## Ryman Premier

LEADERS **Whitehawk** made the most of the weather which sidelined their nearest rivals to move ten points clear of the field with a 3-2 victory at **Wingate** on Saturday.

Second-placed **Margate** had their game at home to **Leiston** called off shortly before kick-off and **Concord**, in third spot, suffered an earlier postponement of their match at **Hampton** as heavy rain swept across the south.

Hawks took command of their game with goals by Michael Malcolm in the 34<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> minutes. Anthony Thomas pounced on a defensive error to pull one back straight after half-time but James Fraser's deflected free-kick quickly restored the two-goal margin and Hawks held on after Daniel Brown's 71<sup>st</sup>-minute reply.

**Wealdstone** are now second, edging ahead of Margate on goal difference after Alex Dyer's 73<sup>rd</sup>-minute goal earned them a 1-0 home win over **Bognor**, who were denied a last-minute equaliser when Peter Dean cleared Stuart Axten's header off the line.

**Canvey** moved up to fourth, ahead of neighbours Concord, thanks to a Bradley Woods-Garness double in a 2-0 win over **Thurrock** on the island. He netted his first after 20 minutes and added his second, his 13<sup>th</sup> league goal, 16 minutes from time, immediately after Robbie Norris was denied an equaliser by the crossbar.

**Lowestoft** are a menacing sixth, with at least two games in hand on all the teams above them, after their own 2-0 home win. Blake Saker's 25-yarder made the breakthrough against **Lewes** nine minutes after the interval and Jack Defty knocked in a loose ball in the 73<sup>rd</sup> minute.

**Kingstonian** slipped back to seventh after losing to a lone goal at **Hendon**, for whom it was the third 1-0 victory in four games. K's were on top for most of the game and Andre McCollin hit a Hendon post before Jack Connors scored the decisive goal on 41 minutes.

Even after Wade Small's dismissal with 25 minutes to go left them with ten men, K's continued to apply pressure but could find no way through.

**East Thurrock** moved into the top half of the table with a 2-1 win at **Bury**, who took the lead six minutes after half-time when John Sands took his league tally to 13. Liam Burgess levelled it seven minutes later and Kye Ruel nabbed the winner in the 71<sup>st</sup> minute.

Bottom club **Carshalton** came from behind to earn a 2-1 home win over out-of-form **Cray**, though they remain at the foot of the table, trailing Thurrock and Hastings on goal difference. Leigh Bremner won and converted a 26<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty for the Wands but a long-range shot by Hakeem Adelakun slipped through the grasp of visiting keeper Andy Walker five minutes later and Luke Nolan won it in style with seven minutes left, another long-distance effort but one that gave Walker no chance at all.

After FA Cup dreamland, reality for **Hastings** is a relegation battle after they slipped into 21<sup>st</sup> place with a lone-goal defeat at fellow-strugglers **Enfield Town**. Liam Hope and Michael Bardle both hit the Hastings woodwork before veteran Scott McGleish netted the 77<sup>th</sup>-minute winner, lifting Enfield to 17<sup>th</sup> place. But they are only two points ahead of Carshalton.

**Harrow** are also deeply involved in the fight for survival, leading the bottom trio by the point they earned in a 1-1 draw at **Met Police**. The Met had the better chances in a poor game and took the lead in the 13<sup>th</sup> minute with an inswinging corner by Ty Smith. A well-taken goal by Charles Ofusu-Hene levelled matters in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute.

## Ryman North

THE unstoppable forces met immovable objects on Saturday as leaders Maldon and second-placed Heybridge, the league's top scorers, were held to goalless draws.

**Maldon** dropped their first home points of the season, after ten successive wins, as Louis Bristow led a determined **Waltham Abbey** rearguard action.

Neighbours **Heybridge**, meanwhile, drew a blank at **Witham** where the hosts had the better of the first half and Swifts were on top in the second.

So Maldon maintained their 13-point lead while Heybridge held on to second place only on goal difference from **Grays**, for whom Jeff Hammond's 20<sup>th</sup>-minute header was enough for three points at **Needham Market**.

The Marketmen are still without a home victory after 11 attempts and it would have been worse for them if Jack West had converted a second-half penalty.

The five clubs behind Grays all won as well, headed by **Aveley** who thrashed **Chatham** 5-1 at the Mill Field. It was 2-0 after only ten minutes thanks to Matt Newman's own goal and a Junior Dadson strike, though Lee Hales quickly pulled one back and only a goalline clearance denied Kes Metitiri an equaliser before half-time.

It was the 75<sup>th</sup> minute before Dadson stretched Aveley's lead again and their top scorer Jordan Cox added two more in the last eight minutes.

**Potters Bar** stayed in fifth place, seeing off ten-man visitors **Sudbury** 4-1. Ashley Shloots was sent off as early as the 12th minute but Cole Penny missed the penalty that followed and Daniel Ailey's 21st-minute strike was all that separated the sides at the interval.

Cole made amends with a goal soon after the restart and Danny Johnson wrapped it up with two in five minutes midway through the half, leaving Sudbury the slim consolation of a last-minute Leon Antoine reply.

**Soham** are a point behind the Scholars with a game in hand after a late rally to snatch a 3-2 victory at **Cheshunt**. Courtney White put the Ambers ahead after 18 minutes and repeated the trick just before half-time, after Robbie Mason had equalised. Matt Robinson made it 2-2 in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute and Luke Stanley grabbed the winner with two minutes left.

**Thamesmead** trail Soham only on goal difference and have played two fewer games. They had no trouble seeing off bottom club **Ilford** with four unanswered goals at Bayliss Avenue. Stuart Zanone opened the scoring after 20 minutes and Ashley Probets added a penalty and a free-kick in the last three minutes of the first half. Lea Dawson made it four with a late header.

**Tilbury**, who chalked up a 3-2 home win over **Wroxham**, have played the same number of games as Thamesmead and are one point behind them. Danny Francis earned a penalty which Aaron Waters converted in the 23<sup>rd</sup> minute, and scored himself six minutes later. Emiel Aiken made it 3-0 with 20 minutes left. Ben Thompson pulled one back for the Yachtsmen soon afterwards but their second, from Jamie Forshaw, did not arrive until the last minute.

There was no change at the bottom, where Ilford remain one point behind Redbridge and Ware. **Harlow**'s 1-0 win over visiting **Redbridge** means there is now a 14-point gap between 19<sup>th</sup> place and the three strugglers. The Hawks dominated the game but managed to score only on the hour when Mitchell Das sunk his old club by heading in Hector Mackie's cross.

**Ware** were beaten 4-1 at **Romford**. It was 3-0 at half-time after Matt Toms set up the 13<sup>th</sup>-minute opener for Nick Reynolds, who returned the favour for Toms to get the second just before the half-hour. Reynolds struck again in added time. Charlie Moxom gave Ware a glimmer of hope in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute but Jack Barry soon restored the three-goal margin.

**Brentwood** have high hopes of using their numerous games in hand to get into the play-off battle but lost ground with a 1-0 defeat at **Waltham Forest**. Arian Retkoceri fired a long-range winner with five minutes to go.

## Ryman South

IT'S not looking good for **Three Bridges** in their Ryman League debut season. They let a 2-0 lead slip and were beaten by a last-minute goal in their all-important home game with **Walton Casuals** on Saturday. The 3-2 defeat leaves the Sussex club five points adrift at the bottom.

Casuals, who were bottom themselves on Wednesday morning, made it two away wins in four days, but not before Bridges had seemingly taken command with goals by Tim Rivers in the sixth minute and Hassan Nyang, against his previous club, in the 40th. James MacShane and Dylan Cascoe squared it with two goals in four minutes midway through the second half, and Matt York completed the comeback with a last-gasp volley.

At the other end of the table, **Dulwich** found a Friend in need as they extended their lead over Maidstone to three points with a 2-0 victory at **Folkestone**. Danny Carr hit a Folkestone post during the first half but Dulwich had to wait until an hour had gone for their opener, an own goal by Liam Friend. Erhun Oztumer made it 2-0 ten minutes later.

**Maidstone** had to come from two down to earn a 2-2 home draw against **Crawley Down** in front of 1,733 spectators. The Anvils took a 19<sup>th</sup>-minute lead through Jamie Cade and struck again two minutes later when Fraser Logan's free-kick eluded the grasp of keeper Deren Ibrahim.

Stones were rescued by substitute Ade Olorunda, who scored his first league goal of the season in the 67th minute and nabbed another one five minutes later.

Many people thought that Maidstone's artificial pitch would give them an unfair advantage might but they have won only six of their 11 home matches.

Their away record is much better, though that is no surprise in this division which yielded six away wins and only two home victories (in both of which the away team scored first), taking the season's tally to 109-88 in favour of visiting clubs.

Third-placed **Leatherhead** were one of the sides who managed to win on home soil, beating **Merstham** 3-1. Former Tanner Jack Macleod put the visitors ahead after 26 minutes but Jamie Coyle quickly replied and Tommy Hutchings put the hosts ahead with a 25-yarder soon after the interval. Liam Wright added the third in the 56<sup>th</sup> minute, his first goal since joining Tanners from Merstham.

**Sittingbourne** moved above Crawley Down into fourth place with a 5-0 romp at **Walton & Hersham**, who had a day to forget. They missed a penalty, conceded three, had two men sent off and rounded it off with an own goal.

Ryan Golding gave the Brickies a fourth-minute lead with the day's only 'normal' goal. Graeme Purdy missed a chance to equalise from the spot but Golding made no such mistake, completing his hat-trick with penalties in the 28<sup>th</sup> and 57<sup>th</sup> minutes.

Walton's Mark McLeod was sent off and he was soon joined by Liam Flanighan, the latter in the 81<sup>st</sup> minute for an offence which produced the day's fourth penalty, this one converted by Joe Taylor. Chris Grayland's own goal completed the misery.

**Tooting** had Laurent Hamici to thank for the day's other home win. He scored twice in the last six minutes to snatch a 3-2 victory over **Hythe**, who have lost all three matches in 2013 and fallen out of the play-off places.

Dave Cook's 18<sup>th</sup> league goal gave Hythe the lead after 19 minutes. Tyrone Berry squared it on the stroke of half-time but Jake Hobbs restored the Kent side's lead with 20 minutes left.

The two sides below Hythe, **Burgess Hill** and **Faversham**, were both victims of the weather. Hillians' home game against **Herne Bay** and Faversham's trip to **Horsham** were both called off in the morning.

Billy Medlock made his debut for **Worthing** after moving down the road from Horsham and celebrated with a hat-trick as they came from behind to win 4-1 at **Corinthian-Casuals**.

Joel Thompson's lob gave Casuals an early lead which Medlock wiped out in the 35<sup>th</sup> minute. Shortly afterwards he converted a penalty after he had been fouled, and he completed his treble midway through the second half. Matt Daniel wrapped up Worthing's eighth away victory, not quite enough to make up for their nine home defeats.

Matt Crabb doubled his total of league goals with two in the first five minutes at **Chipstead**, setting **Eastbourne** on their way to a 5-2 win. His second was a penalty. Danny Curd pounced on a poor back-pass to make it 3-0 and John Lansdale added a fourth before the half-hour mark. Ben Austin completed the nap hand with 20 minutes left, after which Dyane Antonio and Kyle Green gave Chipstead a little consolation.

Ian Pulman returned to **Whitstable**, the club he left early in the season, and his goal a minute before half-time was all **Ramsgate** needed to collect three points. To complete a bad day for the Oystermen, top scorer Stuart Vahid has been forced to retire because of a knee injury. He played 130 games for Whitstable after joining them in 2009, scoring 44 goals.

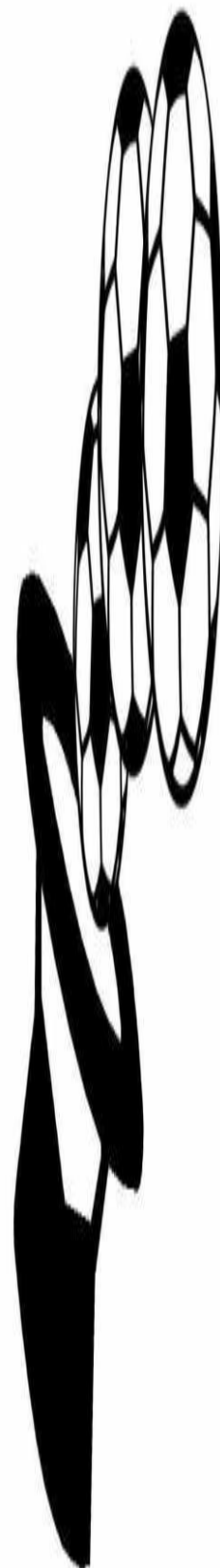
