## Ryman Premier

TWELVE goals in an hour: that was the feast laid on for the fans at Kingsmeadow on Saturday as **Kingstonian** thrashed **Cray** 9-3 to record their highest score since 1966.

No-one could have seen the final scoreline coming after 30 futile minutes, and even after Nathan Koranteng broke the deadlock with a deflected shot it was another 12 minutes before Lewis Taylor made it 2-0. Matt Pattison headed a third before the break.

Taylor scored again in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute but Cray rallied with a goal from Danny Phillips and a Leigh Bremner penalty to pull it back to 4-2 with a quarter of the match to go.

The penalty was the first of four goals in five minutes. Andre McCollin pounced on a bad backpass to score the home side's fifth and Taylor completed his hat-trick before Chris Saunders netted for Cray, making it 6-3.

Substitute Paul Vines nabbed his first goal since returning to K's from Cray, Pattison struck again and Koranteng finished what he started with the ninth goal as time ran out.

Cray, who have taken just two points from their last nine games, continued their slide towards the relegation zone while K's remained in fifth place as the three teams above them all won.

That opened up the title race again, for leaders **Whitehawk** went down 2-1 at **Margate**, only their third defeat of the season.

Michael Malcolm continued his prolific form by giving Hawks a tenth-minute lead but the turning-point came soon after the interval when Josh Jones was denied a second by the crossbar.

Margate substitute Alex Rhodes equalised after 69 minutes with only his second league goal of the campaign and then grabbed his third four minutes later to win it. The Kent side moved up to sixth place.

**Concord** retained second place with a 3-0 win at **Lewes** and closed the gap at the top to nine points, with three games in hand.

Jason Hallett hit a post in the first half and he opened the scoring two minutes after the interval. The Beachboys clinched it with late strikes by Leon Gordon and Danny Spendlove.

**Canvey** remained behind their neighbours only on goal difference after a 4-2 home victory over bottom club **Carshalton**, who scored first through Nathaniel Pinney in the eighth minute.

Jay Curran levelled it after 19 minutes and set up the chance for Bradley Woods-Garness to put the islanders ahead eight minutes later. James Hawes added a third in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute.

Hakeem Adelakun brought the Robins back into it early in the second half but Pinney, their leading scorer, was sent off just after the hour and Woods-Garness wrapped it up with five minutes left, his 16<sup>th</sup> league goal.

**Wealdstone**, in fourth place, also collected maximum points with a 2-1 success in a tight contest at **Enfield Town**, the winner coming from Alex Dyer's solo effort with 17 minutes left.

Wes Parker had headed home a corner to put Stones ahead in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute and Town replied nine minutes later when Adam Wallace hit a post and Tyler Campbell slotted in the rebound.

**Bognor** lost ground in the play-off race when they went down 1-0 at much-improved **Hendon**, who claimed their sixth win in eight games with a 79<sup>th</sup>-minute header from Lee Angol.

**Met Police** moved into contention by beating **Bury** 3-1 at Imber Court. Lee Newton and Craig Watkins scored in quick succession to make it 2-0 after 21 minutes and Charlie Collins stretched the lead in the 77<sup>th</sup> minute.

John Sands netted a consolation goal, his 16<sup>th</sup> in the league, and shares the lead with Woods-Garness in the race for the division's golden boot.

**Thurrock** remained in the relegation places after a 1-1 draw at **Hastings**, who stayed one place and two points ahead of them but have played five games more.

It was the eighth successive draw at the Pilot Field, where Mikel Suarez headed Hastings into the lead from a corner eight minutes before half-time and Jack Paxman curled in the equaliser with 14 minutes left. Matt Turpin could have won it for the visitors at the death but headed over.

**Harrow** remained close to the danger zone after going down 3-1 at home to **Leiston**. Frankie Merrifield handled to allow Gareth Heath to put the visitors ahead with a ninth-minute penalty and Patrick Brothers added another 11 minutes after half-time.

Shaun Lucien replied midway through the half and Leiston were clinging on until Heath struck seven minutes from time to clinch only their second away victory.

**Wingate** picked up a valuable point from a 3-3 draw at **Hampton**. Spencer Bellotti's 20-yarder gave the visitors a 16<sup>th</sup>-minute lead which was wiped out nine minutes later by Ryan Moss.

Charlie Moone put Hampton ahead early in the second half but Wingate quickly hit back when home keeper Rodney Chiweshe came out of his box to head clear and was stranded by Dan Brown's lob.

Moone struck again in the 76<sup>th</sup> minute only for the visitors to snatch a point with a farcical goal as a defender's clearance hit a colleague and rebounded into the net, with Bellotti rushing in to claim a final touch.

**East Thurrock** battled out a goalless draw at **Lowestoft**, for whom Chris Henderson hit a post in the latter stages and Curtley Williams was sent off in added time.

## Ryman North

AFTER some mixed results since Christmas, leaders **Maldon** reaffirmed their title credentials in style on Saturday, crushing hapless **Harlow** 9-1 to regain their ten-point advantage.

Chris Bryan gave them the lead after only five minutes, Lewis Dark volleyed the second after 17 and Glen Golby's header made it 3-0 by the 34<sup>th</sup> minute.

Then James Robinson took charge, netting a minute before half-time, two minutes after it and again in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute to complete a quickfire hat-trick.

Joe Gardner took the tally to seven with 21 minutes left and Maldon had high hopes of matching the 11-0 win recently amassed by local rivals Heybridge against Redbridge.

But the next goal went to Harlow, scored by Clark Akers in the 74<sup>th</sup> minute. Debutant Eddie Hart netted Maldon's eighth three minutes later and the former Canvey man struck again to complete the rout in added time.

**Heybridge**, who were second, slipped back to fourth after going down 3-2 at **Brentwood** whose goals all came from headers.

Steve Butterworth gave Blues the lead after seven minutes but Solomon Ofori put Swifts back on track with a rapid double just after the hour.

Darren Blewitt levelled matters in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute and Sam West got the winner five minutes from time, lifting Blues to tenth place with between four and eight games in hand on all the sides above them.

**Grays** regained second place with a gentle 3-0 home win over **Redbridge**. A foul on Joao Carlos allowed Danny Bunce to convert a tenth-minute penalty and Jared Small made it 2-0 after 19 minutes.

Small set up the third for Jeff Hammond 42 seconds after the interval and Grays then missed a host of chances to boost their goal difference.

**Thamesmead** moved up to third with three unanswered goals at **Cheshunt**. Rob Carter gave them the lead after four minutes and a deflected shot from Baff Addae made it 2-0 just before half-time. Lea Dawson completed the scoring with a header in the 54<sup>th</sup> minute.

Fifth-placed **Aveley** had their game at **Wroxham** postponed as early as Friday afternoon but the three teams behind them failed to make the most of it, collecting a point apiece.

**Soham** were held in a goalless game at **Chatham** and **Potters Bar** had to settle for a 1-1 draw at home to **Waltham Forest**. Cole Penny finished off a good move to put the Scholars ahead in the 38<sup>th</sup> minute but Forest were well worth their point, which was earned by a Jack Leachman goal 12 minutes from time.

**Tilbury**, in eighth place, drew 1-1 at **Needham Market**. Tom Wraight gave the Dockers the lead five minutes before half-time and Sam Newson, recently back from a spell at Lowestoft, levelled it in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute. That made it 13 home games without a victory for the Marketmen, who have claimed 25 of their 31 points on the road.

**Witham** kept their slight play-off hopes alive with a 1-0 win at **Romford**. Rob Whitnell scored four minutes before the break and Romford's Jack Barry was sent off with eight minutes left.

There was yet another change at the bottom, as **Ware** escaped from the sole relegation place despite going down 2-1 at home to **Sudbury**.

Louis Rose put Ware ahead with a looping header after 33 minutes and they stayed in front until 16 minutes from time, when Leon Antoine equalised. A foul on Dave Cowley allowed James Baker to get the winner with a penalty five minutes later.

But Ware still climbed above **Ilford** on goal difference because the Foxes were crushed 4-1 at home by **Waltham Abbey**, a scoreline that, if anything, flattered the home side.

James Peagram opened the scoring on 15 minutes and scored again seven minutes before the interval. Then a quick double by Dean Green made it 4-0 by the break.

The second half was equally one-sided but the visitors somehow failed to add to their tally and Warren Mfula managed a last-minute consolation goal.

## Ryman South

YOU have to feel a little sorry for **Three Bridges**, who pulled off one of the best results in their testing Ryman League debut season on Saturday when they drew 1-1 at third-placed **Leatherhead**.

Despite that, Bridges found themselves seven daunting points adrift at the foot of the table as **Walton Casuals**, the side above them, powered to a 4-0 victory at **Herne Bay**.

Marcus Elliott's 17<sup>th</sup>-minute goal for Bridges was quickly answered by Tommy Hutchings, after which it was the bottom club who had the better chances to take the extra points.

Casuals, meanwhile, took a ninth-minute lead through Sol Patterson-Bohner, who scored again in the 24<sup>th</sup> minute. Former Leatherhead marksman Greg Andrews scored his first goal for his new club five minutes before half-time and Kwabena Agyei's lob on the hour completed an impressive performance. Danny Wisker's late dismissal made it a wretched day for the hosts.

At the other end of the table, leaders **Maidstone** were frustrated by 17-year-old **Folkestone** forward Johan Ter Horst, whose first senior goals earned his side a 2-2 home draw.

He put his side ahead after 13 minutes but the leaders hit back through Graeme Andrews in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute and went in front on the stroke of half-time with a Tom Mills goal. Ter Horst had the last word with a 77<sup>th</sup>-minute equaliser which kept the hosts well in the play-off race.

**Dulwich** moved to within four points of the pacemakers with three games in hand after romping to a 4-1 home win over **Merstham**.

A foul on Nyren Clunis led to a 13th-minute penalty which Danny Carr converted, and Xavier Vidal's 25-yard strike doubled the lead five minutes before the interval. Clunis added two goals in six minutes midway through the second half before Mark Nwokeji netted a late reply for the visitors.

Leatherhead stayed in third place because **Faversham**, the side behind them, had to settle for a 0-0 home draw against lowly **Corinthian-Casuals**. The hosts almost snatched the win in added time, when Danny Dudley's goalline clearance denied Dave Botterill.

**Sittingbourne** are just a point behind Faversham after beating visiting **Hythe** 1-0 in a game of three penalties. Ryan Golding had the chance to put the hosts ahead with a 50<sup>th</sup>-minute spot-kick but hit a post. Joe Taylor fared better from 12 yards in the 77<sup>th</sup> minute to put Brickies in front.

They then conceded a last-minute penalty, with keeper Adam Molloy becoming the day's hero by saving the kick from Dave Cook, the division's joint-top scorer.

A missed penalty was crucial, too, at **Eastbourne**, where **Ramsgate** maintained their march towards the play-off places with a lone-goal victory. Nathan Crabb hit a post with a spot-kick for the home side and, although he buried the rebound, no-one else had touched the ball and it was disallowed.

Ramsgate made the most of that escape when Ian Pulman set up the decisive goal for Ben Lslett with ten minutes left to keep their side in seventh place, two points behind Sittingbourne.

Between them are **Crawley Down**, for whom Jamie Cade added to the list of penalty misses with ten minutes left. His failure was not costly, for visitors **Worthing** were unable to reply to Fraser Logan's 40<sup>th</sup>-minute strike, the only goal of the game.

**Burgess Hill** stayed in the hunt with a 4-1 home win over **Horsham** that was wrapped up by half-time. Pat Harding gave the Hillians a third-minute lead against his former club and added another, his 18<sup>th</sup> of the season, midway through the half.

Kai Bichard's 33<sup>rd</sup>-minute own goal gave the visitors some hope but Dan McLaughlin's header restored the two-goal margin in the 42<sup>nd</sup> minute and Bichard made amends by scoring at the right end in the closing moments of the half.

**Whitstable** continued to put their relegation fears behind them with a 2-1 victory at **Walton & Hersham**, where all five of their previous Ryman League visits had ended in defeat.

Buster Smissen put the Oystermen ahead after 54 minutes and, after Graeme Purdy replied ten minutes later with a penalty, Billy Parkinson forced in a loose ball for the 70<sup>th</sup>-minute winner.

Bamoussa Cisse hit a hat-trick for **Tooting** at **Chipstead** but it was worth only one point to his side in a 3-3 draw. Jason Henry gave Chips an early lead but Cisse then took over, scoring after 34, 42 and 51 minutes. Joe Nwoko pulled one back in the 56<sup>th</sup> minute and netted the equaliser with eight minutes left.
