Ryman Premier

TEN-MAN **Whitehawk** edged closer to capturing the Ryman Premier title at the first attempt as they held on for a 2-2 home draw with **Bury** on Saturday.

Bury, needing points to stay in the play-off hunt, took a third-minute lead through the division's top scorer John Sands, whose 25th league goal of the season gave him a lead of four in the race for the golden boot.

Danny Mills levelled matters after 14 minutes and when Charlie Henry put Hawks ahead seven minutes before half-time they looked well on course.

A straight red card for Sam Gargan midway through the second half changed the picture and the table-toppers were hanging on after Russell Short's 83rd-minute equaliser.

One point turned out to be a handy return, though, as main rivals **Lowestoft** collapsed to a 3-2 home defeat by bottom club **Carshalton**, still battling hard to stay in the division.

The Trawlerboys must have fancied a gentle afternoon's cruise after Lee Smith opened the scoring in the first minute. But they soon discovered it would be nothing of the sort: James Ashton made it 1-1 before the clock had ticked round to the 90-second mark.

The visitors hit the woodwork before Luke Pigden's 35-yard free-kick gave them a half-time lead. Jack Defty was denied an equaliser by a post and the Robins stretched their lead in the 52nd minute through Nathaniel Pinney, another superb long-range strike.

Smith's penalty reduced the deficit with 17 minutes left but Carshalton held out to maintain their survival hopes. They remain on the bottom, though, and will probably need to win two of their last three games to have a chance.

Lowestoft, meanwhile, forfeited second place to **Wealdstone**, who chalked up a 2-0 home win over relegation-threatened **Cray**.

Scott McGleish put them ahead after six minutes and Cray wasted a chance to hit back when Rikki Banks saved Leigh Bremner's weak penalty. Chris Moore gave Stones some breathing space in the 69th minute.

So Whitehawk, who have two games left, lead Wealdstone by ten points and Lowestoft by 13. Stones have four to play, the Trawlerboys six.

At the moment Hawks need to win both games to be sure of the title but they do not play again until next Sunday, when they make the long trip to Leiston, and could even be champions before they set off.

Wealdstone must take at least four points from away games at Hampton on Thursday and Carshalton on Saturday to stay alive, while Lowestoft also need four points from their three away matches at Bury, Thurrock and Bognor to stay in the hunt.

Both clubs are virtually certain of a play-off place and **Concord**'s six-point cushion should be enough to ensure that they make it as well, though their 2-1 home defeat by **Harrow** will keep them on edge.

The League Cup winners fell behind to Paul Olima's early goal and, after Nicky Cowley's 56th-minute reply, Harrow regained the lead three minutes later through Shaun Lucien and held out to give their survival hopes a huge lift.

The final play-off spot is wide open, however, after **Margate**'s miserable run continued with a 2-1 home defeat by **Met Police**. Kezie Ibe gave Margate a 25th-minute lead against the run of play but Billy Crook squared it from 25 yards ten minutes before the interval and set up the winner for Dave Knight soon after the change of ends.

So Margate are down to seventh and out of a play-off place which, having played more games than all their rivals, they may never regain. The Police take over fifth spot but they are looking over their shoulders at **East Thurrock**, a point behind them with a game in hand after their 3-0 victory at **Hampton**.

Rocks, 14th at the start of March, have been unbeaten in 11 games since then, winning eight of them. Sam Collins struck twice in three minutes around the half-hour mark to put them in charge and they clinched it seven minutes after half-time, when keeper Rodney Chiweshe fumbled the ball into his own net.

Canvey stayed in the picture with a 2-0 victory at **Enfield Town**. Bradley Woods-Garness put them ahead after 20 minutes, his 21st league goal, and Ashley Miller made sure with 17 minutes left. Woods-Garness could have added another, but blasted a penalty over the bar.

The Islanders are two points behind the Met, having played the same number of games, with Bury a point further back.

It's tight at the bottom, with seven points covering the bottom eight, and the situation is even more muddled by the variation in games played: **Hastings**, who occupy 21st place, have six matches left while several of their rivals have only three to go.

The Sussex club stayed in the drop zone with a 2-1 home defeat by **Hendon**, despite taking the lead eight minutes before half-time through Sam Adams.

Carl McCluskey equalised 12 minutes into the second half and Hastings were then betrayed by their own goalposts, which kept out shots from Lee Carey and Danny Ellis for the home side but then teed the ball up nicely for Casey Maclaren's late winner when a Junior Lewis header rebounded.

Lewes are just a point ahead of Hastings after their 1-0 home defeat by **Leiston** and have played three games more. Gareth Heath scored direct from a corner with 13 minutes left.

Cray are a point above Lewes and, although they have four games left, three of them are at home. That is hardly an advantage: they have won only twice at Hayes Lane and lost 12.

A point further ahead are **Wingate**, who eased their fears with a 3-0 home victory over **Kingstonian**. Spencer McCall curled in the 15th-minute opener and Matt Pattison hit a post for K's before Leon Smith's penalty doubled the lead soon after half-time. Wade Small became the second visitor to hit the woodwork before John Christian's late strike wrapped it up.

Thurrock also lost at home and are not out of trouble yet although they, like Harrow, have five to play. Ahead after 18 minutes through Ben Smith, Thurrock went down 2-1 to **Bognor**, who equalised through Sam Pearce in the 69th minute and won it with a late header by Dan Thompson.

Ryman North

THE first team to clinch a title this season are **Grays**, who were crowned Ryman North champions with a 2-0 home win over nearest rivals **Maldon** on Saturday.

It was their 16th successive victory, equalling the longest known run in the league's 108-year history, and it completed a remarkable turnaround. Maldon, who themselves had a 14-match winning run earlier in the season, led the table by 15 points at Christmas when they were still unbeaten.

Craig Pope's close-range header put Grays ahead after 25 minutes but their nerves remained ragged until ten minutes from time, when Jack Cawley deflected Jared Small's cross into his own net to start the promotion party.

Maldon find themselves down to third place, behind **Thamesmead** who romped to a 5-0 victory at **Needham Market**. Stuart Zanone put them ahead after 10 minutes and such was their dominance that it was a surprise that the next goal did not come until the 65th minute when Chris Edwards netted.

Rob Carter made it three and Zanone scored twice in the last eight minutes, completing his hat-trick with a penalty.

Both Thamesmead and Maldon are safely in the play-offs, and only four teams are left in contention for the other two places.

Aveley and **Heybridge**, fourth and fifth, drew 1-1 at Heybridge. Ben Newson put Swifts ahead immediately after half-time but they then had Michael Cheek sent off and Jordan Cox equalised just before the hour, his 25th league goal.

With five games left, Millers look sure to claim the third play-off place but Heybridge, a point behind them having played two games more, are under pressure from **Witham**, three points behind them with a game in hand, though with a vastly inferior goal difference.

A Rob Whitnell double earned Witham their 2-1 victory at **Waltham Forest**, who took an early lead through Manu Dagher. Whitnell headed the equaliser soon after half-time and nabbed the winner on the hour, his 20th league goal.

The only other possible contenders now are **Soham**, but they are six points behind Heybridge with three to play after going down 3-1 at home to lowly **Ware**.

Leon Simpson put the visitors ahead on 25 minutes but Robbie Mason's 25th of the season squared it again six minutes later. Matt Gill restored Ware's lead midway through the second half and Simpson struck again to make sure.

The victory ensured that Ware stay up and, with only three clubs now in any danger of relegation, 12 of the clubs in the division have nothing but pride to play for in the last fortnight.

Harlow's chances of going down are merely mathematical, though they need two more points to be officially safe. They salvaged a 2-2 home draw with **Cheshunt** after being outplayed for much of the game.

Corey Whitely and Tony Burke scored in the first ten minutes of the second half to give the visitors a well-deserved 2-0 lead but substitute Luke Eatwell pulled one back in the 74th minute and Christian Wheeler headed the late equaliser.

Ilford went down 2-0 at **Wroxham** to stay at the foot of the table. Josh Carus scored after seven minutes, taking Ilford's goals-against tally into three figures, and Ben Thompson added the second in the 20th minute.

Redbridge remained two points ahead of their local rivals with a game in hand after an Austin Gachero hat-trick condemned them to a 3-1 home defeat by **Chatham**.

Gachero opened the scoring after 12 minutes, when it was Redbridge's turn to concede their 100th goal, and struck again in the 25th and 57th minutes.

Redbridge's sole reply came nine minutes before the interval from Jacob Cleaver. He now has 17 goals and if he is the next man to score for the Motormen he will have exactly half their league total.

Tilbury's remote play-off chances were ended by a 2-0 home defeat at the hands of **Waltham Abbey**. James Peagram scored 11 minutes after the start, Ayrton Coley 11 minutes before the end.

Romford twice came from behind to draw 2-2 at **Potters Bar**. Gary Wharton's 20th-minute opener was quickly answered by Lewis Francis. Josh Hutchinson restored the Scholars' advantage on 53 minutes but they had Cole Penny sent off and James Ishmail squared it midway through the half.

Brentwood's home game with **Sudbury** looked set to finish goalless when Steve Butterworth missed an 81st-minute penalty for the hosts. But Butterworth made amends with the only goal of the game four minutes from time. Sudbury, for whom Lee Townrow hit the bar in the first half, had Sam Clarke sent off in the 74th minute.

Ryman South

A CROWD of more than 2,000 turned up at **Maidstone** to see the Ryman South leaders take on play-off contenders **Faversham** – and they watched Stones' title hopes suffer a potentially fatal blow as they slumped to a 2-1 defeat.

Stones dominated without managing to break through and were stunned when Luke Harvey gave the visitors a 67th-minute lead. Matt Bourne's own goal squared it with 11 minutes left, only for Danny Hockton to grab Faversham's winner in the 88th minute.

Pole position now belongs to **Dulwich**, who crushed bottom club **Walton Casuals** 5-0 at Champion Hill to go three points clear with a game in hand.

Shaking off the disappointment of Tuesday's League Cup final defeat, Dulwich went ahead through Ellis Green in the 19th minute and doubled it four minutes later with an Erhan Oztumer penalty. Conor French netted twice in ten minutes midway through the second half and Oztumer wrapped it up with his 20th goal of the season.

Beaten in the last two play-off finals, Dulwich are now well placed to gain automatic promotion this time. For Casuals, the outlook is less rosy.

Third-placed **Hythe** are close to booking a play-off spot after their 2-1 win at **Whitstable**. Two points from three games will clinch their post-season place.

Dave Cook put them ahead with a 13th-minute penalty but missed another spot-kick four minutes later, allowing Micheal Everitt to level the scores just before half-time. Cook had the last word with his 24th league goal ten minutes from time.

Faversham's victory lifted them one place to fourth and they should make sure of their play-off place as well. They are three points ahead of **Ramsgate** and have a game in hand.

Ramsgate, who have only two matches left, were held to a 1-1 draw at **Crawley Down**. Gabriel Odunaike put the hosts ahead on the hour and Warren Schulz replied five minutes later.

Folkestone moved to within a point of Ramsgate, also with only two games left, thanks to a 2-1 home win over **Horsham**. Johan Ter Horst, 18, continued his impressive start to his senior career with a lovely lob to open the scoring on 26 minutes and Richard Atkins added the second shortly before the break. Charlie Farmer replied with 11 minutes to go.

Leatherhead are still well placed to reach the play-offs, five points behind Ramsgate with three games in hand, but made their task more difficult by going down 1-0 at home to **Burgess Hill**. Max Miller scored the decisive goal after 19 minutes.

Joe Taylor's 57th-minute drive earned **Sittingbourne** a 1-0 home win over **Eastbourne** to keep their slight play-off chances alive. The visitors had Matt Crabb sent off near the end.

Three Bridges continued their amazing escape act with a 1-0 victory at **Merstham**. Elliott Romain netted with 11 minutes left.

Bridges were ten points adrift at the bottom in mid-February, having taken just 17 points from 29 games. They have since taken 23 points from 11 games, including six wins in their last seven, and are up to 19th, six points off the bottom.

Walton & Hersham moved up to 20th, above Horsham, in another game decided by a single goal. James Awofisan scored in the 78th minute to see off visitors **Chipstead** and ease Swans' relegation fears.

Seven teams, from 15th to 21st, are covered by two points but Walton Casuals, five points adrift with only three games to play, will have to do something special to cause concern to any of them, especially as their next fixture is at home to Maidstone. They have won only once on home territory.

The top two in that seven-team group are **Corinthian-Casuals** and **Tooting**, who slogged out a goalless draw at Tolworth to inch closer to safety.

Herne Bay need one point from five matches to be mathematically safe after their 2-2 draw at **Worthing**. All the goals came in the first half, with strikes by James Turner and Byron Walker for the visitors bookending Tom Lawley's goal and Scott Kirkwood's penalty. Worthing's Steve Metcalf hit a post late in the game.

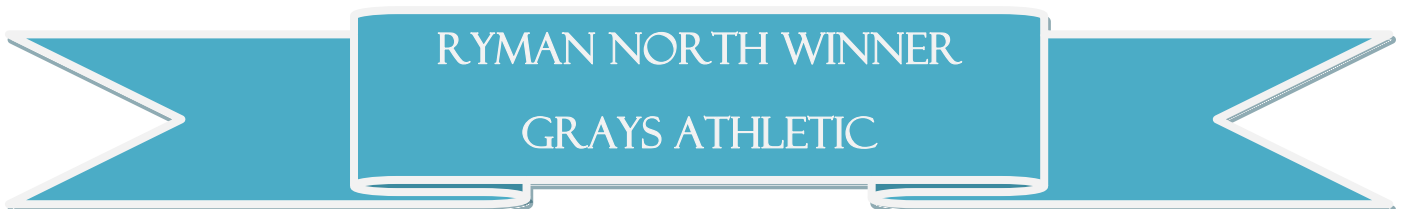

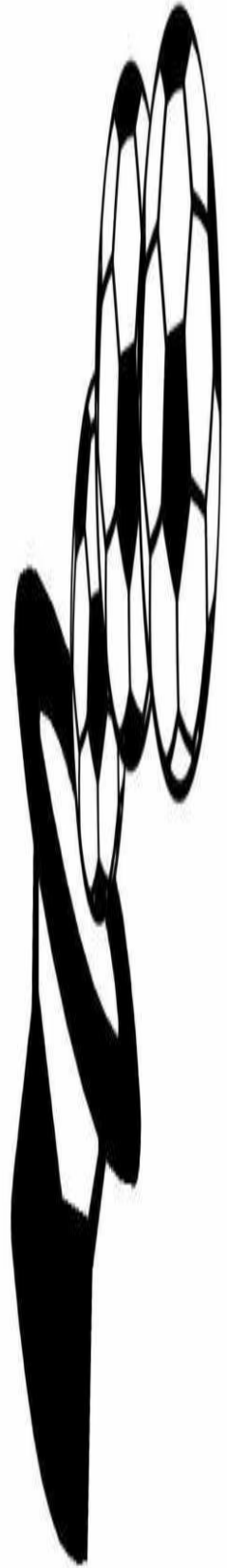
