All the Weekend Inaction

Ryman Premier

BOTH Canvey Island clubs are sitting in the top four of the Ryman Premier table after convincing victories on Saturday.

Canvey themselves made a slow start to their home game against struggling **Harrow** but scored three times in the last 25 minutes to run out 3-0 winners and move into third place.

A typically spectacular 20-yard effort by Bradley Woods-Garness, his 14th league goal, broke the deadlock. Rob King headed the second three minutes later and Jay Curran finished off a pass from debutant George Cocklin to wrap it up at the end.

Concord trail their island neighbours by a single goal, and have two games in hand, after Harry Elmes fired a hat-trick in their 4-0 win at **Bury** – poor reward for the Bury fans who cleared snow off the pitch at lunchtime to allow the game to go ahead.

Only goal difference separated the sides at the start of play but Concord dominated. Elmes gave them the lead midway through the first half and Jason Hallett quickly added a second. Elmes nabbed his second on the hour and completed his treble in the 71st minute.

The game ended on a low note with a mass confrontation that brought red cards for Bury's John Kennedy and Luke Ingram together with Concord's Steve King.

Leaders Whitehawk maintained their ten-point advantage with a 5-2 romp at Met Police, their ninth away victory in 13 attempts.

Michael Malcolm opened the scoring on 14 minutes and struck again ten minutes before half-time. It was 3-0 within a minute of the restart thanks to Hakeem Araba.

The Met then launched a rally. Ty Smith pulled one back in the 56th minute and Craig Watkins made it 3-2 with 20 minutes left. James Fraser gave Whitehawk some breathing space in the 82nd minute and the experienced Kieron St Aimie marked his debut with the fifth goal in added time.

Wealdstone remained second with a 3-0 home win over **Hastings**, aided by an early injury to visiting keeper Liam O'Brien which forced midfielder Tom Vickers to take over between the posts.

It was Vickers who brought down Tom Pett to allow Sean Cronin to convert a 34th-minute penalty and Peter Dean scored in the 58th and 68th minutes to keep Stones a point ahead of the two island clubs and **Bognor**, who moved into fifth place with a 1-0 victory at **Enfield Town**.

James Crane made the most of a pass from Lewis Stockford in the 35th minute, Bognor's only reward for their first-half domination, and it was enough despite an improved Enfield showing after the break.

Margate's home game against East Thurrock was one of five postponed matches and the Kent club dropped from third place to sixth.

Kingstonian climbed to seventh with a 3-1 victory at bottom club Carshalton (all six matches played in the division were won by the higher-placed team).

Matt Pattison gave K's the lead seven minutes before half-time and they put the result beyond doubt with two goals in as many minutes soon after the break, Aaron Goode and Nathan Koranteng the marksmen.

That was a harsh scoreline, for the Robins had played better than their position might suggest, and Ola Sogbanmu's reply in the 74th minute was no more than they deserved.

There must be sympathy for Suffolk coast club Leiston. They made the lengthy trek to Margate on January 5 only for the game to be postponed shortly before kick-off time, and yesterday they suffered the same fate after another long-haul journey to Hampton.

Ryman North

TWO goals by Jacob Cleaver stunned leaders **Maldon** on Saturday as lowly visitors **Redbridge** overcame a twogoal deficit, and a 48-point gap, to pick up a precious point in a 2-2 draw.

After a low-key first half, the much-travelled Lee Boylan opened his Maldon account in the 62nd minute and when James Robinson scored against his old club with 15 minutes left an 11th home win in 12 games seemed a formality.

But the Motormen had other ideas. Cleaver immediately pulled one back and he struck again with five minutes left to shock Maldon boss Terry Spillane, the man who masterminded Redbridge's march to the second round of the FA Cup last season.

The point lifted Redbridge to 20th place, above **Ware** who went down 3-1 at fourth-placed **Aveley**. A Jordan Cox header put Millers ahead after 19 minutes and a deflected shot by Rashid Kamara doubled the lead moments before half-time.

Cox made it 3-0 with his 15th league goal in the 54th minute and Ware had Mark Standen sent off before Tim Shaw managed a consolation goal.

Only one other game was played in the division, at **Thamesmead** who moved into fifth place with a last-gasp goal which earned them a 2-1 victory over visitors **Wroxham**.

The Norfolk side went ahead on the half-hour through Jamie Forshaw but were pegged back by Thamesmead's A Team. Baff Addae equalised on the hour and Enoch Adjei grabbed the winner in added time.

Ryman South

THE match was abandoned at Leatherhead on Saturday when a collapsed wall brought an early halt to the match between Tanners, third in the table, and second-placed Dulwich.

The visitors looked set to bank three valuable points when Danny Carr gave them a 2-0 lead with his second goal of the game in the 76th minute. But as he celebrated with the travelling fans a stretch of the pitch perimeter wall fell down. No-one was hurt and the debris was cleared, but the referee decided that it would be unsafe to finish the game.

That allowed **Maidstone** to move three points clear at the top with their 2-0 home win over **Merstham**, watched by another massive crowd of 1,853.

Stuart King put them ahead midway through the first half, his third goal since his move from Folkestone, and Tom Mills added another just before the break. Merstham had Peter Wedgeworth sent off in the 67th minute to end their recovery hopes.

Fourth-placed **Sittingbourne** looked to be in trouble at **Corinthian-Casuals** when James Cottee put the home side ahead with only ten minutes left. But Joe Taylor quickly made it 1-1, after which both sides missed chances to take all three points.

Crawley Down stayed fifth depite a 2-1 defeat at **Folkestone**, whose manager Neil Cugley was taking charge for the 650th time and, perhaps, the last. He is being strongly linked with the vacancy at Margate.

It was 1-1 by the seventh minute, with Dane Luchford's first goal in Folkestone colours bringing a swift response from Luke Blewden. Darren Smith's through ball set up the 34th-minute winner for Richard Atkins.

Faversham now trail the Anvils only on goal difference, thanks largely to keeper Simon Overland who pulled off a succession of excellent saves to ensure that Wayne Wilson's sixth-minute penalty was enough for a 1-0 win at bottom club **Three Bridges**.

Whitstable fans and officials worked hard to clear their pitch so their game against Worthing could take place, and they were richly rewarded with a 4-0 victory over a club with one of the best away records in the league.

They had a bit of good fortune when Worthing's Tom Stilwell deflected the ball into his own net after four minutes. But there was no luck involved in a cracking volley by skipper James Morrish which doubled the score moments before the interval.

Buster Smissen added the third midway through the second half and Sean Raggett, who earlier had been denied by the bar, completed the rout near the end.

Ramsgate moved to within striking distance of the play-off places with a comfortable 3-1 win at **Tooting**. The outstanding Ian Pulman set up the 16th-minute opener for James Sherman and scored third himself in the 79th minute, shortly after Tom Chapman had made it 2-0. Ryan Adams managed a late reply for the Terrors.

Eastbourne trailed for most of their game at **Walton & Hersham** but ended up frustrated to have dropped points in a 2-2 draw.

Graeme Purdy gave the Swans a seventh-minute lead and, despite the dismissal of Matt Holliday, they stayed ahead until the 73rd minute, when Ross Treleaven equalised. Danny Curd's 88th-minute strike seemed to have completed the comeback but Connor French made it 2-2 in the fifth minute of added time.

Herne Bay gained three welcome points, their first victory since November 10, with a lone 16th-minute goal by Byron Walker at **Horsham**. Both sides later hit the woodwork.
