All the Weekend Action

THERE was no shortage of entertainment in Saturday's Ryman League programme. The 33 games produced 113 goals: 42 in the Premier, 40 in the North and 31 in the South.

The tally included no fewer than ten hat-tricks, which must surely be a league record for a single day or very close to it.

Ryman Premier

BOTTOM club **Thurrock** produced the result of the day in the Ryman Premier on Saturday, thrashing **Kingstonian** 4-0 at Ship Lane to move out of the relegation places.

The result by no means flattered Mark Stimson's men, who might well have added to their score after Ben Smith netted their fourth soon after half-time.

Luke Wanadio put them ahead in the seventh minute, debutant Jack Paxman made it 2-0 on 27 minutes and the outstanding Harry Honesty dealt a further blow to K's right on half-time.

Hendon scored their first away goals of the season: three of them, in fact. Alas for them, they let in six at **Enfield Town** and slipped to the foot of the table.

A drab first half gave no hint of what lay in store, though Liam Hope's header gave Enfield the lead moments before the break. By the tenth minute of the second half it was 3-1. Jack Mazzone equalised only for Michael Bardle and Tyler Campbell to put Enfield in command.

Hope made sure of the points in the space of four minutes midway through the half with a penalty and another header to complete his hat-trick. Then came an exchange of own goals, with Mark Kirby gifting Hendon their second and Scott Cousins returning the favour. Belal Aite-Ouakrim netted Hendon's third in added time, his 50th goal for the club in his 150th game.

Leiston are finding it hard going in their first Premier season and they joined Hendon in the relegation zone after a 5-1 thrashing at table-topping **Whitehawk** left them still seeking their first away points.

James Fraser opened the scoring after three minutes and Jed Wallace nabbed the second 11 minutes later. Sheridan Driver pulled one back in the 36th minute but the impressive Wallace struck again just before the interval and completed his hat-trick in the 74th minute. That was swiftly followed by Hawks' fifth, from Danny Mills.

Margate took over second place with a 3-1 home win over Bury, who took a third-minute lead through Sam Nunn and held it until five minutes after the break, when Tommy Whitnell headed the equaliser. A Dan Stubbs penalty put Margate ahead after 74 minutes and Richard Avery's header wrapped it up before a late red card for Carl Rook took some of the gloss off the victory.

Wealdstone stepped up to third by beating **Carshalton** 3-0, ensuring that they will go a full year without losing at home. Their last reverse at Grosvenor Vale was on November 19, 2011, when they went down 2-1 to Canvey. Richard Jolly set up the opener for Tom Pett in the 27th minute and scored the second himself just before the interval. Shabazz Baidoo wrapped it up with ten minutes left.

Hampton forfeited their unbeaten home record and dropped two places to fourth as they went down 3-1 to **Cray**, who have yet to lose away. Leigh Bremner pounced for the first goal in the 14th minute when Jack Clark's free-kick was parried. Charlie Moone levelled the scores on the half-hour but a Paul Vines header restored Cray's lead before the break and another header from Aaron Day completed the scoring in the 65th minute.

Bognor are also unbeaten on the road and they moved into the play-off places with a 2-1 success at **Lowestoft**. James Crane's chip put them ahead in the 39th minute and Steve Harper added another shortly after the interval. Dale Cockrill pulled one back from the spot after a foul on Chris Henderson with 20 minutes left but there was no escape for the Trawlerboys.

It has been quite a week at **Concord**, who followed up last Saturday's 6-3 win over Carshalton by thumping **Met Police** 5-1. With an 8-2 Senior Cup victory in midweek, lucky fans at Thames Road have seen 25 goals in eight days. Tony Stokes led the way with a hat-trick, becoming the first player in the Premier to reach ten league goals.

Met Police actually went ahead with a seventh-minute header from Jonte Smith, his 19th in league and FA competitions. The unstoppable Stokes replied in the 10th minute and then set up goals for Jerome Walker and Danny Spendlove either side of half-time as the Beachboys took command. Stokes nabbed his second on the hour and completed his treble shortly afterwards with a stunning long-range overhead kick, Ibrahimovic-style.

It was all square at Lewes, for whom Karl Beckford hit a post in the first half. Harrow took the lead when Simeon Akinola punished a short back-pass five minutes after the interval but Anthtony Thomas replied immediately with an intended cross that was misjudged by visiting keeper Elvijs Putnins. Harrow had James Burgess sent off with 12 minutes left but the Rooks could not profit and it finished 1-1.

A third-minute goal by Kye Ruel was enough to give **East Thurrock** a well-deserved 1-0 win at **Wingate**, though veteran striker Rocky Baptiste muffed a simple late chance to level the scores.

There were no goals at all at **Hastings**, where **Canvey** had the upper hand and Rob King came closest to breaking the deadlock.

Ryman North

IF **Sudbury** thought that last week's 6-1 victory over Redbridge was finally going to kick-start their disappointing Ryman North season, they had – as my mother would have said – another think coming.

They travelled to **Soham** on Saturday and found themselves on the wrong end of a 7-2 thrashing, a tally which included a hat-trick of penalties by Buster Harradine. His new teammate Luke Stanley also scored three on his debut, after making his name as a prolific scorer for Cambridgeshire League side Linton Granta.

It was 4-0 inside the first half-hour, with each of Harradine's first two penalties being quickly followed by a goal for the man who was fouled, first Stanley, then Rob Mason. Harradine completed his spot-kick treble on 56 minutes and Stanley made it 6-0 midway through the half. Lee Boyland and Michael Shinn provided some consolation for Sudbury before Stanley completed their misery.

Another hat-trick man was Maldon's Jamie Guy, now the division's joint-top scorer with 13 league goals. His tally included two penalties as the leaders, twice behind, maintained their four-point advantage with a 4-2 victory at Tilbury.

There were three outstanding goals in the first 24 minutes, with Gary Henty and Danny Francis on target for the Dockers either side of Guy's opener. His first penalty levelled it again six minutes before half-time and Joe Gardner put Maldon ahead six minutes after the break. Guy made sure with another spot-kick four minutes from time

Maldon are the league's top scorers with 42 goals and second-placed **Aveley** are on 41 after powering to a 5-0 win at **Potters Bar**, who started the day only a point behind them. Shane Oakley scored early and late in the first half, going on to complete a hat-trick with a penalty on the hour, just after Petrit Elbi made it 3-0. Jay Leader added the fifth.

Grays remain third, behind Millers on goal difference, after a comfortable 3-0 home win over **Thamesmead**. A quickfire double by Joe Sweeney and Joao Carlos put Grays two up after 15 minutes and, after they saw off a Thamesmead rally in the early stages of the second half, Carlos set up the third for Jack West 11 minutes from time

It was a good day for the top three, with none of the six teams behind them managing a victory. They included **Needham Market**, who slumped into the bottom half of the table after yet again failing to record their first home win. This time it was **Witham** who left Bloomfields with the spoils thanks largely to two quick goals early in the second half.

Rob Whitnell put them ahead with a penalty, after Pip Boyland handled, and Emeka Onwubiko made it 2-0. Ollie Fenn gave the Marketmen hope with 20 minutes left but Shamir Mullings responded to complete a 3-1 win for the Essex club.

Heybridge stayed fourth after being held to a 2-2 home draw by **Chatham**, who took the lead through Matt Newman on the half-hour. Two quick goals at the end of the half, from Michael Cheek and Ben Newson, turned it round but Swifts were unable to build on that and Newman scored again on the hour to earn his side a point.

The fifth hat-trick in the division came from **Brentwood**'s Alex Read, his third Saturday treble in four weeks. They beat bottom club **Ware** 4-0 to get back in touch with the pack. Blues are only 18th but have at least three games in hand on every other team in the division, as many as six on some.

Read opened the scoring with a 20th-minute penalty but Ware, four points adrift and still without a win to their credit, held their own until the last 18 minutes, when two more from Read and a late strike by Abs Thompson made it decisive.

Redbridge, in 21st place, suffered their seventh home defeat of the season. It might have been different had Jacob Cleaver not fired a first-half penalty over the bar, but **Waltham Abbey** made the most of their escape to take the points with a lone goal from Tom Bruno 20 minutes after the interval.

Harlow had also lost six out of seven at home before yesterday, but they managed their second win with three unanswered goals against Ilford, the third of the trio who are now well adrift at the bottom. Piers Wixon scrambled an early goal, Mitchell Das headed the second shortly before half-time and Jeff Hammond, who scored four at Redbridge in midweek, was on target again soon after the restart.

Cheshunt had the better of their game at Wroxham, and took the points with a single goal from Dave Greene eight minutes after half-time.

Waltham Forest and Romford slogged out a 0-0 draw, a scoreline that was a fair reflection of the uneventful proceedings. Joel Palmer missed a late chance to win it for Forest.

Ryman South

FOR the second Saturday running Walton Casuals proved unable to hang on to a lead and they remained at the foot of the Ryman South table despite an excellent 1-1 draw at leaders Maidstone, watched by a crowd of 1,755.

If it was not quite as catastrophic as the previous week, when Casuals managed only a draw against Merstham despite leading 6-1 after an hour, it was arguably even more frustrating.

Casuals, who had parted company with manager Mick Sullivan during the week, defied the table-toppers for 89 minutes and then snatched the lead through Kierran Dias. Stones got off the hook with an equaliser from Michael Phillips deep into added time. Without that goal Casuals would have been off the bottom and Stones off the top.

As it is, Maidstone lead on goal difference from **Hythe**, though they and the rest of the top five have all played two games more than the leaders.

Hythe were 4-3 winners at **Worthing**, whose Tom Lawley was the only one of the league's ten hat-trick men not to finish on the winning side. Lawley, in fact, opened the scoring in the second minute. A Dave Cook penalty and a Taser Hassan goal turned it round by the 14th minute.

A 25-yarder from Lawley squared matters again after 32 minutes only for Hythe to respond with goals from Cook and Nick Reeves in the next four minutes. Lawley was on target again five minutes after half-time but Rebels, who have lost six out of seven at home, could not find the net again.

Dulwich held on to third place coming from behind to beat **Herne Bay** 2-1 at Champion Hill. Calum McGeehan's free-kick put the visitors in front just before the interval: Ellis Green replied midway through the second half and set up the winner for Kevin James with six minutes left.

Crawley Down also needed a late winner for their welcome 2-1 home win over **Eastbourne** and they are fourth, only three points off the pace, despite having taken just one point from their previous five games. Man of the match Luke Blewden gave the Anvils a 20th-minute lead which was wiped out by Matt Geard ten minutes after the break. The hosts dominated but it looked as if victory would again elude them until Gabriel Odunaike made the breakthrough with two minutes left.

Burgess Hill complete the top five after their 1-0 victory at **Walton & Hersham**. The hosts had Aryan Tajbakhsh sent off at the end of the first half and Pat Harding won it with a 73rd-minute header, his – and his team's - eighth goal in three games.

After their amazing comeback a week earlier, Merstham saw the other side of the coin as they went down 2-1 at home to Faversham despite taking the lead through Liam Wright's header with only 14 minutes left. Renford Tenyue hit back and Adrian Stone nabbed the winner well into added time.

Stuart King took his league goal tally to 15, the best in any division, with a hat-trick in **Folkestone**'s 3-1 home win over **Three Bridges**. Folkestone had slipped well into the bottom half of the table and were seventh among the eight Kent clubs in the division. Their bad run looked set to continue when Joel O'Hara scored for Bridges in the 24th minute. King turned it round with two goals in the last three minutes of the half, the first a penalty, and made sure with four minutes left. That lifted Folkestone to tenth, although it did not improve their position in the Kent pecking order.

Bridges dropped to 21st, below **Whitstable** who climbed two places with a 1-0 home win over **Chipstead**. The Oystermen had sacked manager Justin Luchford during the week. Scott Heard's 77th-minute goal was enough for three vital points, and they deserved them.

Tempers frayed at Sittingbourne, where 11 yellow cards were shown and Tooting's Taurean Roberts was sent off in the second half. The hosts won 2-0 with a 23rd-minute goal from Hicham Akhazzan and a late Ryan Golding penalty.

Horsham, who chalked up two away wins in the first week of last season, finally ended their long wait for another one with a 2-1 victory at Leatherhead. The sides exchanged penalties in the first ten minutes, with Tommy

Hutchings converting for the Tanners and Ryan Woodford replying. Scott Tipper, recently signed from Worthing, scored the winner ten minutes before the interval.

Ramsgate wasted no time at Corinthian-Casuals. Both goals in their 2-0 win came in the first eight minutes, from Tom Chapman and Macauley Murray. Ian Pulman several times went close to increasing the lead.
