ALL THE ACTION

A PAUL VINES hat-trick led Carshalton into the last 16 of the FA Trophy with a 3-1 replay win over Lincoln at Colston Avenue last night (Wednesday).

Robins became the second Ryman League club to knock out Conference Premier opposition, following Wealdstone's success against Barrow on Saturday.

Defences had the upper hand in the early stages and the breakthrough did not come until the 39th minute, when Vines scored from the spot after a foul on Luke Nolan.

Better was to follow three minutes later when Vines outjumped keeper Joe Anyon to head home a free-kick from Justyn Roberts and hand Robins a 2-0 half-time lead.

And the experienced striker completed a quickfire treble 11 minutes after the break, collecting a long clearance and bursting away to give Anyon no chance with a left-footed shot.

Lincoln looked a well-beaten side and it was the 89th minute before Jake Sheridan provided their consolation goal as Robins earned themselves a trip to Worksop or Newport in the third round.

East Thurrock's replay at Hampton fell victim to a frozen pitch and they will try again on Tuesday when Rocks will bid to become the third Ryman League side in the last 16.



ILFORD quadrupled their away points total with a 2-1 victory at neighbours Redbridge on Tuesday.

It was only their second win of the season and they remain at the foot of Ryman North, but they could move up two places and escape from the relegation zone if they beat fellowstrugglers Great Wakering on Saturday.

Redbridge had the better of the first half, though they were lucky not to fall behind when Joe Wright saved at the feet of Danny Gabriel and Rob Carter hit a post from the rebound.

The Motormen eventually broke through with a Ben Bradbury penalty two minutes before halftime but Carter equalised seven minutes after the break with a fine near-post header.

Glowacki, who recently moved from Redbridge to their neighbours, atoned for his earlier miss with a crisp 20-yard strike to claim the 78thminute winner and revive Ilford's hopes of beating the drop.

At the other end of the table, Leiston went back to the top despite being held to a 2-2 home draw by Thamesmead. Ashley Proberts struck for the visitors after 24 minutes and Danny Smy levelled it on the stroke of halftime.

Smy was to be sent off in the second half but a Pat Brothers goal on the hour looked to have clinched all three points for the home side. Thamesmead, by then down to ten men themselves, denied them with a goal from Theo Fairweather-Johnson on the 88th minute.

Maldon hosted Romford in the day's other Ryman North fixture, which finished goalless.



TWO Suffolk clubs, Lowestoft and Bury, booked their places in the Alan Boon Cup semi-finals on Tuesday.

The Trawlerboys found themselves 2-0 down at half-time in their home game against Canvey. Jason Hallett opened the scoring in the 35th minute and Leon Gordon added another at the end of the half.

Rob Eagle started the comeback seven minutes after the break, Jamie Forshaw equalised midway through the half and Lubo Guentchev struck with 12 minutes left to give Lowestoft a 3-2 victory.

Ryman Premier

John Sands made Bury's long trek to Hastings worthwhile with both goals in a 2-0 success. They came after 67 and 78 minutes.

Sudbury made a brave effort to complete a Suffolk hat-trick before going down in a penalty shoot-out at Premier high-fliers Lewes yesterday (Wednesday).

Robbie Martin put the Ryman North ahead seven minutes before half-time but Matt Somner's header squared matters before the break and that proved to be the end of the scoring.

Both sides missed one of their first five penalties: then, after Albert Jarrett converted the first sudden-death kick, Rikki Banks became the Lewes hero by saving from Ryan Henshaw to earn his side a 5-4 victory.

East Thurrock will host Maidstone in the remaining quarter-final which has been delayed by East Thurrock's FA Trophy replay.
