Ryman Premier

IT'S more than 43 years since **Hendon** last beat local rivals **Wealdstone** at home, and an outstanding Rikki Banks save denied Junior Morais the chance to end that run in a 0-0 draw on Saturday.

The result meant that second-placed Wealdstone were unable to make the most of a shock defeat for leaders **Whitehawk**, who went down 3-1 at **Harrow** but remained nine points clear.

It all went wrong for Hawks in added time at the end of the first half, when a Gary Jones penalty and a Shaun Lucien free-kick wiped out Michael Malcolm's early strike for the Sussex side.

Ola Williams added another midway through the second half and Hawks' frustration was compounded when Tommy Fraser was sent off near the end.

There was a sad end to proceedings at **Concord**, where the match against **Thurrock** was abandoned early in the second half after popular home striker Harry Elmes suffered a broken leg.

So **Canvey**, who came from behind to win 2-1 at **Kingstonian**, were not as happy to take third place from their neighbours as they would have been in different circumstances.

It was only the second home defeat for K's, who took a deserved lead through Andre McCollin in the 24th minute. Canvey stepped up a gear in the second half and James Rowe equalised in the 70th minute after two defenders collided. Bradley Woods-Garness won it with eight minutes left.

Lowestoft also moved above Concord, into fourth place, despite being held to a 0-0 home draw by **Enfield Town**. Lee Smith came closest for the Trawlerboys, hitting a post from 20 yards.

Met Police moved up to sixth, level on points with the two sides above them, after two superb late strikes earned them a 2-1 home win over **Wingate**.

The visitors took a 13th-minute lead through Andre Scarlett and went on to dominate the rest of the first half. The hosts fought back after the break but Wingate held their lead until Dagenham loanee Duran Reynolds fired in a scorcher with eight minutes to go. Ty Smith netted another cracker in the 88th minute to snatch all three points.

Margate stayed in the play-off picture with a 2-1 home win over **Hampton**. George Purcell, a new arrival from Tonbridge, latched on to a long ball to score a debut goal and put the home side ahead on 54 minutes.

Hampton thought they had saved a point when Charlie Moone levelled matters in the 80th minute, but Alex Rhodes headed the winner four minutes later.

Bury are also in the hunt after a John Sands double saw off visiting **Bognor**. Sands opened the scoring on after five minutes and struck again on the half-hour, becoming the first man in the division to reach 20 league goals. It finished 2-0, though not before Bognor had several times brought the best out of home keeper Marcus Garnham.

Thurrock stay at the bottom after the premature end to their match, a point behind **Carshalton** with eight games in hand. Carshalton went down 3-1 at home to **Leiston**, who have doubled their total of away wins in the space of three days.

Gareth Heath put them ahead, as he had done in Thursday's 3-0 victory at Thurrock, with a 28th-minute goal. Jerome Walker replied soon after half-time only for Leon Ottley-Gooch to put the Suffolk side ahead again in the 62nd minute.

The bar denied Pelayo Gomes Pico a second home equaliser before Nathan Stone clinched it with eight minutes to go.

It was a bad day for the Robins, for the two sides above them both won. Harrow are four points ahead of them and **Hastings** three, both having several matches in hand.

Hastings eased their relegation fears with a 2-0 victory at **Cray**, never looking back after Zac Attwood's second-minute opener. Lee Carey's free-kick stretched the lead before half-time and Bailo Camara wrapped it up in the closing stages.

East Thurrock's last two games had yielded 17 goals, of which they had scored eight but taken only one point. So they were satisfied with an uneventful 1-0 home victory over **Lewes**, the goal coming from a Sam Higgins penalty after ten minutes.

HOWEVER long his career lasts, 17-year-old **Chatham** forward Taylor McDonagh is unlikely to suffer more acute frustration than he did on Saturday.

McDonagh gave Chats a third-minute lead at leaders **Maldon** and, after Chris Bryan equalised in the 40th minute, McDonagh struck again before the interval and completed a hat-trick when he ran through from halfway to make it 3-1 with 12 minutes left.

It stayed that way until the last five minutes, when Maldon showed why they are 13 points clear at the top. A double from James Robinson levelled the scores and, two minutes into added time, Lewis Dark tapped in to steal a 4-3 victory which preserved the league's only unbeaten home record.

The current top five look almost certain to stay there until the end of the season. They shared 21 goals in collecting maximum points.

Second-placed **Grays** romped to a 5-1 victory at lowly **Ware**. Headers by Jack West and Jeff Hammond gave them a 2-0 lead at the break which they stretched with a Danny Bunce penalty on 54 minutes after a foul on West by Dave Bastian, who was shown a yellow card and collected another one shortly afterwards.

The ten men pulled one back on the hour, a deflected shot by David Corran, but West scored twice in the next five minutes to complete his hat-trick and put the result beyond doubt.

Thamesmead trail Grays only on goal difference after twice coming from behind on their way to a 3-2 home win over **Potters Bar**.

An own goal by Lewis Tozer gave the visitors a 13th-minute lead. Stuart Zanone replied ten minutes later only for Daniel Ailey to restore the Scholars' advantage moments before the interval. Zanone levelled it again in the 54th minute and Chris Edwards nabbed the winner eight minutes later.

The division's third hat-trick came from Luke Callander, who took his league-leading tally to 26 as **Heybridge** retained fourth place with a 4-0 victory at **Soham**.

Ben Newson and Callander scored in the first nine minutes and Callander added two more in the first seven minutes of the second period. It took Heybridge's tally to 100 goals in all competitions and they are the league's joint top scorers with 83, a tally matched only by neighbours Maldon.

Aveley bounced back from their midweek defeat by Grays to hit five unanswered goals at **Ilford**, keeping their hosts nailed to the foot of the table.

Petrit Elbi put them ahead after 32 minutes, Billy Holland added another before the interval and a Junior Dadson double either side of Jordan Cox's 22nd league goal completed the haul by the 62nd minute.

Millers are ten points clear of **Witham**, who moved above **Soham** into sixth place with a 1-1 home draw against Sudbury in a game which produced two penalties in the first eight minutes.

Sudbury had the first chance but James Baker's kick hit a post, as did Lee Townrow's follow-up. Scott Pethers fared better at the other end shortly afterwards. Dave Cowley's header squared it on the half-hour.

Mid-table **Needham Market** had more reason than most to celebrate after Bradley Barber's spectacular 25-yarder earned them a 2-1 home win over **Redbridge**.

Beating a club 21st in the table might not be seen as a major achievement, but after 14 futile attempts – seven draws and seven defeats – the Marketmen finally became the last club in the league to win on their own territory.

Duane Wright's header gave them the lead nine minutes before half-time but the Motormen equalised soon after the break with a lob from Jacob Cleaver, who has claimed ten of their 23 league goals. Then Barber stepped in.

It means no change at the bottom, where Redbridge are a point ahead of Ilford and four points behind Ware. Only one club will go down at the end of the season.

Brentwood went down 2-0 at **Wroxham**. It was their third defeat in five days and seems to have ended any chance that they can catch the top five with their games in hand, though they still have plenty of them.

After a tedious first half, Adam Eastaugh broke the deadlock in the 48th minute and Ben Thompson added another just before the end.

Harlow missed an early penalty at **Waltham Abbey** and had to wait until the second minute of added time for Michael Akande's goal which gave them a 1-1 draw at Waltham Abbey.

Jack Daveney had put the hosts ahead four minutes before the interval. The Abbots have suffered more than most from the weather: it was their first home game since Christmas and only their second since November 10.

Tilbury were under the cosh for most of the first half but beat visitors **Waltham Forest** 1-0 with a 54th-minute goal by Danny Francis, who finished off a cross from Jack Carlile.

The other match was a goalless draw between **Romford** and **Cheshunt** at Ship Lane. The hosts had a goal disallowed and Cheshunt hit a post.

AFTER reaching the League Cup final in midweek, **Dulwich** were brought down to earth by **Eastbourne** striker Evan Archibald on Saturday as the title race opened up again.

Archibald headed two first-half goals, in the 27th and 45th minutes, as Dulwich went down 2-0 in Sussex, their first defeat since October.

They still have three games in hand on leaders **Maidstone** but are five points behind them after Stones came from behind to win 3-1 at **Herne Bay**.

The hosts took the lead midway through the first half when Alex Brown brought down Michael Turner and Byron Walker scored from the spot.

Michael Phillips powered through to level the scores on 63 minutes and Tim Olorunda pounced when Stuart King's header came back off the bar to put Stones ahead in the 81st minute. Alex Flisher completed the scoring in added time.

Faversham took over second place, though they have played four games more than Dulwich, with a 2-1 victory at **Chipstead**. They, too, had to come from behind after Duane Antonio converted a 24th-minute penalty for a foul on himself.

Dave Botterill equalised shortly before half-time and it was also Botterill who headed the 57th-minute winner from Darren Marsden's cross.

Leatherhead stayed fourth after a comfortable 4-0 home win over **Walton Casuals**. The much-travelled Allan Tait scored his first goal since his move from Met Police in the 21st minute and Jamie Coyle's header quickly made it 2-0.

Sam Blackman and Liam Wright doubled the total in the last ten minutes, twice punishing Casuals' failure to clear corners.

Two play-off contenders clashed at **Sittingbourne** and **Crawley Down** held on to fifth place with a 2-2 draw. Ryan Golding put the Brickies ahead after 17 minutes but the visitors replied through Gabriel Odunaike in the 53rd minute and Luke Blewden gave them the lead seven minutes later.

The home side were reduced to ten men by Anthony John's dismissal and their best chance seemed to have gone when Golding hit the bar. Then, with five minutes to go, Golding was brought down and he converted the penalty himself for his 20th league goal.

They are two of four sides on the 47-point mark as the play-off battle heats up. **Hythe** stayed level with them after being held to a 0-0 home draw by **Merstham**. Craig Cloke almost won it for Hythe with a header that Rob Carter cleared off the line.

Folkestone complete the gang of four after their 3-1 win at **Burgess Hill**. Young striker Johan Ter Horst was their hero with goals in the 76th and 90th minutes, the second double of the month for the 17-year-old.

Richard Atkins had given Folkestone the lead after 31 minutes but Toby Pointing replied two minutes later and Hillians missed a chance to take the lead from the penalty spot.

Ramsgate moved to within one point of the quartet with a 2-0 victory at **Walton & Hersham**. Tom Parkinson headed home a long throw to give them the lead after ten minutes and Curtis Robinson added the second in the 63rd minute, soon after Mark McLeod's second yellow card reduced the hosts to ten men.

Three teams well in the bottom half of the table helped themselves to 13 goals, led by table-proppers **Three Bridges** who thrashed neighbours **Horsham** 4-1 to revive their hopes of an improbable escape from relegation, though they are still seven points adrift of the field.

Abu Touray's tenth-minute opener was quickly followed by a Williams Peaurox strike and Touray was on target again just before the break. Tony Nwachukwu pulled one back from the spot on the hour but Bridges won a penalty of their own with ten minutes left and Peaurox made no mistake.

Corinthian-Casuals laid on a treat for visiting League Chairman Alan Turvey, thrashing **Whitstable** 5-1. It was their biggest victory since they defeated Ashford by the same margin in September 2009. They have not won a league match by more than four goals since beating Chertsey 5-0 in December 2002.

They recovered quickly after Maddie Nsubuga's own goal gave the visitors an eighth-minute lead. Bashiru Alimi replied two minutes later and Casuals took command with strikes from Michael Mullen and Joe Hicks in the last four minutes of the first half.

Jamie Byatt stretched the lead further with a penalty in the 79th minute and Mullen added his second in the last minute.

Tooting fell behind twice before rallying to beat **Worthing** 5-2, much to the delight of a group of Bradford City supporters, in London for the Capital One Cup final, who turned up to support their former favourite Jamie Lawrence.

Billy Medlock netted for the Rebels after three minutes and, after Carl Wilson-Denis equalised on 14 minutes, Chris O'Flaherty headed Worthing back into the lead six minutes before half-time.

The Terrors hit back with both barrels in the first eight minutes of the second half, Wilson-Denis levelling matters again before Nathan Koo-Boothe headed his side in front. A volley by Bamoussa Cisse made it 4-2 on the hour and Wilson-Denis completed his hat-trick with a late penalty.

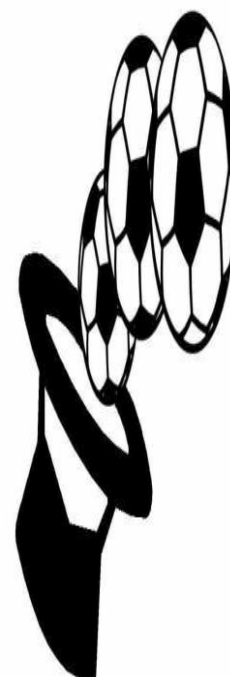
