors survived heavy pressure to take the points.

Cray and Hendon battled out a goalless Ryman Premier draw at Hayes Lane on Sunday, both clubs failing to claim the victory they needed to close the gap significantly on fifth-placed Lewes. The Sussex club still have a three-point lead over Cray and Hendon, now sixth and seventh respectively.

It was a game of few chances. Cray could make little impression on a Hendon defence with former Premiership star Frank Sinclair (pictured) at its heart and Hendon, though having slightly the better of the exchanges, fated little better.

Mauro Vihete came closest to breaking the deadlock, hitting a post from 20 yards in the 72nd minute and then, a minute later, seeing his header tipped away at full stretch by Cray keeper Andy Walker.

# Ryman North

MATCH of the day in Ryman North yesterday (Saturday) was at Needham Market, where the table-topping hosts took on a Grays side who trailed them only on goal difference.

It was to be the Marketmen's day and, almost inevitably, Sam Newson took centre stage. He put them ahead a minute before half-time, becoming the first man to reach 20 Ryman League goals this season, and scored again, his 29<sup>th</sup> in all games, 18 minutes after half-time. Grays replied with an Anthony Ryan header seven minutes later but it was to be Needham's day as the league's last unbeaten away record came to an end.

Third-placed Leiston had the day off and that enabled Enfield Town to overtake them. They beat Soham 3-0 in the first league game at the Queen Elizabeth II Stadium, which attracted a gate of 420.

Having their own ground at last has given Town new hope for the future, so it was entirely appropriate that Liam Hope scored their first two goals. He put them ahead after 15 minutes and added a penalty 11 minutes after the interval. Leon Osei netted the third midway through the second half.

Brentwood were held to a 0-0 draw in a lively game at Romford and that allowed Tilbury to overtake them and move into fifth place with a 2-1 home win over Cheshunt.

Alex Read opened Dockers' account after 12 minutes, and, after Anthony McDonald headed the equaliser in the 39<sup>th</sup> minute, another header by Emiel Aiken restored the lead moments before half-time. A defiant display by Cheshunt keeper Joe Wright denied Dockers more goals.

Chatham wasted no time in tearing into the league's leakiest defence at Great Wakering,

without a manager after Danny Greaves' short spell in charge ended during the week.

Lee Hales put Chats ahead in the second minute and by the midpoint of the first half it was 3-0. Jason Barton headed the 50<sup>th</sup> goal to find the Wakering net this season and Jack Jeffery added another. It ended there, though, and Wakering hit back soon after the break through Alberto Pinto. Luka Frankis reduced the arrears further, but not until the 88<sup>th</sup> minute, and Chats won 3-2.

The other three matches produced just two goals – and one of them did not come until the fourth minute of added time. Luke Callander scored it for Heybridge, denying lowly Ware their second away point of the season after their match-long rearguard action looked set to be rewarded.

Nathan Clarke netted after ten minutes to give Sudbury all three points at home to Waltham Abbey, while Potters Bar and Waltham Forest slogged out a goalless draw. Ashley Harrison-Barker came closest to a breakthrough, hitting the Abbey bar.

## South

IT could hardly be much tighter at the top. Leaders Maidstone did not play on Saturday and slipped to third place behind Dulwich and Whitehawk. All three are level on points: Dulwich lead by one goal and Whitehawk have a two-goal advantage over Stones.

Then come Bognor, a point behind but with by far the best goal difference of the quartet, something that will comfort them as they recall missing the title by a single goal in the spring.

Maidstone were relegated last season and the other three teams in the log-jam at the top were the trio who missed out in the play-offs.

Dulwich reclaimed pole position with a 3-0 victory at Walton & Hersham. Dorian Smith hit the bar for Swans during a even first half but it was Dulwich who went ahead in the 44<sup>th</sup> minute with a Sanchez Ming penalty. Ming also scored the late third, after Frankie Sawyer had netted his 12<sup>th</sup> league goal.

Hawks narrowly escaped defeat at fifth-placed Worthing for whom Steve Metcalf's 51st-minute goal looked likely to be the winner.

Then Sami El-Abd squared it three minutes into added time, heading home when Rebels keeper Alan Mansfield could only push away a corner.

Bognor maintained their free-scoring form with four unanswered goals at Merstham. Ben Andrews put them ahead after 21 minutes and former Burgess Hill skipper Steve Harper opened his account for Rocks with a header eight minutes later. The inevitable Jason Prior goal, his 19<sup>th</sup> in the league, arrived five minutes after the interval, also a header, and a late long-range strike by James Crane wrapped it up.

The highest scorers in the division were, however, bottom club Crawley Down. They thrashed Croydon Athletic 5-0 to record only their third Ryman League victory. Gabriel Odunaike started the rout with a scrambled goal on the half-hour and, after a post had denied George Landais an equaliser, Tom Burton made it 2-0 at the break.

Luke Blewden, Burton and Hulusi Mustafa struck in the last 20 minutes as the Anvils gave notice that they have not given up the survival battle just yet. They remain bottom, but are now only a point behind Burgess Hill and two behind Croydon.

Hillians themselves went down 4-0 at home to Godalming, who took a fourth-minute lead through Dan Read. A spectacular volleyed double by Jamie McClurg towards the end of the half put the home side out of the picture and Darren Wheeler added another four minutes from time.

Experienced striker Danny Hockton scored his first two goals for Faversham but was also responsible for one of their two missed penalties as they went down 3-2 at Ramsgate.

lan Pulman put Rams ahead on 12 minutes and Hockton lifted a penalty over the bar before netting the equaliser on 37 minutes. Another penalty just before half-time was taken by James Peacock but he hit a post. Hockton headed his new side into the lead on the hour but those spot-kick misses came back to haunt them as a James Gregory corner and, in the final minute, a long throw by Simon Pettit allowed Ollie Gray to head home twice.

Brendon Cass had more luck than Hockton, with his two goals for Hythe earning them a 2-1 win at Sittingbourne. He converted a 48<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty and scored again 13 minutes later. Jack Hooper replied with 20 minutes left.

Whitstable looked set to move up the table when they took a 2-0 lead at home to Corinthian-Casuals. Stuart Vahid put them ahead after four minutes and Damian Abel, a recent arrival from Faversham, netted after 24.

The second half was 20 minutes old when Saheed Sankoh replied for Casuals and he struck again in the 88<sup>th</sup> minute to make it a 2-2 draw.

Chipstead moved to within one point of a playoff spot with two unanswered goals, both provided by Callum O'Shea corners, at Whyteleafe. Marcus Elliott broke the deadlock on the stroke of half-time and Jason Goodchild added another in the 69<sup>th</sup> minute. Leafe's Fred Fleming was sent off just before the end.

The other game, between Eastbourne Town and Walton Casuals, finished scoreless as a strong wind dominated proceedings on the Sussex coast.



IT WAS a happy return to Thurrock on Saturday for Hornchurch chairman Colin McBride, manager Jim McFarlane and coach John Purdie.

The trio between them played over 1,300 games for Thurrock and McBride also had a long stint as manager.

The Conference South club were expected to provide difficult FA Trophy opposition for the Urchins, second in Ryman Premier, but it turned out to be a one-sided affair as Hornchurch powered to a 5-0 victory.

Jonathan Hunt's free-kick gave them a sixthminute lead and Martin Tuohy rounded off a fine move to make it 2-0 in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute.

Simon Glover effectively settled it when he headed home Hunt's free-kick soon after the interval and yet another free-kick from the 40-year-old midfielder allowed Lewis Smith to add the fourth on the hour.

Thurrock had Dean Cracknell sent off soon after that and two yellow cards in a minute for Drewe Broughton reduced them to nine men before Michael Spencer fired the final goal in added time.

That was the league's only success against Conference South opposition, though Bury might feel they should have done better than a 2-2 draw at Farnborough after Billy Clark scored twice in the first 11 minutes.

Kieran Leabon and John Sands went close to increasing the lead before the interval.

Farnborough raised their game after the break and two goals in a minute by substitute Jordan

Merryman just after the hour set up a replay in Suffolk on Tuesday.

Ryman North side Thamesmead achieved an excellent 2-2 draw against Welling, second in ConSouth.

Theo Fairweather-Johnson put them ahead a minute after half-time and then snatched a late equaliser after Welling had responded with two goals.

Andy Pugh scored immediately after coming on as a substitute and Lee Clarke put Welling ahead, converting the rebound after Adam Mott saved his penalty.

The other three match-ups between the leagues went the way of the Conference clubs.

Premier leaders Billericay were beaten by a single goal midway through the first half at Maidenhead, a fine solo effort by Reece Tison-Lascaris.

Harrison Chatting hit a post as the Essex men tried to force a replay.

A hat-trick by Dave Tarpey, a prolific scorer during a loan spell at Walton & Hersham two seasons ago, accounted for Canvey, who were beaten 4-2 at Hampton.

Canvey were 3-0 down but gained new hope with two goals in the minute from Rob King, his sixth in the competition, and Alex Rhodes. That gave them 16 minutes to find an equaliser but Tarpey killed them off with his third goal at the end.

Goals in the last ten minutes of the first half by Gareth Risbridger and Jake Goodman put the skids under Folkestone as they went down 3-1 at home to Staines. Marc Charles-Smith stretched the visitors' lead further before Frankie Chappell's 83<sup>rd</sup>-minute consolation.

Only one match pitted a Ryman club against Southern League opposition and Wealdstone will be favourites for Tuesday's replay after a goalless draw at Banbury.

There were three all-Ryman League ties and in each of them a Premier club were drawn away to a team from the North division. All three went the way of the senior team by an odd goal.

Jamie Forshaw rescued Lowestoft with two goals in the last 20 minutes at Harlow, who had taken a 10<sup>th</sup>-minute lead through Piers Wixon, while a single goal by David Ray in the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute was enough to see Carshalton through at Maldon.

And finally . . . Redbridge's amazing run of success in the FA competitions is over after they lost 2-1 at home to East Thurrock.

The Motormen, looking forward to their FA Cup second-round tie at Crawley next Saturday, fell behind to a Petrit Elbi goal after 11 minutes.

Rocks went further ahead soon after half-time when Dan Trenkel diverted the ball into his own net.

Ryan Wade pulled one back for Redbridge with a penalty on the hour but Rocks held out to book their place in Monday's first-round draw
