

### **All the Weekend Action**

#### **Ryman Premier**

A HAT-TRICK by Nathaniel Pinney provided the shock of the programme on Saturday, leading bottom club **Carshalton** to a 4-0 home win over fifth-placed **Margate**.

Pinney joined the Robins in October and scored his first goal at the start of November. Including that strike, he has netted 18 of their last 37 goals.

It was Sean O'Toole who set the ball rolling with a tenth-minute goal, heading home after his first effort had been tipped on to the bar by Margate keeper Craig Holloway.

Pinney doubled the lead with a free-kick in the 32<sup>nd</sup> minute and added a penalty just after the hour before completing his treble as time ran out.

Holloway was sent off for the offence that led to the penalty: not the most auspicious start to his reign as player-manager after he was confirmed in the job this week, partnered by Simon Osborn, after a caretaker spell.

Carshalton are off the bottom, though they remain two points behind 20<sup>th</sup>-placed Lewes and have only four games left, so it will still be an uphill struggle to complete the escape.

**Hastings** went down 1-0 at **Bognor**, Dan Thompson heading home a corner in the 68<sup>th</sup> minute, and drop into last place, two points behind the Robins but with five games in hand.

**Lewes** failed to make the most of a glorious opportunity to chalk up a valuable win at **Hendon**, who were down to nine men after 20 minutes.

Sam Flegg was first to go, in the tenth minute for a 'professional foul', but Karl Beckford fired the resulting penalty against the bar.

Dean Cracknell put Hendon in front with a 15th-minute header but they were soon down to nine when Casey Maclaren was dismissed for violent conduct. They still managed to double their lead through Kevin Maclaren in the 32<sup>nd</sup> minute.

Simon Wormull's penalty reduced the deficit on the stroke of half-time and there seemed little doubt that the visitors would go on to win. A heroic rearguard action kept them at bay until Ben Godfrey equalised in the 86<sup>th</sup> minute and Lewes stay in deep trouble.

So, too, do Wingate after their 3-0 defeat at Leiston. Luke Hammond opened the scoring after 18 minutes when Tom Winter's effort came back off the bar.

Michael Brothers, whose cross set up the first goal, made it 2-0 just before the hour and his header rebounded from the bar for Winter to score his first goal for the club with 13 minutes left.

**Thurrock** eased their fears considerably with their second 1-0 away success in three days. They followed up Thursday's shock win at Lowestoft with a less surprising one at **Cray**, who have now lost 12 at home. As at Lowestoft, Charlie Stimson did the trick for his father and manager Mark, with a 74<sup>th</sup>-minute header.

Cray still look reasonably safe, as do **Harrow** after their 4-2 home win over **Enfield Town**. Saheed Sankoh fired home from long range after six minutes but the in-form Liam Hope putting Enfield on terms in the 24th minute.

Sankoh scored early in the second half as well and Simeon Akinola made it 3-1 in the 71<sup>st</sup> minute. Hope nabbed his second in the 82<sup>nd</sup> minute but Rob Wolleaston quickly responded to make sure of the win. The visitors finished with ten men after a second yellow card for Will Sturgess

At the other end of the table, **Whitehawk** are three games away from clinching the title in their first Premier season after a 3-2 win at **Kingstonian**.

Sami El-Abd headed Hawks in front in the 35<sup>th</sup> minute but Luke Wanadio levelled it from 25 yards before half-time and 18-year-old Daniel Sweeney gave K's the lead from a similar distance just before the hour mark.

It proved to be only a hiccup for the title-chasers, who were level ten minutes later when Joe Keehan headed in a corner and went on to win it when Michael Malcolm rounded keeper Rob Tolfrey with 13 minutes left.

Three wins, then, will see Hawks home unless **Lowestoft** can take maximum points from their last eight games and make up 24 goals as well. Two goals in as many minutes just before half-time, from Rob Eagle and Jack Defty earned them a 2-0 win at **Canvey** and lifted them into third place.

**Wealdstone** stay second but would have wished for more than a 0-0 draw from their visit to **Bury**, a result which means that Hawks will have to drop four points to give Wealdstone any chance of pinching the crown.

It could have been worse for Stones and better for Bury, who are six points adrift of a play-off spot: Craig Parker missed a penalty at the end of the first half.

**Concord**'s title challenge is over after their 3-1 defeat at **East Thurrock** left them in fourth place. Danny Spendlove put the Beachboys ahead in the sixth minute but a Sam Higgins penalty levelled it on 21 minutes and a post prevented Ben Greenhalgh restoring Concord's advantage.

Sam Collins put the hosts 2-1 up before the half-hour and Higgins scored again early in the second half to leave Rocks seven points short of a play-off place with two games in hand. They are already virtually certain to finish as the top club in the borough of Thurrock, which boasts five Ryman League teams, for the first time in their history.

With Canvey and Bury dropping points, **Met Police** were given a boost in their challenge to Margate for that final play-off spot. They are two points behind the Kent club, both having six games left, after Dave Knight's goal ten minutes into the second half gave them a 1-0 home win over **Hampton**.

#### **Ryman North**

THERE was no change at the top on Saturday as the leading five clubs all won. So perhaps the most important result was at **Witham**, where **Soham** were beaten 2-1.

That lifted Witham above their victims into sixth place, just three points behind Aveley who do, however, have two games in hand. Soham's hopes seem to have gone but they have done remarkably well to become play-off candidates after taking longer than any other club to collect their first point of the season.

Scott Pethers missed a penalty for the home side before Daniel Lopes put them ahead on the half-hour and Lewis Godbold headed their second early in the second half. Luke Stanley pulled one back eight minutes from time.

**Grays** moved closer to the title with a 2-0 victory at lowly **Ilford**. Jeff Hammond scored after only six minutes and Kris Newby added his first goal since his move from East Thurrock in the 55<sup>th</sup> minute.

**Maldon**, who have played one more game than the leaders, remained six points behind them with a 1-0 home win over **Needham Market**. James Robinson scored after 25 minutes. If Maldon avoid defeat against Tilbury on Saturday week they will be the only team in the league to remain unbeaten at home all season.

Four minutes before Robinson's strike, Stuart Zanone had nabbed the goal which gave **Thamesmead** their 1-0 home victory over **Tilbury**. Both sides later hit the woodwork. Thamesmead trail Maldon by five points but have a couple of games in hand.

That trio will almost certainly be the top three at the end of the season, leaving Heybridge, Aveley and maybe Witham to fight it out for fourth place.

Luke Callander moved closer to the golden boot with goals after 19 and 83 minutes in **Heybridge**'s 2-0 win at **Sudbury**, taking his haul for the season to 32.

Aveley conceded an early goal to visitors, Joel Palmer hitting the net in the fifth minute. But Jay Leader headed the equaliser on 35 minutes **Waltham Forest** and deadline recruit Karl Blake put Millers 2-1 up with a deflected free-kick three minutes later. That proved to be the end of the scoring.

With only one team going down, Redbridge remain in the hot seat but are now just a point behind llford with two games in hand after their 1-1 draw at Cheshunt.

Lamar Lemonius punished a defensive error to put the Motormen ahead after ten minutes and they stayed in front until 12 minutes from time, when Courtney White equalised.

James Gershfield scored his first goal since November as Potters Bar won 3-1 at Ware. Cole Penny put the Scholars ahead in the second minute and Elliot King equalised soon after the interval.

Gershfield, whose sizzling early-season form earned him an unproductive spell in the Premier with Wingate, ended his drought with 11 minutes left and substitute Gary Wharton made sure of the points.

Michael Clarke, one of three youth-team players signed on senior forms by **Romford** on deadline day, became the second of them to find the net when he scored in the 80<sup>th</sup> minute to clinch their 2-0 home win over **Harlow**. He followed Andre Gumbs, who got a debut goal on Easter Monday.

Lewis Francis had a first-half penalty saved by Harlow keeper James Hassell and it was left to David Ottley to open the scoring five minutes after the break. A post denied Joe O'Donoghue a consolation goal for the visitors.

**Chatham** came from behind to beat visiting **Brentwood** 2-1. Ross Wall put Blues ahead after 14 minutes but Matt Solly and Garry Tilley turned it round soon after half-time.

A late goal by Ayrton Coley gave **Waltham Abbey** a 2-1 home win over **Wroxham**. A Ben Lewis own goal gave the Abbotts an early lead which Matt Daniels wiped out with a 27<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty.

#### Ryman South

IT'S still advantage **Dulwich** in the race for the Ryman South title after their 2-0 victory at third-placed **Faversham** yesterday (Saturday) kept them level on points with leaders Maidstone, and with a crucial game in hand.

Ellis Green put Dulwich ahead after 14 minutes and they maintained the upper hand, although it was not until the last minute that Xavier Vidal clinched the points with a spectacular long-range shot. Faversham's Jamie Maxted was denied a consolation goal by a goalline clearance.

Maidstone eased to a 3-0 win at Three Bridges, halting the Sussex club's run of four victories which had lifted them off the foot of the table.

Danny Lye headed in a long throw from Alex Flisher in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute and Flisher himself made it 2-0 midway through the second half. Ade Olorunda's header in added time extended Stones' goal-difference advantage over Dulwich to eight and that could yet turn out to be vital. Bridges remain in 21<sup>st</sup> place, ahead of Walton Casuals only on goal difference.

Faversham stayed in third place but can now finish no higher. The only team who can, on paper, catch the top two are **Hythe**, 14 points behind them with five games left after their 2-1 home win over **Crawley Down**.

They dominated the first half: Dave Cook put them ahead with his 22<sup>nd</sup> league goal in the 32nd minute and Craig Thompson doubled the lead before half-time.

The Anvils, desperate for points to maintain their play-off hopes, improved after the break but had only a 76<sup>th</sup>-minute goal from Miles Mitchell to show for it.

An Ian Pulman double enabled **Ramsgate** to cling on to fifth place with a 2-0 home win over **Worthing**, killing off the Sussex club's lingering play-off hopes.

Pulman, who has hit top format the right time, took his league tally to 20 with goals in the 55<sup>th</sup> and 72<sup>nd</sup> minutes, much to the relief of Warren Schulz who had missed a first-half penalty.

**Folkestone** stayed sixth, a point behind the Rams, with a 3-1 victory at **Walton Casuals** which kept their hosts pinned to the bottom. Richard Atkins put them ahead on 25 minutes with a deflected shot and also made it 3-0 in the 62nd minute, ten minutes after Phil Stevenson had netted the second with a free-kick.

But the advantage remains with seventh-placed **Leatherhead**, also a point behind Ramsgate and with two games in hand. The Tanners missed a host of chances at **Herne Bay** but the one they took, netted by Tom Bradbrook on the hour, was enough for a 1-0 win.

Horsham did themselves a power of good in the battle to stay up, beating Merstham 1-0 at Gorings Mead to move five points clear of the bottom two. Trevor McCreadle converted a Tony Nwachukwu cross for the decisive goal soon after the break.

**Chipstead** also eased their fears with a lone-goal home win. They beat **Sittingbourne** with a 56th minute goal from Kyle Green and that surely ended the Brickies' play-off bid. Chips had to survive the last few minutes with full-back Dan Dean between the posts after Mu Maan was injured.

**Tooting** and **Walton & Hersham**, two other teams in the relegation mix, shared the points with a 1-1 draw. Ty Berry put the Terrors in front after seven minutes and they held it until the last kick of the game, when James Awofisan rescued the visitors.

**Corinthian-Casuals** also picked up a handy point from a goalless and uneventful draw at **Eastbourne Town**. Casuals' Jamie Byatt looked the man most likely to break the deadlock.

**Burgess Hill** were 2-0 home winners over **Whitstable**. Max Miller gave them a half-time lead and Ryan Thomson added a late second. Darren Budd missed a penalty for Hillians in added time.


