ALL THE ACTION

Premier

LOWESTOFT suffered a major setback in their quest for the title with a 2-0 defeat at Kingstonian on Monday.

Ryan Woods put Ks ahead on the half-hour and Lowestoft's best effort to replay was a shot that hit the bar soon after half-time.

A red card for Andrew Fisk reduced them to ten men before substitute Bobby Traynor clinched it in added time. It was a welcome return to goalscoring form for Traynor, the golden boot winner in his division for the last three seasons, who has lost his place in the side after a barren run stretching back more than two months.

It was a major setback for the Trawlerboys, who needed a point to move into second place and a win to return to the top.

Kingstonian maintained their hopes of mounting a challenge for a play-off place, as did Wealdstone who saw off Tooting by the same margin, and in almost identical fashion, at Grosvenor Vale.

The first goal here arrived around the half-hour mark from Britt Assombalonga, and Stones then had to wait until added time for their second. Again it was one of the league's most feared marksmen on target as Richard Jolly slotted in his 29th of the season.

Tooting remain in the bottom four, two points behind Hastings and no longer with a game in hand on the Sussex club.

Canvey and Met Police dented each other's play-off hopes with a 2-2 draw at Park Lane on Tuesday.

Jay Curran put Canvey ahead after 13 minutes but skipper Steve Sutherland equalised shortly before the interval and Eddie Smith gave the Met a 2-1 lead in the 58th minute.

Alex Rhodes almost levelled matters again with a ferocious shot that crashed against a post, but the islanders had to wait only until the 69th minute before Jason Hallett rounded the keeper to make it 2-2.

A draw was fair enough, though it took a superb point-blank save by James Russell to prevent Met substitute Mu Maan heading a late winner.

Margate began life without goal machine Kwesi Appiah on a bleak note, going down 2-0 at lowly Leatherhead, who moved up to 19th place and rekindled their survival hopes. Tommy Hutchings made the breakthrough in the 48th minute and Billy Manners added the second with 20 minute left.

Redbridge boosted their play-off chances with a convincing 3-0 win over sixth-placed Tilbury.

The Motormen are now five points short of the play-off places and still have one or two games in hand on everyone else in the division.

Two goals in three playing minutes either side of half-time, from Michael Toner and Vinnie

Durrant, set them on their way, and Toner struck again on the hour.



FA Trophy

EAST THURROCK are out of the FA Trophy but gave a spirited performance before going down 4-1 at Hampton in their second-round replay on Tuesday.

The scoreline is misleading, for Hampton's last two goals came in added time at the end of the game.

Dave Tarpey gave them the lead in the 54th minute and struck again three minutes later.

Rocks, who could well have been ahead by then, refused to crumble after the double blow and Kris Newby replied after 65 minutes.

But, as they pressed for a late equaliser, Tarpey completed his hat-trick to put the tie out of the visitors' reach and a Ben Wood own goal completed the tally.

That leaves Carshalton and Wealdstone to fly the Ryman League flag in Saturday's third-round ties, when Carshalton travel to Wales to take on Newport while Stones visit Dartford.
