Had we not decided to seek our "Soccer Adventure" elsewhere at the end of last season, tonight's game, by tradition, would have been the first match of the season. For that reason, we are particularly happy to welcome the representatives—Officers, Players and Friends—of the clubs competing in The Isthmian League.

This is the third successive season that we have been proud to stage this fixture. On August 24th, 1963, as Isthmian League Champions for season 1962-63, we accepted the combined challenge of the other clubs and the result was a draw of three goals each. And on August 18th, 1962, as the final leaders for season 1961-62, the same fixture resulted in a 3—1 win for the league combination.

Our last HOME League game was versus Deal Town. On that occasion the official attendance was 3,500. This was easily the highest "gate" of either division of our league.
