# **Premier**

HARROW gave themselves a huge lift in the fight for Ryman Premier survival with a 3-0 victory at East Thurrock tonight (Tuesday).

Their fans also had the unusual experience of cheering goals netted by fierce rivals Wealdstone. A Richard Jolly double gave Stones a 2-0 win at Hastings, which means that Harrow move up two places to 17<sup>th</sup>.

Harrow always had the better of things against a tired-looking Rocks outfit and they went ahead in the 28<sup>th</sup> minute. A fine save by home keeper Richard Wray was followed by a blocked shot before Ashley Watson netted the loose ball.

It was 2-0 five minutes later thanks to Simeon Akinola's superb curling shot from the edge of the penalty area into the far top corner.

Sam Higgins missed a good chance for the home side just before the interval but Harrow were rarely troubled after that and Akinola made sure of victory with his second goal in the 79<sup>th</sup> minute.

At Hastings, meanwhile, Wealdstone were chasing the points to stay in the play-off race and they endured an unhappy first half during which Jolly and Scott Fitzgerald wasted good chances.

When Fitzgerald missed a penalty soon after the restart it began to seem that it would not be Stones' night. But Jolly headed home a cross from James Mulley to break the deadlock with 12 minutes left and he struck again four minutes from time. That was his 42<sup>nd</sup> goal of the season and his 26<sup>th</sup> in the league. He is once more the leading scorer in all three divisions, one ahead of Hornchurch's Martin Tuohy.

Stones move up three places to ninth, five points behind fifth-placed Cray with a game in hand. Hastings slip to 18<sup>th</sup>, below Harrow on goal difference, while Leatherhead fall back into the bottom four, three points adrift. All three clubs now have five games to play.

A last-gasp Paul Vines penalty probably put paid to Metropolitan Police's play-off ambitions as they went down 2-1 at Carshalton. The Blues are seven points behind Cray and have played the same number of games.

Vines opened the scoring midway through the first half but Sam Hurrell equalised six minutes before the break.

There was no further scoring until the fourth minute of added time, when Robins were awarded a spot kick and Vines made no mistake.

Another late goal denied Bury, in fourth place, the chance to open up a substantial gap between themselves and the other play-off contenders.

David Laird's goal two minutes into added time allowed visitors Wingate to escape with a 2-2 draw

He had also given his side the lead in the 22<sup>nd</sup> minute but John Sands levelled matters in the 37<sup>th</sup> minute and Lee Smith put Bury in front just before the break.

The Suffolk club are four points ahead of Cray, who have a game in hand.
