## Ryman Premier

A FIRST-MINUTE goal by Nathan Crabb set **Lewes** on course for their first away league win of the season on Saturday – and they did it in style with a 6-3 romp at in-form **Concord**. Ben Godfrey made it 2-0 after 14 minutes and, after Tony Stokes pulled one back in the 33<sup>rd</sup> minute, Chris Breach quickly restored the two-goal gap.

Jon Dollery's lob made it 4-1 midway through the second half and, although Jack Lampe quickly responded, Lewes would not be denied. Crabb got his second in the 84<sup>th</sup> minute and completed his hat-trick with a penalty in added time. Stokes still had time to notch his second, his 14<sup>th</sup> league goal of the season, strengthening his lead in the race for the division's Golden Boot.

The top-of-the-table clash between second-placed **Whitehawk** and leaders **Margate** was abandoned early in the second half after a cloudburst. Hawks were leading with a 29<sup>th</sup>-minute goal by Josh Jones.

That gave their pursuers the chance to close the gap and **Wealdstone** made no mistake, extending their long unbeaten home record by thrashing **Enfield Town** 4-0. They are five points behind Margate with three games in hand. There was little between the sides in the first half but it was Stones who found the net twice in as many minutes just before the half-hour. Richard Jolly took his league tally into double figures and Wes Parker added the second. Chris Moore effectively killed the game with a third two minutes after the break and he completed the scoring with a late header.

**Lowestoft** moved into a threatening fourth place with a 2-0 victory at **East Thurrock**. The Trawlerboys were reduced to ten men by a red card for Michael Frew after 30 minutes but, five minutes later, a moment of madness by Kris Newby levelled the numbers and handed Lowestoft a penalty, which Dale Cockrill converted. The home side dominated the second half but Jack Defty's 81<sup>st</sup>-minute strike secured the points for the Suffolk club.

**Bognor** also moved into the top five after beating lowly **Hendon** 3-1 at Nyewood Lane. It was a tight, scoreless affair until the 74<sup>th</sup> minute, when visiting keeper Berkley Laurencin parried a shot from James Crane and Harvey Whyte pounced on the loose ball. Terry Dodd added a second and a long-range lob by Daryl Wollers made it 3-0, leaving Hendon, who stay in 21<sup>st</sup> place, the slim consolation of a goal by Dean Cracknell in added time.

Bottom club **Carshalton** had a day to forget, finishing with nine men in their 2-0 home defeat by **Canvey**. Jay Curran scored early in each half to leave Carshalton without a point from their last eight games. To make matters worse, they had Tommy Brewer and Ricardo Joseph sent off in the second half.

Two sides struggling for form met at **Wingate** and it was **Hampton** who ended a run of four successive defeats with three unanswered goals, moving up three places to sixth. Gary Burrell missed two good early chances for the hosts, who have now taken one point from their last six, and Jon-Jo Bates put Hampton ahead two minutes before half-time. Tom Hickey doubled the lead with 11 minutes left and Joe Turner wrapped it up with a diving header.

**Bury** dropped from fourth to seventh after their 2-0 home defeat by **Met Police**. Allan Tait opened the scoring after 20 minutes and John Kennedy turned a cross into his own net shortly before half-time. David Knight almost added a third with a shot that struck a post.

FA Cup heroes **Hastings**, with little time to recover from their extra-time marathon on Thursday, will probably be satisfied with their 1-1 draw at **Thurrock**, who took a 37<sup>th</sup>-minute lead through debutant Danny Green. They had Ben Walster sent off midway through the second half and Hastings made the most of their extra man with an equaliser from Zac Attwood nine minutes later.

**Leiston** continued to move away from the danger zone with their third successive win, though they needed a slice of luck to see off visiting **Harrow**. After 89 scoreless minutes, Harrow keeper Elvijs Putnans parried a shot from Patrick Brothers and Michael Peacock's attempted clearance flew into his own net.

**Kingstonian** jumped from ninth to sixth, trailing Lowestoft and Bognor only on goal difference, with a 3-1 win at **Cray** on Sunday. There were plenty of chances at both ends, most of them falling to Cray, but no goals until the 77th minute when Wade Small's cool finish put K's ahead.

Andre McCollin doubled the lead nine minutes later with a penalty, his 12<sup>th</sup> league goal. Jack Clark pulled one back right on 90 minutes with a long-range daisy-cutter but K's completed the late goal rush three minutes into added time when Matt Pattison rifled home Dean Lodge's cross.

## Ryman North

MARVELLOUS **Maldon** reached the 50-point mark with a 1-0 victory at **Harlow** on Saturday. No-one else in the league has more than 36 and they are 15 points clear in their division.

Their 14<sup>th</sup> successive win was probably their luckiest. Harlow had much the better of the game but failed to take their chances and lost out to Jamie Guy's 16<sup>th</sup> league goal of the season in the 73<sup>rd</sup> minute. Harlow's hopes of hitting back were dented when Michael Akande was sent off shortly afterwards.

It was a good day for second-placed Grays even though their game at Redbridge was postponed: the three sides immediately behind them were all beaten.

**Aveley**, who were third, had an afternoon to forget, losing 4-1 at home to **Wroxham** and finishing with nine men. Jamie Speller put Wroxham ahead after 35 minutes and the game turned decisively their way five minutes later, when Aveley keeper Jason Willis was dismissed after clashing with Ross Durrant and Gavin Lemmon converted the penalty. Speller made it 3-0 soon after half-time and Jordan Cox was given his marching orders on the hour. Durrant added a fourth before Paul Burnett managed a consolation goal for the depleted Millers.

That result meant that **Heybridge** took over third place, on goals scored, despite their own 3-1 home defeat by **Brentwood**. Abs Seymour broke the deadlock on the stroke of half-time and Alex Read continued his prolific form by making it 2-0 just before the hour. Ben Newson pulled one back but Michael Cheek missed a penalty that would have made it 2-2 and Read punished him with a clincher, his 14<sup>th</sup> league goal to go with nine in the FA competitions.

**Thamesmead**, who were fifth, went down 3-2 at home to **Cheshunt**. After a scoreless first half, Baff Addae gave the hosts a 47<sup>th</sup>-minute lead which was immediately wiped out by Courtney White. A Chris Edwards free-kick soon put Thamesmead in front again but White's header went in off the bar to square it with 12 minutes left. It could have gone either way after that, but it was Cheshunt who took the points with an 84<sup>th</sup>-minute header by 17-year-old Tommy Fletcher.

That enabled **Potters Bar** to reclaim fifth place with a comfortable 4-1 win at **Waltham Forest**. Jamie-Lee O'Donoghue's long-range shot gave them a fourth-minute lead which was extended by Danny Johnson in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute. Jose Espinoza struck twice in eight minutes around the hour mark, leaving Forest the consolation of a Corey Whitely goal in the 73<sup>rd</sup> minute.

The next three sides in the table all won to maintain their bids for a play-off place. A single goal was enough for **Soham** at home to **Chatham**. It came from Luke Stanley after 14 minutes and the free-scoring Rob Mason should have added two or three more before half-time, hitting the bar with his closest effort.

**Tilbury** dented **Needham Market**'s impressive away record, helped by Jordan Pavett's 32<sup>nd</sup>-minute red card. Sam Cutler gave Dockers the lead five minutes after half-time with a shot that hit the underside of the bar and sparked an 'over-the-line' controversy. Duane Wright's own goal doubled the lead in the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute and, although he made amends by scoring at the 'wright' end 11 minutes later, Needham could not avert a 2-1 defeat.

**Witham** edged out **Romford** 1-0, defending well after Emeka Onwubiko's goal in the 21<sup>st</sup> minute. Romford skipper Jack Barry was sent off near the end.

Bottom club **Ware** had the chance to move up two places thanks to the postponements which sidelined Redbridge and Ilford but they failed to take it, going down 2-0 at **Sudbury**. Tom Cutts broke the deadlock after 55 minutes and Dave Cowley secured a very welcome victory for the hosts four minutes into added time.

## Ryman South

THIRD met fourth on Saturday, and with the top two sidelined it was a chance for **Hythe** or **Sittingbourne** to improve their own prospects. Hythe, in fact, would have drawn level on points with leaders Maidstone had they won, but they needed a 90<sup>th</sup>-minute goal by Dave Cook, his 15<sup>th</sup> in the league, to salvage a 1-1 draw and they stay in third place. The Brickies had led since the third minute, when Tom Loynes found the net.

Their dropped points allowed **Burgess Hill** to take over fourth place with a 1-0 victory at **Horsham**. A poor game was settled, fittingly enough, by a mistake. Ten minutes after the interval a Hornets clearance went straight to Pat Harding, who found the net from 25 yards for his 14<sup>th</sup> league goal.

**Crawley Down** dropped out of the play-off places after being held to a 2-2 draw at **Worthing**. They led in each half, through Fraser Logan and Jamie Cade, but were hauled back by Nick Sullivan's header and then, with eight minutes left, by Matt Daniel. It was the first time all season that Worthing have shared the points.

A deflected shot by Jamie Maxted kept **Faversham** well in the hunt with a 2-1 win at **Corinthian-Casuals**. Lawrence Harvey put the visitors ahead on the half-hour and, after Jamie Cottee levelled it from 25 yards in the 65<sup>th</sup> minute, Maxted restored the lead five minutes later.

**Leatherhead** are also contending strongly for a top-five place after their 3-1 victory at **Three Bridges**. The hosts went ahead with a 36<sup>th</sup>-minute goal by Williams Peuroux, who marked his return to the club by heading home after Joel O'Hara's shot hit the bar. Mark Simmons replied with a free-kick two minutes later and Tom Bradbrook's header gave the Tanners a 70<sup>th</sup>-minute lead which was extended within a minute by Sam Blackman.

Bridges now lead bottom club **Walton Casuals** only on goal difference after Casuals drew 1-1 at home to **Herne Bay**. Sol Patterson-Bohner put the home side ahead after 24 minutes and missed a good chance to make it 2-0 before Dan Wisker equalised in the 62<sup>nd</sup> minute.

Laurent Hamici went close several times for **Tooting** but it was lanky Carl Wilson-Denis who gave them the lead early in the second half. It looked as if it would be enough, but Sam Robinson grabbed a last-gasp equaliser for visiting **Chipstead**.

**Ramsgate** and **Eastbourne** slogged out a scoreless draw in Kent. The best chances fell to Ramsgate's Ian Pulman but his goal touch was missing.

In a division where visiting clubs have had the upper hand all season, that adds up to five draws and three away victories. The sole home success came at **Whitstable**, where **Walton & Hersham** were beaten 3-0. Micheal Everitt opened the scoring with an 11<sup>th</sup>-minute header and Buster Smissen grabbed the second shortly before the interval, pouncing when Dan Hanshaw's shot was parried. Hanshaw made it 3-0 with 17 minutes left.

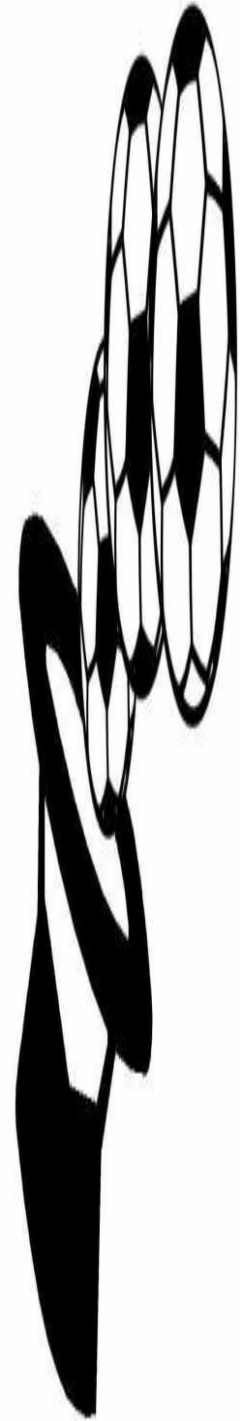
