## FA Cup

AFTER going six years without winning a game in the FA Cup, **Hastings United** have certainly made up for lost time. They carried the Ryman League flag into the second round proper with a 2-1 victory at Conference North side Bishop's Stortford on Saturday.

Player-manager Sean Ray led from the front, volleying the 70<sup>th</sup>-minute goal which brought the sides level after Stortford had led from the seventh minute, when Matt Johnson found the net. Everything looked set for a replay in Sussex, but with three minutes left Brad Goldberg, who had scored in every round of the competition, tried to maintain his record with a long-range effort and, although he failed, teammate Zac Attwood was on the spot to deflect the ball into the net.

Chatham, Staines, Hitchin and Blackfield & Langley had already fallen to the Sussex side, who are now just 90 minutes away from the chance of meeting one of England's top clubs.

Standing in their way are Harrogate Town, just three places above Bishop's Stortford in Conference North. Unfortunately Hastings have to travel again as they try to emulate the achievement of the town's previous United club, who reached the third round in 1954 and 1955.

With a bit of fortune there could have been three Ryman League clubs in the draw. **Metropolitan Police** were denied a replay against League One high-flyers Crawley Town by the width of the Imber Court post which kept out Howard Newton's shot in added time.

Crawley had taken the lead in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute when Josh Simpson converted a through ball. Billy Clarke made it 2-0 on 69 minutes and, hard through the Met had battled, it looked as if it would be a comfortable afternoon for the visitors. But there was new hope for the Ryman club in the 83<sup>rd</sup> minute as Craig Brown's shot came back off the bar and Allan Tait was there to finish. The Met threw everything forward and had penalty appeals turned down before Newton came so close to saving the day.

**Hendon** came within six minutes of a replay at League Two Aldershot. Dean Cracknell gave them the lead with a long-range cracker in the 28<sup>th</sup> minute and some heroic goalkeeping by Berkley Laurencin made it a frustrating afternoon for the Shots. The dangerous Danny Hylton headed an equaliser in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute and it was Hylton who finally shattered Hendon's dreams when he finished off a cross from Craig Reid.

## Ryman Premier

LEADERS **Hampton** were quickly into their stride at **East Thurrock** on Saturday. James Simmonds and Joel Ledgister put them two up after only eight minutes and they held on to win 2-1. The Beavers had been beaten at Wealdstone in midweek after going two up and East Thurrock certainly tried hard to repeat the feat. But, reverting to their normal form, Hampton defended strongly and it was the 86<sup>th</sup> minute before Reiss Gilbey put Rocks on the scoresheet.

**Whitehawk** took over second spot with a 3-1 victory at **Bury**. The damage was done in a ten-minute spell soon after half-time: Sam Gargan scored twice in three minutes, with chest and head, and Jed Wallace saw his inswinging corner go in off the far post. John Sands had put Bury in front in the seventh minute. The hosts had Jordan Patrick sent off near the end.

**Wealdstone** moved up to third, making the most of their hosts' misfortunes with a 3-0 win at **Cray**, who lost goalie Andy Walker in the warm-up and centre-back Joe Vines after ten minutes. Richard Jolly had already netted for Stones before Vines hobbled off. The outstanding Alex Dyer made it 2-0 on 20 minutes and Jolly struck again midway through the second half, reclaiming his familiar position at the top of the division's scoring chart with his eighth league goal.

Managerless **Wingate**, whose long-serving boss Dave Norman resigned after their midweek FA Trophy exit, pulled off a 1-0 victory at **Kingstonian**. Mark Henry scored the decisive goal 11 minutes after half-time and K's dropped from second to fourth in the table.

**Bognor** are up to an unlikely fifth place – unlikely because James Crane's goal on the stroke of half-time was only their second in seven home league games. It was enough for a 1-0 victory over bottom club **Thurrock**.

The day's thriller was at **Canvey**, where a Liam Hope hat-trick led **Enfield Town** to a 4-3 win. Enfield lost keeper Noel Imber to injury after 18 minutes. Defender Lee White took over and got an immediate boost when Hope opened the scoring with a penalty. Rob King equalised on 34 minutes but, three minutes later, he made the mistake which handed Hope his second. A minute after that, however, Kevin Dobinson made it 2-2, only for Joe O'Brien to cap a hectic spell of four goals in seven minutes by putting Town ahead again.

Hope gave his side breathing space with his third goal on 55 minutes and, although King rallied the islanders with his own second ten minutes later, that proved to be the end of the scoring.

**Carshalton** climbed out of the bottom two thanks to a pair of late goals which earned them a 2-0 home win over **Lowestoft**. It looked as if their chance had gone with a bizarre incident on 73 minutes. Lewis Taylor converted a penalty but the ball clipped his standing foot as he kicked it and the goal was disallowed because he had touched the ball twice. Then, with 88 minutes on the clock, Hakeem Adelakun rifled in a 35-yard drive to put Robins ahead. Nathaniel Pinney added another four minutes into added time, though home keeper Nick Hamann still had to preserve his clean sheet by saving Chris Henderson's penalty.

There was a predictable draw at **Leiston**. The home side have drawn five of their six home games and **Lewes**, though still without an away win, have taken a point four times on the road. Chris Breach nodded the visitors ahead in the 25<sup>th</sup> minute and Leiston wasted a number of chances before sub Nathan Stone headed home a cross from Emmanuel Osei to level it with 12 minutes left.

At almost the same time Harry Elmes converted a penalty to give **Concord** a 2-1 victory at **Harrow**. Nicky Cowley's header put the Essex side in front after 53 minutes and Simeon Akinola drove home from the edge of the box to level it 20 minutes later. Ruddock Yala, who conceded the decisive penalty, was shown a straight red card four minutes later.

## **Ryman North**

JAMIE GUY played the key role on Saturday as leaders **Maldon** saw off second-placed visitors **Grays** 2-1 and opened up a five-point gap at the top of the table.

Guy set up the opening goal for Ollie Berquez after 37 minutes and added the second himself ten minutes after the break. Grays had Jake Hall sent off shortly afterwards and it would have been 3-0 but for a penalty miss by James Robinson. Harry Agombar's long-range strike gave Grays hope with five minutes left but Maldon were worthy winners.

It was a good day for the town of Maldon as its other club, **Heybridge**, took over second place with a 2-1 victory at **Aveley**. The hosts had Luke Wilson sent off before the half-hour mark but took the lead through Jordan Cox shortly afterwards. They held it until the 70<sup>th</sup> minute, when Luke Callander rifled home his 12<sup>th</sup> league goal of the season, the best tally in any division. A foul on Callander then allowed Michael Cheek to win it with an 83<sup>rd</sup>-minute penalty.

Callander had been caught briefly by James Gershfield, who netted his 11<sup>th</sup> with a 63<sup>rd</sup>-minute penalty to give **Potters Bar** the lead at **Romford**. Lewis Francis made it 1-1 with another penalty in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute and Nick Reynolds converted a Joe Oates free-kick two minutes into added time, earning Romford a 2-1 win which lifted them to sixth place while their victims slipped from third to fourth.

**Sudbury** dropped four places to 19<sup>th</sup> after they were thrashed 4-0 at home by **Brentwood**. Alex Read opened the scoring after three minutes and went on to complete his second successive Saturday hat-trick with a late penalty. His second goal came eight minutes before half-time and Daryl Robinson was also on target for Blues in the 54<sup>th</sup> minute.

Brentwood were among several lowly teams to pick up morale-boosting victories, among them **Harlow** who pulled off a welcome 2-1 win at **Cheshunt**. Piers Wixon put them ahead after 12 minutes, following up after his penalty was saved, and Jeff Hammond added an insurance goal with 11 minutes left. Hawks needed it, as Dave Greene pulled one back for the hosts four minutes later.

**Chatham** came out on top by the same margin at home to **Redbridge**, who remain in 21<sup>st</sup> place. Lee Hales put Chats ahead after 14 minutes and Redbridge missed a penalty before Lee Newton levelled the scores right on half-time. Player-manager Kevin Watson netted the decider five minutes after the break.



It was the same scoreline at **Witham**, too. John Watson's close-range effort gave them the lead against **Waltham Forest** on the half-hour and Rob Whitnell added a 56<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty after a foul on Sam Taylor. Adrian Clifton pounced on a loose ball to give Forest hope with ten minutes left, but in vain.

Forest had won 6-1 at **Needham Market** in midweek and the Marketmen continued their bewildering form by hitting three unanswered goals at **Thamesmead**, who boasted a 100 per cent home record. Headers by Duane Wright and Ollie Fenn in quick succession midway through the first half put the visitors in control, and Kieran Leabon made sure just after the hour. Yet to win at home, Needham have dropped only two points in five games on the road.

**Soham** also rattled up a 3-0 away win, at **Ware** who remain four points adrift at the bottom without a league victory to their credit. Michael Simpson opened the scoring on 19 minutes and Matt Robinson added a double, converting a loose ball just before the interval and firing home from 20 yards in the 77<sup>th</sup> minute.

**Ilford** started the season with a 2-1 victory at Soham but have not won, or scored more than once in a game, in any competition since then. Their latest setback was a 3-1 home defeat by **Wroxham**, who took the lead through Ross Durrant after 15 minutes. Matt Daniels added a goal in each half before Joel Etienne-Clarke replied.

Danny Francis twice gave **Tilbury** the lead at **Waltham Abbey**, scoring after 20 and 55 minutes. Louis Bristow's 36<sup>th</sup>-minute goal made it all square at the interval and James Peagram salvaged a 2-2 draw for the hosts with a long-range rocket two minutes from time.

## Ryman South

WHO can stop **Maidstone**? The leaders faced a potentially difficult Kent derby at fourth-placed **Faversham** on Saturday and made light of their task with four unanswered goals in front of 615, the division's best crowd of the season anywhere except Maidstone's own Gallagher Stadium.

Nicky Humphrey headed home Alex Flisher's free-kick in the 16<sup>th</sup> minute and Ian Draycott continued his scoring form with two in the second half before Sam Bewick wrapped it up in added time.

**Hythe** look to have done themselves no harm by signing long-serving Folkestone striker James Everitt this week. Ratty, as he was known during his nine years at Folkestone, marked his debut by scoring both goals in the 2-0 home win over **Whitstable** which lifted his new club into second place. Everitt opened the scoring with a deflected shot moments before the interval and headed his second after 70 minutes.

**Dulwich** won by the same score at bottom club **Walton Casuals** to take over third place. Another new signing played his part here: 18-year-old substitute Daniel Carr, who broke the deadlock early in the second half. Lewis Gonsalves added the second on the hour.

Early pacemakers **Crawley Down** dropped to fourth as their slump continued with a 4-1 pasting at **Ramsgate**, who moved into the top half of the table. The first half finished all square, with Fraser Logan replying to Tom Chapman's early strike for the hosts. The game was effectively settled in three minutes around the hour mark, when Ian Pulman restored Ramsgate's lead and Warren Schulz made it 3-1 from the spot. Pulman was on target again ten minutes later.

**Herne Bay**'s promotion push, in their debut season, was derailed by lowly **Worthing** who, like a number of teams at the wrong end of the table, are picking up the vast majority of their points away from home – 12 out of 15 in their case. It could hardly have started better for the hosts, who took the lead inside 30 seconds through Joe Turner. Scott Kirkwood turned things round, converting a 19<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty and scoring again three minutes later. Jamie Brotherton's intended cross found the net to stretch the lead on 64 minutes and Chris O'Flaherty completed a 4-1 scoreline eight minutes later.

**Tooting**, who had claimed 12 of their 13 points on the road, at last found their home form with a 3-0 win over **Corinthian-Casuals**. They were given a flying start by Taurean Roberts, who scored twice in the first nine minutes. Casuals had a chance to get back in the game after 20 minutes but Darren Behcet saved Jordan Cheadle's penalty. Jordan Wilson made sure with a solo goal seven minutes from time.

**Horsham** are unusual among the struggling sides by saving their best performances for their home fans and they maintained that with a 2-1 victory over **Folkestone**. Gary Charman, with a header, and Billy Medlock, with a free-kick, netted goals in the 13<sup>th</sup> minute of each half. Stuart King replied with a penalty in the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute, becoming the division's undisputed top scorer with his 11<sup>th</sup> league goal (and, for seven minutes, the joint-top scorer in the league).

**Three Bridges**, kept off the bottom of the table only by goal difference, were given a boost when Joe White saved a 19<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty by Fabio Saraiva for visiting **Merstham**. But two goals in the last five minutes

of the half, from Jack Macleod and Mark Nwokoji, put Merstham in charge. Marcus Elliott pulled one back with 20 minutes left but a late Nwokoji effort made it 3-1 and ended the home side's hopes.

**Burgess Hill** led for most of their home game with **Leatherhead** after Pat Harding's third-minute goal but had to settle for a 1-1 draw. With 12 minutes left Hillians keeper Mark Zawadski was sent off for bringing down Tommy Hutchings and Greg Andrews made no mistake with the penalty.

**Chipstead** fought back from 2-0 down to draw with **Walton & Hersham**, who also took a third-minute lead through Phil Williams. Harold Odemetey doubled it after 25 minutes but Jason Goodchild gave the home side some encouragement by pulling one back in the 40<sup>th</sup> minute. Again the equaliser came from the spot, James McShane scoring after 82 minutes to punish a foul on Rob Haworth.

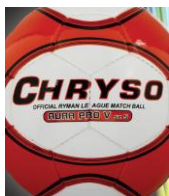
