FA Trophy

THERE'S no place like home, they say, and **Maidstone** are certainly proving that after their 25-year exile from their home town.

The Ryman South title favourites, regularly attracting crowds of well over 1,000 to their glossy new Gallagher Stadium, became the first Ryman League side to reach the second round of the FA Trophy with a 2-0 home win over Conference South leaders Salisbury on Saturday.

Nicky Humphrey headed home Tim Olorunda's flick-on to give Stones the lead after 35 minutes and Alex Flisher rifled the second from 30 yards seven minutes later.

Salisbury dominated the second half but valiant Stones defence kept them at bay to bank the £5.000 prize money and book a place in the last 32.

Hampton will also be in the hat, but they face a replay at Conference South side Chelmsford tonight (Monday) after a 1-1 draw on Saturday.

Former East Thurrock midfielder Max Cornhill put Chelmsford ahead after 52 minutes and Charlie Moone equalised 11 minutes later with his seventh goal in the competition.

Hampton could have gone ahead immediately afterwards but Moone, Joel Ledgister and Joe Turner all contrived to hit the woodwork during a frantic goalmouth scramble.

Andre McCollin missed a third-minute penalty for **Kingstonian** and they crashed to a 4-0 defeat at home to high-flying Conference Premier side Dartford.

The 2010 Ryman champions took a 21st-minute lead through Jacob Erskine and K's found themselves deep in trouble seven minutes later when Simon Huckle received a straight red card for a wild challenge.

Tom Bradbrook doubled the lead six minutes after half-time and further goals by Danny Harris and Nathan Collier completed a comfortable Dartford victory.

Ryman Premier

TWO down at half-time, **Leiston** battled back to earn a 2-2 draw at **East Thurrock** on Saturday, collecting their first-ever Ryman Premier away point to climb off the foot of the table and out of the relegation places.

Kris Newby hit a post early in the game for Rocks, who went ahead with a lob by Reiss Gilbey in the 20th minute and doubled their lead through Hakeem Araba at the end of the first half.

Patrick Brothers gave Leiston hope six minutes after the break and Emmanuel Osei completed the comeback with 11 minutes left.

Carshalton now prop up the table after going down 1-0 at home to **Thurrock**, who are also out of the bottom two with their second successive win.

In a game that barely survived the heady rain, Rhys Paul claimed the only goal ten minutes after the interval, pouncing when Nick Hamann could only parry a shot from Harry Honesty.

Bury moved into the play-off places with a 4-2 home win over **Wingate** in a lively affair. John Sands headed them into a 24th-minute lead which was immediately wiped out by Murat Karagul.

Sands scored again moments after half-time, but Wingate again replied when Leon Smith broke away to score in the 55th minute. The hosts went ahead for the third time, this time to stay, three minutes later as Mark Coulson's cross found its way into the net and Sam Reed made sure with eight minutes left.

Jason Hallett, scorer of 13 goals in **Concord**'s last two midweek games, forced his way into their starting line-up for their home game against **Whitehawk** and was inches away from converting Danny Glozier's early cross.

That was as close as he came to extending his scoring run as two in-form sides fought out a 2-2 draw. A wonderful solo goal from Jed Wallace put Hawks in front on the half-hour but Danny Spendlove replied in the 37th

minute and provided the free-kick which Nicky Cowley headed home soon after the interval to give the Beachboys the lead.

Hawks responded in the 69th minute when Wallace was denied another individual goal by keeper Michael Jordan and Josh Jones converted the loose ball. With their closest rivals sidelined by the weather or the FA Trophy, the Sussex side moved two points clear at the top.

Met Police, unbeaten at home, entertained **Lewes**, without an away win, and it looked as if a Chris Breach goal after 55 minutes of an uneventful game would end both those records. But with five minutes left Steve Robinson, who had been outstanding in the Lewes defence, brought down Jonte Smith and the young striker made no mistake with the penalty to claim his 23rd goal of the season. It was the Met's third draw in five home games and Lewes's fifth draw in nine away matches.

Ryman North

RUNAWAY leaders **Maldon** moved ten points clear of the field as they crushed visiting **Cheshunt** 6-1 on Saturday to chalk up their 11th successive league victory.

Draws at Aveyley and Potters Bar are the only blemishes on their unbeaten record, they are the first team in the league to reach the 50-goal mark and this was their eighth win out of eight at home. So it must have been with acute frustration that they totted up the takings from a crowd of just 51.

Maldon were without top scorers Jamie Guy and James Robinson, so Cheshunt must have had high hopes of an upset as they held out for most of the first half. But Joe Gardner made the breakthrough four minutes before the interval and struck again five minutes after it.

Chris Bryan's 63rd-minute penalty was followed by a quickfire double from Aaron Best and Ben Bradbury. Liam Foster managed a consolation goal in the 87th minute but there was still time for Dave Wareham to complete the six-hit with that 50th of the season.

Local rivals **Heybridge** moved into second place in equally convincing style, hitting five unanswered goals at **Romford**. In fairness to the hosts, there was little between the teams for more than an hour with Solomon Ofori's 30th-minute goal all that separated them.

Ofori nabbed his second on 65 minutes and Swifts then flew away with it. New signing James Bunn made it 3-0 and Michael Cheek added two late goals. He should have had a hat-trick, but missed an even later penalty.

Thamesmead moved into the top five with a 2-1 home win over **Waltham Forest**, though it threatened to be much more decisive. Sean Roberts scored in the first minute and set up the second for Rob Carter in the 20th. Forest refused to be overrun and debutant Kery Kedze netted after 65 minutes to make it an edgy finish for their hosts.

Potters Bar had a day to forget as they went down 3-0 at **Soham**, who are up to eighth. Luke Stanley scored after 19 minutes and Rob Mason added another on the stroke of half-time.

If it could go wrong for the visitors in the closing stages, it did. They lost new keeper Yilmaz Aksoy to injury, Wes Beckles put through his own net and Jack Friend was sent off.

Brentwood led for 90 minutes at **Needham Market** and came away with just a 1-1 draw. Darren Blewitt's third-minute header gave Blues the advantage and it was deep into injury time when Kieran Leabon rescued the Marketmen, who are still seeking a three-point haul on home turf after eight attempts.

TWO late goals by Danny Carr fired **Dulwich** to the top of the table with a 2-1 victory at **Three Bridges**, where 326 braved Saturday's driving rain to watch the action on a pitch that remained in near-perfect condition.

The visitors always had a slight edge with their neat passing game but were frustrated by several excellent Alan Mansfield saves and fell behind to a goal by Marcus Elliott two minutes before the interval.

A floodlight failure after an hour – the third such event in Sussex in recent weeks – delayed proceedings for 15 minutes and Dulwich raised their game after the restart. Carr, who scored four times in a League Cup tie on Tuesday, rounded keeper Alan Mansfield to equalise on 74 minutes and repeated the trick in the 87th minute to win it.

Crawley Down moved up to fourth with a 1-0 win at **Corinthian-Casuals** which owed much to the outstanding form of Tony Di Bernardo between the posts. He was fully rewarded by Fraser Logan's free-kick a minute before the interval.

The Anvils overtook **Sittingbourne**, who were held to a 2-2 home draw by **Merstham** but stay in the top five. Ryan Golding's tenth league goal of the season came after 12 minutes and gave the Brickies a half-time lead.

Then came a burst of three goals in as many minutes early in the second half. Lee Newman equalised, Golding made it 2-1 and Newman again responded.

Tooting's improved form continued with a 3-2 home win over **Whitstable**. It looked easy as Carl Wilson-Denis scored in the third minute and further goals by Trevor Rowe and Taurean Roberts made it 3-0 with little more than half an hour gone.

Damian Abel pulled one back with a 58th-minute penalty for a foul on Sean Raggett and when Stuart Vahid struck a minute later it condemned Tooting to a nervous half-hour. But they held out and moved up to ninth.

A point behind them in tenth place are **Worthing**, a remarkably lofty placing for a side that have lost six of their seven home games. Their away form has been a different story and they collected their sixth victory with four unanswered goals at **Chipstead**.

Chris O'Flaherty got three of them, the only hat-trick in the league after the previous Saturday's bonanza of ten such feats. His free-kick opened the scoring on 18 minutes and he quickly added another. Luke Gedling made it 3-0 early in the second half and O'Flaherty completed the scoring with 35 minutes still remaining.

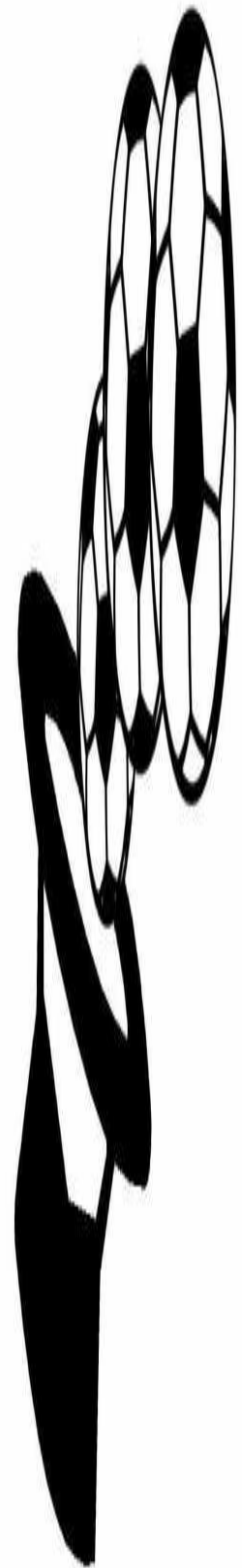
