# Welcome to ...

A merger of the town's Printing Works and Night School football teams took place in 1897 and thus Aylesbury 'United' was formed. Nicknamed 'The Ducks' from the world renown Aylesbury Duck, they joined the Spartan League in 1908 having earlier served in the Bucks Contiguous and South Eastern Leagues. In the first year they won the Western Division title and beat Luton Clarence to lift the Spartan Championship outright.

In 1913-14 Aylesbury lifted the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup, then after the First World War when the Spartan League was extended they won the Division One West title in 1928-29.

Relegation followed in 1933 although a return was made in 1935 by finishing second to Jurgens Purfleet. The 'Ducks' dropped down again in 1938 but bounced back a year later as Division One Champions.

They became founder members of the Delphian League in 1951 and earned national fame by reaching the F.A. Cup First Round Proper. Infact Aylesbury went into the history books as being the only Delphian side ever to reach the First Round Proper. Finishing Runners-up in 1952-53, they went one better twelve months later to win the League Championship.

The Delphian League merged in 1963 with the Corinthian and Athenian Leagues and Aylesbury remained for thirteen years, during which time there Division Two Runners-Up in 1967-68. In 1976 a decision was made to turn Semi-Professional and United were elected to the Southern League Division One South. They were Runners-Up in 1979-80 and a year later an exciting run in the F.A. Trophy took them to the Quarter Finals.

In 1983 Trevor Gould (brother of Bobby) was appointed Manager and in his second year the Club gained promotion to the Southern League Premier Division. However, their Turnfurlong Ground was sold for re-development and they spent a season playing 'home' games at nearby Tring Town and RAF Halton. A worthy eighth placing in the league was capped by winning the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup for only the second time in their history.

Aylesbury gained promotion to the G.M. Vauxhall Conference by winning the Beazer Homes (Southern) League Premier Division title in 1987-88 on goal difference from Dartford, and in the June of 1988 they entertained the full England team in a unique friendly. The new ground's record crowd of 6,031 packed in to see the National side play Non-League opposition for the one and only time.

The step-up into the Conference proved too great and United were relegated after just one season. They joined the Isthmian League Premier Division for 1989-90 and a successful campaign saw them gain their first victory over League opposition when they beat Division Four leaders Southend United in the F.A. Cup 1-0 at Buckingham Road. A year later they became the first Non-League side to feature in a 90 minute live broadcast when their F.A. Cup-tie at home to Walsall was shown throughout Europe on BSkyB.

In 1992 Trevor Gould moved on to a coaching position at Coventry City and the following two seasons fell short of success previously enjoyed by their large support. In the summer of 1994 Steve Ketteridge, a member of the Cup side which defeated Southend, was appointed Manager and optimism returned. Season 1994-95 saw United have one of the best home records in the Division and they eventually finished in fourth place.

But it was in Cup competition where they made the headlines last season. In the F.A. Cup (sponsored by Littlewoods Pools) United fought their way from the First Qualifying Round to the Third Round Proper before going down 0-4 to Premiership Queens Park Rangers at Loftus Road. Their impromptu 'Cup Duck Walk' to celebrate a goal at Kingstonian in the Second Round was shown throughout the world.

To complete a memorable 1994-95 season Aylesbury United lifted the Diadora (Isthmian) League Cup. In a tense and hardfought Final at Marlow FC, the 'Ducks' beat rivals Slough Town 7-6 on penalties after the sides had finished 1-1 at the end of extra time.

#### Introducing the men from Buckingham Road ...

Steve Ketteridge: Last season's success was just reward for the enthusiastic Manager in his first year in charge. Appointed in the summer of 1994 following a spell as Coach, Assistant and Manager of St. Albans City. In a long 'midfielder' career he played for Derby County, Wimbledon, Crystal Palace, Leyton Orient, Cardiff City, Barnet, St. Albans and Aylesbury United. Allan Pluckrose: Returned as Player-Coach during last summer, first joined Aylesbury as a player in 1989 with Steve Ketteridge. Combined Services International, has also played for Torquay United, Slough Town, St Albans City, and a spell in German football. Equally effective in defence or midfield.

Goalkeepers: Capped by England at Semi-Professional level, Gary Phillips signed this summer from Barnet. Made over 300 League appearances for Brentford, Reading, Hereford United and Barnet for whom he also served as Manager and Coach. Was their number one when they lifted the G.M. Vauxhall Conference title in 1991. Jon Franklin is a High Wycombe based Fireman who made his Club debut last season. Has played locally for Stocklake, Beaconsfield United and Bucks Fire Service, he was also loaned to Wealdstone during part of last term.

Defenders: Matt Hayward signed summer 1993 having helped Thame United to promotion from the DFL Division Three. Previously won two successive South Midland League titles with both Thame and Pitstone & Ivinghoe. Michael Danzey featured for Aylesbury and Cambridge United last season. Was previously a striker for St. Albans City having began his career as an apprentice then professional with Nottingham Forest. Lennie Brayshaw signed summer 1994 after spells with Hungerford Town, and Lancaster City in the Northern Premier League. A combined Services International. Kristian Sorensen returned this summer after a couple of years at university. Made his senior debut for Aylesbury in 1992 having captained the youth team. His grandad John (in the 1940's) and Uncle Mick (1970's) both played for Sutton United. Gary Simpson signed this summer on loan from Luton Town where he rose from apprentice to professional and has played over 50 reserve games. Steve Shea signed this summer after a spell with Rushden. Former Everton apprentice, has also played for Feyenoord, St Albans, Chesham, Hendon, Hitchin, Staines and Harrow.

Midfielders: Paul Hobbs signed summer 1994 and scored some important goals in last season's success. Previously played for Berkhamsted, Stevenage Borough and Hemel Hempstead. Steve Herd signed December 1993 from Rushden Town. Has had spells with Danish First Division club Silkeborge, and Aldershot when they were in the Football League. Gary Cobb signed March 1995 from Chesham United and can also play at full-back. Former professional with Luton Town, Fulham, and loan spells at Northampton Town and Swansea. Naseem Bashir signed November 1993 from Chesham United where he won a DFL Premier Championship medal. Began his career at Reading before going Non-League with Slough Town and Chalfont St. Peter. Gary Smith signed this summer from Barnet. He began his career with Fulham before spending a time at Colchester United. Went Non-League and has since played for Enfield, Wycombe and Welling United.

Forwards: Cliff Hercules made his senior debut in September 1984 after signing from local side Oving. Has gone on to become the Club's all-time record goal and appearance holder. Represented the F.A. XI and Isthmian League, he passed 500 games and 250 goals last year. Dean Williams signed October 1994 after short periods with Doncaster Rovers, Stevenage Borough and Brentford. By the end of last season he scored 29 goals in 30 (full) + 7 (sub) appearances for Aylesbury. First made his debut for Cambridge United as a 16-year old before spells at St. Albans City, Hemel Hempstead, Chesham United and Wokingham Town. John Caesar signed this summer from neighbours Marlow. Made his debut for them in 1989 and scored nearly 100 goals in less than 300 games after joining from nearby Flackwell Heath. Gained national attention by scoring Marlow's winner against Oxford United in last season's F.A. Cup. Wayne Jones is a former Aylesbury United youth team player who graduated to the first team and made his senior debut against Carshalton Athletic in August 1992.
