Ryman Premier

JUST a minute: that was all the time it took to settle the big top-of-the-table clash at East Brighton Park on Saturday.

A first-minute goal by James Fraser was enough to give leaders **Whitehawk** a 1-0 victory over second-placed **Concord** and extend the Sussex club's lead to ten points.

Hawks had the ball in the net again before half-time but Hakeem Araba's effort was disallowed for a push, and the Beachboys came within inches of a late equaliser when Leon Gordon hit the bar.

With about five minutes left it looked as if it would be very much Whitehawk's day, for all the other teams in the top five were losing.

But Wes Parker scored twice in the dying minutes to give **Wealdstone** a 2-1 home win over **Margate**, who had also netted in the first minute with a Dan Stubbs header.

Parker turned in a loose ball to equalise with six minutes left and then popped up with an 89th-minute header to lift Stones to second place.

At Donkey Lane, meanwhile, Paul Vines struck in added time to give fifth-placed **Kingstonian** a 1-1 draw at **Enfield Town**, who had gone ahead with a 27th-minute penalty by Scott McGleish after a foul on Mark Henry.

Enfield had Joe O'Brien sent off for halting Andre McCollin's run towards goal five minutes after the interval but the ten men almost held out.

Wealdstone climbed above Concord and their neighbours **Canvey**, who crashed 3-0 at home to ever-improving **Hendon**.

Dean Cracknell gave the visitors an 11th-minute lead which was extended 13 minutes into the second half by 17-year-old Wycombe loanee Junior Morias to end a spell of home pressure. Isaiah Rankin added a late third.

Lowestoft made the most of the failings of the sides above them, ending **Hastings'** remarkable sequence of eight home draws with a convincing 4-1 victory at the Pilot Field.

Jack Defty twice headed the Trawlerboys into the lead, on 18 minutes and again on the stroke of half-time, after Mikel Suarez had levelled the scores.

Chris Henderson made it 3-1 with around 20 minutes left and Joshua Dawkin's strike in added time completed a fine performance which lifts Lowestoft to sixth place, six points behind Wealdstone with at least three games in hand on everyone above them.

Those games in hand, though, mean that they still have 21 matches - half the season - to play. A hectic programme lies ahead.

Thurrock, who have 22 games to go, hit the bottom after a 3-1 home defeat by **Carshalton**, who occupied the basement at kick-off time.

The in-form Nathaniel Pinney gave the visitors the lead after 17 minutes. They almost doubled it when Justyn Roberts hit a post, and did so through Pelayo Gomes Pico soon after half-time.

Danny Green pulled one back for Thurrock with 13 minutes to go and they almost drew level when Harry Cook hit a post. Instead, the visitors counter-attacked and Pinney made sure of the points.

Carshalton remain in the relegation places, behind Hastings on goal difference and two points ahead of Thurrock, who have no fewer than eight games in hand.

The day's goal feast came at **Leiston**, where the hosts edged out **East Thurrock** 5-4. Seven of the goals came in the first half, though that could not quite match the nine-goal second half at Kingstonian a week earlier.

Pat Brothers, with a back-heel, and Daniel Ottley-Gooch put Leiston two up before Sam Collins replied, and it was still only the tenth minute.

Dave Bryant levelled matters in the 26th minute but nine minutes later Rocks were 4-2 down as David Head and Gareth Heath punished their failure to clear corners.

Collins pulled one back before the interval and completed his hat-trick in the 57th minute as Rocks again came from two down to draw level.

Then Rocks keeper Elliott Justham failed to hold Joe Jefford's header and Emmanuel Osei nipped in for what proved to be the final goal of the afternoon with almost half an hour left.

The 9-3 thrashing at Kingstonian might have been the low point in **Cray's** fortunes, for they arrested their alarming slump towards the danger zone with a 2-0 victory at **Bognor**, their first win in ten games.

Michael Power cracked in an 18-yard scorcher to give them the lead after 54 minutes and Alex Stavrinou added the second five minutes later.

Met Police bounced back from their 4-0 midweek defeat at Enfield to move within five points of the play-off spots with a 2-1 victory at **Lewes**.

Tommy Brewer, one of four debutants in the Sussex side, put the hosts ahead after 28 minutes but Charlie Collins replied quickly and Steve Noakes got the winner midway through the second half.

Bury marksman John Sands took an undisputed lead in the division's golden boot race when he headed their 11th-minute opener at **Wingate** and moved two clear when he struck again in the half-hour, his 18th goal of the season.

Spencer Bellotti pulled one back after 62 minutes but Craig Parker put Bury 3-1 up shortly afterwards and that was how it finished. Wingate had to play the last 15 minutes with ten men after a succession of injuries.

Hampton's home game against **Harrow** was called off after a pitch inspection in the morning.

RUNAWAY leaders **Maldon** continued their inconsistent form since Christmas with a 2-0 defeat at mid-table **Cheshunt** on Saturday.

David Greene put the Ambers ahead on 18 minutes and Tommy Fletcher's header made it 2-0 just after the half-hour. Chris Bryan's second-half penalty miss ended Maldon's recovery hopes.

They still have a ten-point lead over **Thamesmead**, who moved into second place with a hard-earned 2-1 victory at **Waltham Forest**.

Jack Leachman headed home Luke Stanley's free-kick to give Forest the lead six minutes before the break and Lea Dawson levelled matters just after the hour.

It looked as if Thamesmead, below their best, would have to settle for a point until Chris Edwards grabbed a last-minute winner.

Heybridge climbed to third after a comfortable 3-0 home win over **Romford**. All the goals came in the first half, the opener a 19th-minute penalty by Michael Cheek, his 20th league goal.

Russell Malton netted the second on 40 minutes and Luke Callander made it 3-0 in added time, cementing his position as the league's top scorer with his 23rd of the season.

Aveley also moved up one place to fourth with a 3-1 home win over **Witham** as Grays, who were without a game, slipped from second to fifth.

Jordan Cox took his league tally to 21 by punishing a weak back-pass in the 15th minute and adding a penalty on the half-hour. Danny Emmanuel's 52nd-minute strike put Witham back in it but Jay Leader's header soon restored the two-goal margin.

Soham strengthened their grip on sixth place, albeit seven points adrift of the play-off places, with a 3-1 victory at **Potters Bar**. It took their tally of away goals to 40, seven more than any other club in the league.

The Scholars started the day level on points with their opponents but finished well beaten. Rob Mason scored after 27 minutes and struck again, his 18th league goal, soon after half-time.

Buster Harradine made it 3-0 before the hour and had a penalty saved by Ed Thompson before a free-kick from Harvey Scott-Morris gave the hosts some late consolation.

There were more twists in the battle to avoid the single relegation spot. **Ilford** stayed at the bottom, a point behind neighbours **Redbridge**, after their derby at Oakside ended all square.

Jacob Cleaver punished a poor clearance to give the hosts an early lead: he has scored nine of Redbridge's 22 league goals. Daniel Crowie replied on the hour and Ilford had two shots cleared off the line. It was only Redbridge's fourth home point and Ilford's fifth on their travels.

Ware, meanwhile, had luck on their side as they won 3-2 at **Chatham**. It looked as if they would have to settle for a draw which would have kept them level on points with Ilford, but Austin Gacheru's last-minute penalty hit the bar.

Ricci Crace had given Ware a 15th-minute lead but Chatham hit back with two goals in four minutes soon after the interval, a free-kick from Lee Hales and a Gacheru strike.

Ware were quickly back on terms through Louis Rose and, although they had Tony Martin sent off with ten minutes left, Elliot King then put them ahead and Gacheru's miss lifted them to 20th place.

Harlow seem to be pulling clear of the danger zone once again. A last-minute goal by Piers Wixon gave their ten men a 1-0 win over **Tilbury**, who had found the net in the 69th minute only to be denied by an assistant's flag. Harlow keeper Bertrand Bossu was sent off before play resumed.

Sudbury moved into the top half of the table with a 2-0 home win over **Waltham Abbey**, who will consider themselves unlucky after hitting the woodwork twice.

Joe Pearman was denied by the bar before Ryan Henshaw's 23rd-minute opener and Ayrton Coley struck a post before Leon Antoine clinched the points well into added time.

Spare a thought for **Brentwood**, whose home game against **Needham Market** was called off by the match referee. Already behind with their fixtures because of prolonged involvement in the FA competitions, including several replays, they have since been hit hard by the weather and have 23 league matches to squeeze into the last ten weeks of the season.

WHAT home advantage? There were those who thought that **Maidstone's** artificial surface would pose a problem for visiting teams but, despite heading the table, Stones have won only half their 14 home games after their 0-0 draw with **Burgess Hill** on Saturday.

Almost 2,000 watched a frustrating afternoon for the hosts at the Gallagher Stadium. Alex Flisher came closest to breaking the deadlock when he hit a Hillians post in the second half.

Dulwich closed to within two points with three games in hand after a 2-0 home win over bottom club **Three Bridges**, who put up a brave effort but remained seven points adrift.

It was the tenth minute of the second half before Erhan Oztumer made the breakthrough. Ryan James clinched the points with a 20-yarder in the 76th minute.

Faversham stayed third but lost ground after being held to a 1-1 home draw by **Herne Bay**, who were unlucky not to be in front by the interval after James Turner twice hit the bar.

The hosts made the most of their good fortune, taking the lead through Toby Ashmore eight minutes after the break, but the visitors nabbed the point they deserved with a late equaliser from Billy Bennett.

Folkestone moved up to sixth with a 2-0 home win over fourth-placed **Leatherhead** despite playing for almost an hour with ten men.

Richard Atkins opened the scoring on the half-hour and, although Phil Stevenson was sent off shortly afterwards, they stretched their lead before the interval with a Darren Smith penalty and held out.

Sittingbourne, in fifth place, went down 2-1 at **Merstham** which means that Folkestone are just a point behind them with two games in hand.

Two goals in a minute just before half-time, from Lee Newman and Fabio Saraiva, were enough to clinch Merstham's first win of the year and first at home since October 6.

Hicham Akhazzan had earlier hit the bar for the Brickies, who pulled one back through Ryan Golding with 16 minutes left, his 18th league goal, but could not salvage a point.

There are six clubs within four points of the play-offs, two of whom met at **Ramsgate** where **Hythe** came from behind to win 4-2.

Curtis Robinson's second-minute goal for the home side held up until just after the hour, when Craig Cloke levelled the scores and Dave Cook became the first man in the division to reach 20 league goals with a penalty.

Warren Schulz put Ramsgate back on terms in the 70th minute, also with a penalty, but Ashley Miller restored Hythe's lead with eight minutes left and Brendon Cass made sure.

Crawley Down would have moved into the top five with a home win over **Corinthian-Casuals**, but it was the visitors who came out on top with a lone goal from Jamie Byatt in the 65th minute.

Inconsistent **Worthing** stayed in the hunt with three unanswered goals against visitors **Chipstead**. Jamie Brotherton netted twice in as many minutes midway through the first half and Matt Daniels added the third nine minutes from time, shortly after Chipstead's Devon Williams was dismissed.

Life without manager Jamie Martin, who resigned in midweek after a budget dispute, proved no problem for **Tooting** who romped to a 4-0 win at **Whitstable**.

Bamoussa Cisse put the Terrors ahead after the 13th minute, an unlucky number for the Oystermen who fell further behind when Anthony Joseph netted 13 minutes later. Carl Wilson-Denis made it 3-0 soon after the interval and Lee Hall completed the scoring 13 minutes into the half.

Walton Casuals continue their vain quest for their first home win of the season after going down 2-1 to **Eastbourne**, who took a fifth-minute lead through Ethan Strevett and doubled it after 25 minutes with a goal by John Lansdale.

Harry Hoadley pulled one back shortly before the break but, despite dominating the second half, Casuals were left to contemplate a 14th unsuccessful outing on home turf. They have six victories on the road.

The pitch at **Horsham** survived a morning inspection but the boggy surface did neither side any favours as the Hornets slogged out a 0-0 draw with **Walton & Hersham**. Adam Hutchings came closest with a header that landed on the Walton bar.

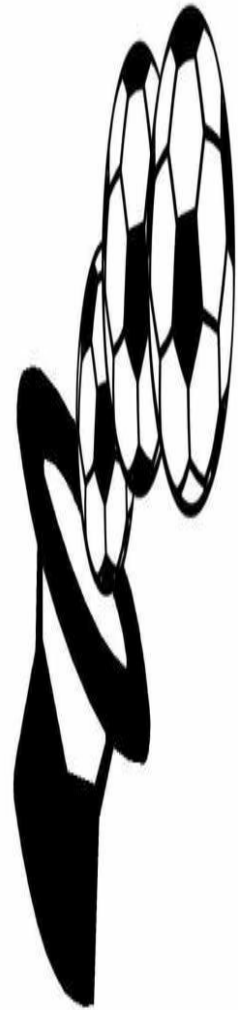

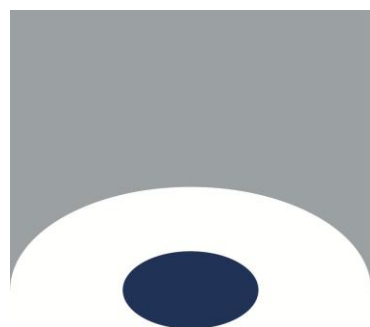
