Ryman Premier

TWO late goals kept ten-man **Lowestoft** in the hunt for the title on Saturday with a 5-3 home victory over **Hampton**.

The Trawlerboys took an early lead through Scott Mitchell and looked set for a comfortable afternoon when Chris Henderson made it 2-0 in the 33rd minute.

But they were stunned as Tony Taggart and Ryan Moss levelled the scores by half-time, and Taggart struck again six minutes after the break to give Hampton the lead.

It proved to be brief. Jack Defty made it 3-3 two minutes later and, despite the dismissal of Greg Crane with ten minutes to go, Lowestoft netted twice in the closing stages to take the points, with Defty netting his 19th league goal of the season before Michael Frew made sure.

They moved up to third place, still 11 points behind Whitehawk with four games in hand. Winning those games in hand may be another matter as the Trawlerboys face a stiff programme of 13 matches in the last six weeks of the season.

Whitehawk showed their determination to take the title at the first attempt by fielding no fewer than four new signings at **Thurrock**.

One of them, Reading youngster Charlie Losasso, scored in the tenth minute to set Hawks on course for a 3-0 victory, though not before some confusion because the ball went through a hole in the net.

The hosts fought hard in the first half but were killed off by goals by James Fraser in the 35th minute and Danny Mills, a thumping header, five minutes later.

The only other side in the top five to play – four matches in the division were postponed – were **Canvey**, who stayed fifth but suffered a potentially-damaging 1-0 home defeat by **Met Police**, who are now five points behind them and retain play-off hopes. Dave Knight forced the ball home at the second attempt for the decisive goal ten minutes before the interval.

Margate moved to within a point of the islanders with a game in hand by chalking up a 3-0 victory at **Enfield Town**. Carl Rook scored with a fierce shot midway through the first half and Kezie Ibe added the second just after the break, nipping in when Tommy Murphy's shot came back off a post.

Rook struck again on 63 minutes and had the chance to complete his hat-trick from the penalty spot, only for Noel Imber to save his effort.

Bury also stayed well in the play-off picture, three points behind Canvey, with a 2-0 win at slumping **Kingstonian**. An offside flag denied the division's top scorer John Sands his 23rd of the season but Bury did not have to wait long for one that counted, Warren Whitely opening the scoring in the 11th minute.

K's had Wade Small sent off before half-time for arguing with the referee. They came close to an equaliser midway through the second half when Tom Bird's cross was deflected against the bar but Craig Parker scored the second from the spot a minute later after Matt Pattison brought down Sam Reed.

Only three of the relegation candidates were in action and **Hastings** stayed in 21st place, two points behind Thurrock, after going down 1-0 at home to **Leiston**.

Rhys Henry netted after 58 minutes for Leiston, who have steadily come to grips with Premier football and moved into the top half of the table.

Hastings did their best to respond but Danny Ellis hit a post and visiting keeper Jack Dixon earned his clean sheet with several excellent saves.

The team in real trouble, apart from bottom club Carshalton, would seem to be **Wingate**, who are only five points above Hastings and have played between three and seven more games than their rivals at the bottom.

They, too, went down to a lone goal, at **Bognor** where Terry Dodd was on target in the 27th minute. It was Bognor's first league goal at home since January 5.

Ryman North

FOR the first time this season, **Grays** are favourites for the title after their 4-1 home win over Potters Bar on Saturday lifted them to within six points of long-time leaders **Maldon** with four games in hand.

Jared Small put Grays ahead in the 26th minute and Kenny Beaney added another seven minutes later, only for the Scholars to reply quickly through Lee Close. That was a suitable name, for it stayed close until Danny Bunce made it 3-1 with 20 minutes left. Leon Lalite completed the scoring in the 80th minute.

Grays have taken the maximum 24 points from their last eight games while **Maldon** have managed only 14. They retained the league's only unbeaten home record but let two more points slip in a 1-1 draw with **Romford**, who took an early lead through long-serving skipper Paul Clayton.

Ollie Berquez levelled the scores moments before half-time but the hosts could not build on that goal in the second period and their position at the top now looks highly vulnerable.

Thamesmead might have title ambitions of their own after beating **Sudbury** 1-0 to move to within nine points of Maldon with two games in hand. Lea Dawson's 35th-minute effort, when Lewis Tozer's header came back off a post, was all the hosts needed.

Aveley, in fourth place, lost ground on the sides above them as they crashed 4-1 at **Needham Market**, who have finally found their touch at home. This was their fourth successive win at Bloomfields after they had gone 14 games without one.

Most of the action came in the first 16 minutes as Jemel Fox, Sam Newson and Bradley Barber put the Marketmen 3-0 up before Junior Dadson replied. Barber's free-kick completed the scoring just before the break.

Heybridge stayed in fifth place after their 0-0 draw at **Cheshunt**, providing the merest glimmer of play-off hope for their nearest rivals, though Soham and Witham still have a seven-point gap to overcome. It could have been six, but Cheshunt's Ryan Wade missed a good chance in the last minute.

Soham's game at Tilbury was one of three postponed matches in the division, but **Witham** saw action and made the most of it with a crushing 7-2 win at **Ilford**.

Rob Whitnell's sixth-minute header was soon answered by Dan Jolley, but then came a blitz from Sam Taylor, who netted twice in the last ten minutes of the first half and completed his hat-trick immediately after the restart.

Scott Pethers also found the net during that spell, and Whitnell made it 6-1 midway through the second half. Warren Mfula pulled one back with a penalty before John Watson volleyed the best goal of the game.

That result gave new hope to bottom club Redbridge, whose home game against 20th-placed Ware was another casualty of the wet weather. The Motormen are still two points behind Ilford but now have a second game in hand.

It was all square at **Wroxham**, where Gavin Lemmon's fourth-minute penalty put the hosts ahead and **Chatham** replied a minute before half-time through Austin Gacheru.

The same 1-1 scoreline had been recorded in the Friday night game at **Harlow**, where Danny Brown scored in the sixth minute of added time to wipe out Jack Leachman's 41st-minute effort for **Waltham Forest**.

Ryman South

A MONTH ago **Three Bridges** looked doomed to spend only one year in the division before returning to the Sussex County League.

Since then they have taken 11 points from six games and their 2-0 win at **Tooting** on Saturday left them just one point behind Walton Casuals, though the Surrey club have two games in hand.

Abu Touray was the Bridges hero, scoring two minutes after the start and six minutes before the end as the Terrors suffered their tenth home defeat of the season.

Walton Casuals would have been bottom had they lost at **Whitstable**, but it finished in a 1-1 draw. Casuals, in fact, took the lead through James McShane in the 59th minute but Micheal Everitt headed the equaliser within a minute.

Horsham suddenly find themselves in the danger zone, too, three points above Bridges. Three games in hand offer security of sorts but, as they have yet to win in 2013 and have taken only two points from their last nine outings, they need to find some form quickly.

They were thumped 4-0 at **Ramsgate**, who moved to within a point of the play-off spots. Former Scotland and Manchester United manager Tommy Docherty was among the spectators before speaking at a club function in the evening.

Hornets held out almost until half-time before Ian Pulman rounded the keeper to break the deadlock. James Sherman added another on the hour, announcers' favourite Jon Ibarrondo Eguileor made it 3-0 and Sherman scored again in the last minute.

The only teams in the top five to beat the weather clashed at **Hythe**, and an 82nd-minute header by Craig Cloke gave the home side a vital 1-0 victory over **Dulwich**. Hythe strengthened their grip on fourth place while Dulwich, in second spot, remained six points behind Maidstone and now have only two games in hand.

Worthing retained their slim play-off hopes by coming from 2-0 down to see off visiting **Merstham** 4-2 in the only other game to survive in the division.

Two goals in four minutes, a header from Robert Carter and a shot by Fabio Saraiva, gave the visitors their advantage by the half-hour mark. Jamie Brotherton pulled one back before half-time, Billy Medlock equalised with a 56th-minute penalty and Tom Lawley gave Rebels the lead 15 minutes later. Steve Metcalf made sure with two minutes left.

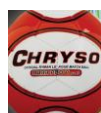

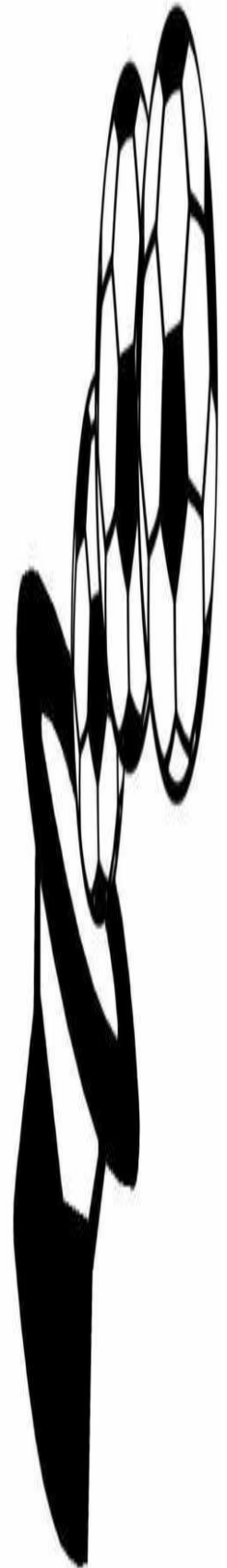
