

Midweek Update – Season 2012/13 No.26 14th February 2013

Ryman Premier

AN EARLY goal by top scorer Jack Defty was enough to boost Lowestoft's Ryman Premier play-off prospects with a 1-0 home victory over Margate on Tuesday.

Defty's fifth-minute strike, his 11th goal of the season, lifted the Trawlerboys to eighth place and, having not yet reached the halfway point in their league campaign, they have at least three games in hand on everyone above them, including Margate who remained in sixth spot.

In the only other Premier game to survive the weather, **Enfield Town** improved their survival hopes considerably with an impressive 4-0 home win over **Met Police**, a side whose recent good form was driving them towards the play-off race.

The damage was done early and late. Adam Wallace and Scott McGleish put Town 2-0 up by the 12th minute. Michael Bardle made it three in the 85th minute and McGleish added another making nine in eight games since the veteran striker moved to Donkey Lane.

IF EVER the manager of the month award was going to live up to its reputation as a jinx, it was on Tuesday at Maldon after their boss Terry Spillane was handed no fewer than three of the trophies before their game against Potters Bar.

He was presented with the divisional awards for October, November and December by league vice-chairman Nick Robinson and secretary Kellie Discipline.

But there was to be no bad luck for Spillane's men unless you consider a 13-point lead to be unlucky, for that was the margin they established with their 3-2 victory.

A perfect pass by Joe Gardner sent Chris Bryan clear to open the scoring on eight minutes and Maldon seemed to have a god case for a penalty when Bryan was brought down three minutes later. But play went on and, seconds later, Jose Espinoza lashed the ball into the net at the other end to equalise.

Maldon played some delightful football but wasted some good chances before Bryan's deflected shot put them ahead again five minutes before half-time.

Gardner's 71st-minute tap-in made it 3-1 but the spirited visitors responded three minutes later through Josh Hutchinson.

Maldon held on, however, and their opponents drop to eighth, one place below **Witham** who moved up with a 2-0 success at **Chatham**.

Both goals came from Rob Whitnell, the first on the half-hour and the second immediately after the interval, as Chatham slumped to their eighth home defeat.

Four other games were scheduled in the division but they were postponed. One was at Brentwood, who have yet to complete their 20th league match and face a hectic time in the next few weeks.

Fifth-placed **Aveley** came from behind to beat **Cheshunt** 2-1 at the Mill Field on Wednesday and open up an eight-point gap between the play-off places and the rest of the field.

Leon Archer pounced on a defensive mistake to put the visitors ahead in the 26th minute and they stayed in front until the hour mark, when a header by Jordan Cox eluded the grasp of keeper Obey Murefu.

Cox also nabbed the winner, his 19th league goal, from a cross by newly-arrived substitute Jack Stephenson in the 83rd minute.

Waltham Abbey moved up one place to 15th with a 3-0 victory at **Waltham Forest** and, with their season only halfway complete, they still feel they can challenge for a promotion place if they profit from their games in hand.

The goals all came in a 13-minute spell in the first half. Joe Pearman opened the scoring after 25 minutes and that was followed by strikes from James Peagram and Dean Green.

A GOAL from Kieran Oliver seven minutes after half-time on Tuesday proved decisive for **Faversham**, who climbed to third place with a 2-1 home win over **Burgess Hill**.

Jamie Maxted's early goal for Faversham was answered by Karly Akehurst midway through the first half but it was not enough for Hillians in the end as their play-off challenge suffered a setback.

A first-half double by Ashley Miller, who scored in the seventh and 31st minutes, set **Hythe** on their way to a 3-1 home win over **Corinthian-Casuals**.

Jamie Byatt put Casuals back in the picture after 38 minutes and Hythe had to wait until two minutes from time for the clinching goal by Nick Barnes.

The only other game to be played was at Woodside Road, where visiting **Walton & Hersham** held **Worthing** to a goalless draw.
