Ryman Premier

THERE'S no substitute for experience, they say, and **Enfield Town** will certainly endorse that after two men with a combined age of 79 shared the goals in their 2-1 home win over **Lewes** on Saturday.

Scott McGleish, 39, continued his prolific form by converting Mark Kirby's knockdown on the half-hour and four minutes later another McGleish shot was turned in by 40-year-old Bryan Hammatt for his first goal of the season.

Ben Godfrey pulled one back for Lewes with 17 minutes but the defeat leaves them looking anxiously over their shoulders while Town are virtually assured of a second season in the Premier.

Thurrock lifted themselves off the foot of the table with a 3-0 home win over **Harrow**: quite a comedown for the Middlesex side who beat leaders Whitehawk the previous Saturday.

Danny Green's cross was headed home by Lewwis Spence after 16 minutes, Harry Honesty doubled the score in the 33rd minute and Jamar Dobson wrapped it up with 11 minutes left.

Thurrock are still in the relegation places but are within five points of five teams, including Harrow, with anything from three to seven games in hand on them.

Carshalton are back at the bottom after going down 3-1 to **Bury**, their tenth home defeat of the season, in a game they could have settled before half-time.

Ola Sogbanmu's 22nd-minute header put them in front but they should have had more. Instead they turned round on level terms when Craig Parker converted a penalty five minutes before the break.

Then it was over to the division's top scorer John Sands, who extended his lead with a shot and a header in the first ten minutes of the second half, taking his total to 22 and lifting his side into the play-off places.

Hastings are two points above Thurrock after a goalless stalemate against **Hampton** at the Pilot Field. Hampton had the upper hand but home keeper Daniel East was in fine form and a post saved him when he was beaten by James Simmonds in the first half.

The hosts almost snatched it when a late effort by Jack Dixon was cleared off the line amid penalty appeals, but there was no breakthrough and Hastings drew at home for the tenth time in 14 games.

Wingate also stayed in trouble after a 3-2 defeat at high-flying **Canvey**. Spencer Bellotti had one effort disallowed before putting the visitors ahead in the 18th minute.

Bradley Woods-Garness netted his 18th league goal to level it late in the first half but Bellotti struck again midway through the second. James Hawes made it 2-2 with 14 minutes left and Jay Curran won it for the islanders six minutes from time.

Canvey stay third, behind **Wealdstone** whose 1-0 victory at **Met Police** sets them up nicely for next week's visit to leaders Whitehawk. A tight game was settled by Tom Pett, who finished off a Lee Chappell cross five minutes after the break.

Stones are within seven points of **Whitehawk** with two games in hand after the Sussex side battled out a goalless draw at **Lowestoft**. The home side, unbeaten in 15, had the better chances and Greg Crane was narrowly off target with a late header.

Although the dropped points cost Lowestoft their place in the top five, they can overtake Hawks by winning their games in hand, and fourth-placed **Concord** can catch them.

Tony Stokes and Luke Chambers were the heroes of their 1-0 win at **Bognor**, Stokes with a 59th-minute goal and Chambers with a penalty save from Sam Pearce shortly afterwards.

Kingstonian have scored only twice in five games since thrashing Cray 9-3 and they went down 2-0 at home to **East Thurrock**. Sam Higgins opened the scoring in the tenth minute and James Lawson headed the clincher midway through the second half.

The division's third goalless draw came at **Hendon**, where **Margate** were the visitors. Joe Vines hit the bar for Margate in the closing stages: had it gone in they would have been up to fifth place, but instead they dropped to seventh.

And there was to be another 0-0 result – the ninth of the weekend in the three divisions - on Sunday, when **Cray** met **Leiston** at Hayes Lane.

The visitors had the better of the game but the best chance fell to Cray in the second half when new signing Paul Booth set up an open goal for Danny Phillips, who blasted the ball over the bar.

THE title race is well and truly on after **Grays** cut Maldon's lead to eight points, and with three games in hand, after their 3-1 home win over **Waltham Forest** on Saturday.

Forest made them work hard and it took an 88th-minute penalty by Jack West, after a foul on Jeff Hammond, to secure victory.

The rest of the scoring had come in the first 20 minutes, with Jack Leachman equalising for Forest in between strikes by Joe Sweeney and Luke Marshall.

Maldon, who were 13 points ahead after the previous Saturday's games, saw their lead cut to single figures as they were held to a 0-0 home draw by **Aveley**, who were denied victory by the superb form of Maldon keeper Joe Wright.

Millers slipped back to fifth place, though with a comfortable cushion over the rest of the field, while **Heybridge** climbed two places to third with a 2-0 win at **Harlow**.

The home side started well but were beaten by two goals in four minutes soon after the hour, with Ben Newson's opener quickly followed by Grant Cooper's header.

Thamesmead dropped to fourth after their ten-match winning run ended with a 1-0 home defeat by sixth-placed **Witham**. Sam Taylor's early goal settled it thanks to a determined defensive display.

Soham stayed seventh with a 3-1 win at **Ilford**, who remain at the foot of the table. It might have been different: Warren Mfula hit a post with a shot that would have levelled the scores just before Michael Simpson netted Soham's third in the 75th minute.

Luke Stanley had given them an early lead which was wiped out by Daniel Crowie at the start of the second half. But in the 55th minute a foul by Paul Oshin earned him a second yellow card and gave Soham a penalty which Buster Harradine netted.

So Ilford remained a point behind neighbours **Redbridge**, who were crushed 5-0 at home by **Romford**.

The Motormen had won 2-1 at Romford on opening day but have gathered only three victories since then and their home record is a grisly one: four points from 13 games with goal figures of 8-42.

Kurt Smith's 20-yarder put Romford ahead on 25 minutes. Tom Richardson won, and converted, a penalty three minutes later and scored again before half-time. The hosts did better in the second half but Tyler Christian-Law completed the rout with two goals in a minute just before the final whistle.

Wroxham had the better chances in their 0-0 home draw with **Potters Bar** and it looked likely to end goalless at **Cheshunt**, as well, but Corey Whitely scored six minutes from time to see off **Sudbury**.

It was all square at **Tilbury**, where Sam West volleyed **Brentwood** into the lead less than a minute after half-time and Tom Wraight made it 1-1 with a solo strike ten minutes from the end.

The outcome was the same at **Waltham Abbey**, where James Peagram put the home side ahead soon after half-time and the bar denied Kieran Ogunkoya a rapid second. So a 30-yard drive by James Lawrence in the 74th minute earned **Chatham** a point.

Needham Market, having registered their first home win of the season at the 15th attempt, made it two in a row by beating **Ware** 2-0.

Duane Wright gave them the lead six minutes before half-time but was promptly sent off for comments to the Ware bench.

The visitors were unable to profit from their extra man, however, and Bradley Barber clinched it in added time.

DECISIVE away victories by three of the top four teams in the division on Saturday kept their promotion hopes bubbling nicely.

Maidstone retained their five-point lead with four unanswered goals at **Walton & Hersham**. Ade Olurunda scored twice in the last three minutes of the first half and Stuart King added a third five minutes after the restart.

King also helped himself to the fourth with 12 minutes left, his 21st league goal including 15 before his switch from Folkestone.

Dulwich remained five points behind with three games in hand after their 3-0 win at **Ramsgate**. Ellis Green put them ahead on the half-hour, Erhun Oztumer added another before half-time and Danny Carr wrapped it up in the 56th minute.

Leatherhead, who are fourth, fared even better as Allan Tait fired a hat-trick in their 5-0 romp at **Whitstable**. The home side kept it tight for almost an hour, restricting Tanners to Tait's 14th-minute effort.

Tommy Hutchings nabbed the second on 57 minutes and his side took command. Tait quickly made it 3-0, Elliott Thompson fired home from 25 yards and Tait completed his treble with five minutes left.

Third-placed **Faversham** lost ground to their rivals with a 1-1 draw at **Eastbourne**, and it took a last-minute goal by Matt Bourne to earn that single point. Until then it looked as if Ross Treleaven's 15th-minute strike would lift the hosts into the thick of the play-off race.

As it is, Eastbourne are five points behind **Sittingbourne**, who reclaimed fifth spot with a 5-2 home win over bottom club **Three Bridges**.

Two goals from Ryan Golding in the first 15 minutes set them on their way and it was 4-0 by the half-hour mark though Ashley Baverstock and Ryan Cooper.

Ellis Hooper opened Bridges' account with a 32nd-minute header and the goals then dried up until the 90th minute, when Tim Rivers made it 4-2 with a penalty.

Bridges, still six points adrift at bottom with only ten games left, then conceded a penalty which Golding converted to complete his hat-trick and take his league tally to 23, two ahead of King in the golden boot race.

The Brickies climbed above **Crawley Down**, who lost 1-0 at home to **Merstham**. Fabio Saraiva scored after 63 minutes and the Anvils wasted a chance to equalise when Jamie Cade missed a penalty.

Hythe stayed in the thick of things, though they had to defend well to prevent bottom-but-one visitors **Walton Casuals** answering the 37th-minute strike by Brendon Cass which provided the game's only goal.

Folkestone are right in the hunt as well, and would have been level on points with Sittingbourne had they not conceded a last-minute equaliser at **Worthing**.

A foul on Johan Ter Horst allowed Darren Smith to put the visitors ahead with a 37th-minute penalty and they stayed in front until the death, when Steve Metcalf headed home a Jamie Brotherton corner to make it 1-1.

Rebels had been unlucky earlier when Paul Kennett hit the bar and Brotherton struck a post from the rebound.

The other three games in the division failed to produce a goal and, indeed, a quarter of Saturday's games in the whole league – eight out of 32 – ended in scoreless frustration.

Tooting had the better of things in their home game with **Herne Bay**, though Byron Walker missed a late chance for the visitors.

Midweek hat-trick hero Laurent Hamici and experienced Rob Haworth wasted good opportunities to give **Chipstead** a home win over **Burgess Hill**, while a post denied Bashiru Alimi of **Corinthian-Casuals**, who also had a late goal disallowed as they were held by visiting **Horsham**.






