**All the Weekend Action**

#### **Ryman Premier**

SUNDAY'S Ryman Premier relegation battle between **Wingate** and **Thurrock** ended in extraordinary circumstances. It was abandoned after 82 minutes when a fifth Wingate player was sent off, leaving them unable to field the legal minimum of seven players.

Yet no-one would describe it as a dirty game. The first half was hard-fought but goalless, and it was seven minutes into the second period when the first red card was shown, to Ahmet Rifat for violent conduct in an off-the ball incident.

Nine minutes later a foul by Osa Obamwonyi earned him a yellow card, and a red one since he had been cautioned early in the game for handling. The offence also produced a Thurrock a penalty, which Stuart Thurgood converted for what would be the only goal of the afternoon.

A wild challenge from behind by Ronayne Marsh-Brown had referee Sam Purkiss reaching for his red card again in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute and Jon Christian departed seven minutes later, earning his second yellow for kicking the ball away.

When Scott Shulton received his marching orders for his language to the referee the game had to end. It is believed to be the first time in the League's 108-year history that a game has been abandoned for this reason. The League will make a decision about the result of the game at the earliest opportunity.

Almost 600 fans piled into East Brighton Park to see Ryman Premier leaders Whitehawk take on second-placed Wealdstone on Saturday.

It looked as if Hawks would cement their position at the top with Hakeem Araba's goal after 27 minutes. But Wealdstone's pressure paid off when Alex Dyer replied with 14 minutes left.

Stones brought on striker Chris Moore but he was sent off for a wild challenge within two minutes. Five minutes later Whitehawk's Mark Knee followed him to level the numbers for the closing stages.

Richard Jolly missed a late chance to win it for Wealdstone and it finished 1-1. So Stones remain seven points behind with two games in hand.

Concord, whose game against Hendon was one of four postponed fixtures in the division, can now overtake Hawks. They are ten points adrift with four games in hand.

**Lowestoft**, 14 points back with five games in hand, can also do so. They failed to improve their position by drawing 3-3 at **Harrow**, and had to come from 3-1 down to achieve that.

Harrow fans hardly knew what to expect. On the two previous two Saturdays they had beaten leaders Whitehawk 3-1 and lost 3-0 to bottom club Thurrock.

They were gifted an early lead by Trawlerboys keeper Andy Reynolds, who fumbled the ball into his own net. Jack Defty's header squared it in the 17<sup>th</sup> minute but Shaun Lucien's quickfire double then put Harrow two goals clear by the half-hour.

Adam Smith reduced the arrears ten minutes before half-time and, although Lowestoft dominated the second half, Paul Olima's own goal with 12 minutes left was all they had to show for it.

**Canvey** stayed in fourth place with a 2-1 win at **Lewes**, who took an early lead through Alex Malins. Rob King replied with a 19<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty and Canvey hit the woodwork three times before Kevin Dobinson decided it in the 80<sup>th</sup> minute.

A late red card for Steve Brinkhurst completed the misery for Lewes, who have played several more games than two of the three sides below them and are in serious danger of relegation.

**Margate** moved up to sixth with a comfortable 3-0 home win over out-of-touch **Bognor**. Kezie lbe put the hosts in front after 13 minutes and Tommy Whitnell scored midway through each half.

**Cray** eased their relegation fears with a 4-2 victory at **Met Police**. Leigh Bremner opened the scoring with a 13<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty and, after Duran Reynolds replied with a free-kick in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute, it was Bremner who restored Cray's advantage with a header shortly after half-time. Paul Booth and Chris Saunders made it 4-1 by just after the hour, and only five minutes remained when Dave Knight managed a second for the Met.

**Carshalton** stayed rooted to the bottom after being hammered 4-0 at **East Thurrock**. The visitors made a bright start but Ross Parmenter put Rocks in front after 33 minutes and Ryan Sammons claimed the second with a deflected shot right on half-time. Dave Bryant and Sam Higgins wrapped it up by the 62<sup>nd</sup> minute.

#### Ryman North

ONLY two teams in the top five of Ryman North played on Saturday, and it was their rivals who were left chuckling as both of them were beaten.

Leaders Maldon continued their wobbly form by losing 2-0 at Waltham Forest, a result which led Robbie Savage to name them his non-league team of the day on Radio Five's 606. Farai Hallam headed the opening goal on 55 minutes and Adrian Clifton added a 74<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty. Matt Waldron was then sent off but it was too late to give Maldon any hope.

Their lead over Grays, whose visit to fifth-placed Heybridge was postponed, remained at eight points but Grays now have four games in hand.

**Thamesmead** stayed third despite going down 4-2 in a thriller at **Soham**, who were two goals down after 22 minutes. Rob Carter and Chris Edwards, with a free-kick, were the Thamesmead marksmen. James McCabe started the comeback in the 26<sup>th</sup> minute and Rob Mason netted his 20<sup>th</sup> league goal to equalise just before half-time.

The second half was tight but Soham broke through in the 87th minute when Luke Stanley volleyed in Mason's cross. The visitors several times went close to replying before Mason clinched it in the fifth minute of added time. Soham reclaimed sixth spot but are still seven points short of the play-off places.

There was crucial action at the foot of the table, where **llford** pulled off only their third victory of the season to climb off the bottom. Chinedu McKenzie, signed only just in time to play, scored the only goal of their game at **Sudbury** in the 71<sup>st</sup> minute and the hosts had Robbie Martin sent off a few minutes later.

**Redbridge** twice fought back to level terms at **Potters Bar** but the eventual 3-2 defeat leaves them two points below Ilford. Daniel Ailey put the Scholars ahead after eight minutes and hit the bar with a free-kick soon afterwards. The Motormen rallied and drew level five minutes after half-time with a rare goal by Sam Holloway. Wes Beckles put the home side in front again on the hour but this time it took Redbridge only a minute to reply, Garry Skerritt the scorer. They had no answer, however, to the matchwinning strike from Lee Close with ten minutes to go.

Equalisers by Austin Gacheru late in each half earned **Chatham** a 2-2 home draw with **Cheshunt**. Corey Whitely put the visitors ahead after five minutes and Courtney White repeated the trick at the same stage of the second half

It was scoreless at **Brentwood**, where **Harlow** were the visitors, but Brentwood will have been relieved to get the game played on a day when so many other matches were called off. They still have 16 league fixtures to play. Harlow had the better of things until Stanley Muguo was sent off ten minutes after half-time.

#### Ryman South

ANOTHER crowd of close to 2,000 at Ryman South leaders Maidstone on Saturday helped to celebrate the league's 'Isthmians Against Discrimination' weekend.

**Maidstone** beat **Tooting** 3-0 to move six points clear at the top, with all the significant action coming in a ten-minute spell early in the second half.

Ian Draycott put Stones ahead in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute, Alex Flisher added another two minutes later and, after Tooting's Nathan Koo-Boothe had been sent off, Steve Watt scored the third.

**Dulwich** reclaimed second place, with three games in hand, with a 3-1 home win over play-off contenders **Sittingbourne**.

Two goals in the first nine minutes, from Nyren Clunis and Xavier Vidal, put the skids under the Brickies, and Clunis effectively settled it with his second on the stroke of half-time. Hicham Akhazzan netted a late consolation for the visitors, who slipped from sixth to seventh.

The upset of the day was at **Faversham**, who started it in second place after an eight-match unbeaten run. They were trounced 4-1 at home by **Whitstable**, 18 places below them.

Tom Brunt's fierce drive and Buster Smissen's header put the Oystermen two up in 16 minutes and it stayed that way until the sixth minute of the second half, when Danny Hockton pulled one back with a penalty.

Faversham had several chances to equalise before Jake Beecroft's 25-yarder put Whitstable 3-1 up with eight minutes left. Ollie Lee completed the triumph with a header.

Brendon Cass was again the hero for **Hythe** as they knocked **Leatherhead** out of fourth place with a 1-0 victory in Surrey. Cass, who netted the only goal of Wednesday's victory at Burgess Hill with five minutes left, this time had 12 minutes to spare when he cut out a pass by home skipper Mark Simmonds and went through to score.

**Folkestone** moved up to sixth, coming from behind to beat visiting **Ramsgate** 3-1. Ian Pulman scored for Ramsgate in the 22<sup>nd</sup> minute and they would themselves now be sixth if they had held the lead.

Instead, they find themselves ninth. Josh Vincent headed the equaliser in the 29<sup>th</sup> minute, Dane Luchford put the hosts ahead with 20 minutes left and a late effort from Frankie Chappell made sure.

The day's most exciting game was at **Herne Bay**, where play-off chasers **Crawley Down** fought back to level terms from 3-0 down. But the celebrations for Luke Blewden's 87<sup>th</sup>-minute equaliser were short-lived. Byron Walker struck a minute later and Herne Bay won 4-3.

Such a tight finish could hardly have been predicted when the hosts struck three times in 13 minutes in the game's second quarter, with James Turner's double sandwiching Sam Bewick's 25-yarder. Blewden gave the Anvils hope just before the interval and Jack Page further reduced the arrears in the 71<sup>st</sup> minute.

Bottom club **Three Bridges** revived their survival hopes thanks to a 26<sup>th</sup>-minute goal by Joel O'Hara, who made the most of Lee Carney's pass to score the only goal of their home game against **Walton & Hersham**.

Bridges are now only three points behind **Walton Casuals**, who have two games in hand that will be little use to them if they continue the form which brought them a crushing 6-1 home defeat by **Worthing**.

Jamie Brotherton put the Rebels ahead on 20 minutes and Billy Medlock added another in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute before making it 3-0 with a penalty just after the interval. The rout continued with a Chris O'Flaherty goal in the 54<sup>th</sup> minute and, after James McShane pulled one back on the hour, Medlock quickly completed his hat-trick and went on to nab his fourth near the end.

Games at Horsham and Merstham were postponed, so the only other action was at **Burgess Hill** where **Corinthian-Casuals** were beaten 2-1.

Part Harding's 18<sup>th</sup> goal of the season gave Hillians a 17<sup>th</sup>-minute lead which Ryan Thompson doubled midway through the second half. Steve Barilli replied with four minutes left.
