Ryman Premier

THE battle at the bottom of the Ryman Premier table on Saturday went the way of **Hendon**, who scored with their first three shots to see off visiting **Carshalton** 3-1 and leave the Robins three points adrift.

In a drab game of few chances, Hendon took control with goals in the last seven minutes of the first half from Julian Owusu and Belal Aite-Ouakrim.

Josh Clarke pulled one back 11 minutes into the second half but Hendon made sure of three precious points when Dave Diedhiou netted six minutes from time.

Hendon remain in the relegation places but now trail **Thurrock** only on goal difference after the Essex club were held to a 1-1 draw at **Enfield Town**. Harry Honesty put Mark Stimson's men ahead on nine minutes and Adam Wallace equalised for Town ten minutes later.

Wingate, two points ahead of Thurrock, held out for an hour at table-topping **Margate**. Then John Beales dived to head home a cross from Alex Rhodes, who added a late goal himself to complete a 2-0 victory and maintain Margate's one-point lead.

Hot on their heels, with a game in hand, are **Whitehawk**, who came from 2-0 down in their derby at **Lewes** to win 3-2 despite being reduced to ten men.

Headers either side of half-time from Danny Walder and Ben Godfrey put Lewes in charge but Hawks then introduced substitute Jefferson Louis, on loan from Newport to the 27th club of his career, and immediately looked more dangerous.

Danny Mills pulled one back on 55 minutes, Louis headed the equaliser in the 72nd minute and, although Sami El-Abd was sent off shortly afterwards, Hawks won it through Josh Jones with eight minutes left.

Third-placed **Wealdstone** are four points behind Whitehawk after a Jack Defty hat-trick sent them crashing to a 3-0 defeat at **Lowestoft**, who moved up to fifth. Defty headed a 21st-minute opener, scored again in the 49th minute and completed his treble with another header four minutes from time.

Bury also climbed into the play-off spots, taking over fourth place with a 3-2 victory at **Hampton**. The hosts paid the price for their wasteful finishing in the first half, when they should have added to a lone goal by Neil Jenkins after 28 minutes.

John Sands and Craig Parker scored in the first 12 minutes after the interval to put Bury in front and, although Charlie Moone headed Hampton back on to level terms in the 72nd minute, the visitors quickly regained the lead when Parker was fouled in the box and converted the penalty himself.

To complete a good day for the Suffolk trio in the division, **Leiston** chalked up their first away win and ended **Met Police**'s unbeaten home record. A single goal by Emmanuel Osei in the 71st minute decided it, and it could have been more as the visitors dictated the game.

It was a tale of two penalties at **Kingstonian**. Andre McCollin, who had earlier hit a post, converted a 43rd-minute kick for the home side after an offence for which **Bognor** keeper Craig Stoner was sent off. A foul on Harvey Whyte gave Bognor the chance to level it in the 71st minute but James Crane's kick was saved by Rob Tolfrey and Bognor's unbeaten away record ended.

Cray were the only other side in the division who were undefeated on their travels and they, too, lost their record to a single goal. That was at **Canvey**, where a lively game was not settled until Bradley Woods-Garness polished off a Louis Dennis pass with six minutes left.

Hastings, five days away from their FA Cup replay against **Harrogate**, drew 2-2 with Concord at the Pilot Field. Steve King's foul on Zac Attwood allowed Lee Carey to put the hosts ahead with a 35th-minute penalty but Tony Stokes replied just on half-time and then put Concord ahead in the 70th minute, becoming the division's top scorer with his 12th league goal. Jono Richardson quickly squared it again and Hastings had chances to win it.

East Thurrock came out on top by the odd goal in five at **Harrow**. They took a fifth-minute lead through Sam Collins and, after Frankie Merrifield made it 1-1 in the 32nd minute, Kris Newby restored the advantage before half-time. Hakeem Araba added the third just after the hour when James Lawson's header came back off the bar and Simeon Akinola's 77th-minute free-kick was not enough to save the hosts.

Ryman North

WHAT next for unpredictable **Heybridge**? They followed up a 5-0 victory at Romford in their last Ryman North away game by going one better at **Ilford** yesterday (Saturday), hitting six unanswered goals. Promotion form indeed, were it not for the 8-2 home defeat by Soham in between those two away triumphs!

Michael Cheek put them ahead in the 10th minute at Ilford and fluked another midway through the half when a defensive clearance hit him and cannoned into the net.

Then came a three-goal blitz in the last five minutes of the first half: a deflected shot by Ben Newson, a Cheek effort that went in off the bar to complete his hat-trick and a header by Luke Callander from a cross by Solomon Ofori, who added the sixth goal himself after 67 minutes. It was his tenth goal in league and FA competitions, making him the fourth Swift to reach double figures. Cheek has 18 goals, Callander and Newson 16 apiece.

Maldon's Jamie Guy is one ahead of Cheek and Callander at the top of the division's scoring charts after his 12th-minute penalty, his 15th league goal, earned the unbeaten leaders a 1-0 home win over **Thamesmead**. It extended their 100 per cent home record to nine games and their winning overall run to 13.

They are now 12 points clear at the top, though they were tested to the full by a lively Thamesmead side who almost got the equaliser they would have deserved when Chris Edwards hit the bar with a free-kick.

Grays moved into second place despite being held to a 1-1 home draw by **Witham**, for whom Lewis Goldbold scored in the ninth minute. Joe Sweeney replied after 21 minutes with a deflected shot.

Aveley dropped to third after going down 2-1 at **Romford**. Petrit Elbi put Millers ahead after 11 minutes and was denied a second by a post. Romford made the most of that slice of luck. Billy Hunt squared it just before the interval and Matt Toms nodded a 69th-minute winner when a Nick Reynolds header came back off the bar.

Heybridge and Thamesmead complete the top five, though Thamesmead now lead **Potters Bar** only on goal difference after a 43rd-minute free-kick by Josh Urquhart earned the Scholars a 1-0 home win over **Waltham Abbey**.

Ware gained the first victory of the season in their second game under new boss Nick Ironton, beating **Waltham Forest** 2-0 at Wodson Park. It might have been different if Corey Whitely's shot had given Forest the lead instead of hitting the bar.

As it was, Ricci Crace put Ware in front five minutes before the interval and substitute Tony Martin scored with his first touch midway through the second half. Ware had Martin Standen sent off but it was too late to offer Forest a lifeline.

Ware are now just one point behind Ilford in the fight to avoid the sole relegation place. Ilford in turn are three points adrift of **Redbridge**, who moved above them with a 3-1 victory at **Wroxham**.

Jacob Cleaver was the axeman, scoring twice in the first 20 minutes with Ben Thompson netting for the Yachtsmen in between. Lee Martin clinched it for the Motormen in the fourth minute of added time.

Soham were involved in a goal feast for the second successive Saturday, but they came down to earth after that stunning win at Heybridge with a 6-3 defeat at **Brentwood**.

Rob Mason scored a hat-trick for the visitors but he was topped by Alex Read, who slammed a hat-trick – his fourth in recent weeks - in ten minutes as a rapid response to Mason's 24th-minute opener.

Abs Seymour made it 4-1 at half-time and Daryl Robson added another before Mason got his second. A foul on Abs Thompson allowed Read to score his fourth from the spot with ten minutes left. Mason's third was only a consolation goal but it was Soham's 31st away from home, the most in any division.

The frustration goes on for **Needham Market**, still without a home win after nine attempts. They could hardly have come closer this time. Danny Bloomfield put them ahead on the half-hour and Piers Wixon replied for **Harlow** ten minutes after the break.

Duane Wright put the Marketmen ahead again with 16 minutes left but two great saves by Bertrand Bossu denied them a clincher and Wixon made it 2-2 deep into added time.

An early goal by Rodrigue N'Diane set **Chatham** on their way to a 2-0 home win over **Sudbury**, who had much of the possession but could not make it count. Liam Hickey got the second in the 37th minute.

Cheshunt were also given a boost by an early goal, a seventh-minute effort by John Megicks. **Tilbury** keeper James Marrable saved a Tony Burke penalty to deny the hosts a second before the interval but Courtney White made it 2-0 in the 58th minute, pouncing after Tommy Fletcher's shot hit the bar, and Dave Greene added another before Jake Pooley's late consolation for the Dockers.

Ryman South

SIGNING Stuart King, the league's top scorer, from Folkestone, has done **Maidstone's** Ryman South title prospects no harm at all and he opened his account for his new club with a tenth-minute goal yesterday (Saturday), his 16th in the league.

That was all Stones needed for their 1-0 win at **Leatherhead**, though they lost keeper Charlie Mitten with a suspected broken arm in the first half and his replacement, Deren Ibrahim, had to pull off one excellent save from Tom Bradbrook to deny Tenners an equaliser.

Stones remain two points behind leaders **Dulwich**, who thrashed **Horsham** 4-0, with three games in hand. Hamlet's 18-year-old striker Danny Carr maintained his run of form with a hat-trick after Horsham keeper Michael Hunter had pushed a corner into his own net for the 15th-minute opener.

Carr headed his first soon afterwards but had to wait until the last ten minutes for his other goals. By then Horsham were down to ten men after Ryan Woodford's dismissal.

Dave Cook took his goal tally for **Hythe** into three figures with a double in their 2-0 victory at **Eastbourne**. He netted a 19th-minute penalty and added his ton-up goal on the stroke of half-time. Hythe stay level on points with Maidstone though they, too, have played three more games.

It was Hythe's seventh away win, a league-best total they share with **Worthing** after the Sussex club gained an important 2-1 victory at **Sittingbourne**. The losers remained in fourth place but Rebels, who are seventh, are now just one point behind them.

A foul on Joe Taylor allowed Ryan Golding to give the Brickies a 27th-minute lead from the spot but goals late in the first half by Tom Lawley and Nick Sullivan turned it round.

Crawley Down hung on to fifth place despite being held to a 1-1 draw by lowly **Whitstable**. Steve Sargent hit the bar for the hosts before Luke Blewden gave them a 65th-minute lead. But the Oystermen deserved some reward from the game and they got it when Sean Raggett scored with five minutes left.

Burgess Hill, in sixth place, moved level on points with the two sides above them after their 2-0 home win over **Three Bridges**. Both goals came in the last 13 minutes, with an own goal by Dean Carden swiftly followed by Kai Bichard's first strike since his move from Tooting.

Faversham crushed bottom club **Walton Casuals** 7-0 to record only their second home win of the season. Casuals conceded three penalties and had two goalkeepers sent off.

Renford Tenyou opened the scoring after seven minutes and Wayne Wilson added a penalty on the half-hour before things started to go seriously wrong for the visitors. Matt Pegler was sent off for conceding a penalty five minutes before the interval, again converted by Wilson, and Tenyue made it 4-0 at the break.

Deputy keeper Michael Corbett was given his marching orders in the 83rd minute and striker Greg Andrews, just signed from Leatherhead, completed his debut in unexpected fashion by taking over between the posts.

He could not prevent Tenyue completing his hat-trick from the resulting penalty and was then beaten twice in a minute by Kieran Oliver as Faversham improved their goal difference.

A poor back-pass allowed Joe Nwoko to score a 15th-minute goal for **Chipstead** and set them on their way to a 3-0 home win over **Ramsgate**. Shaun Preddie made it 2-0 early in the second half and Nwoko got his second midway through.

Merstham were also 3-0 winners, at **Herne Bay** who have come down to earth after a bright start to Ryman life. Luke I'anson's 36th-minute strike was all that separated the sides until the 79th minute, when Liam Wright made it 2-0. I'anson quickly added the clincher.

One goal was enough for **Folkestone**, a 20-yarder by Luke Webb in the 75th minute, though Laurent Hamici three times came close to equalising for visitors **Tooting**.

The scoreline was the same at **Walton & Hersham**, where Harold Odometey scored after 58 minutes to see off **Corinthian-Casuals**. The Swans are down in 13th spot but within four points of the play-off places.
