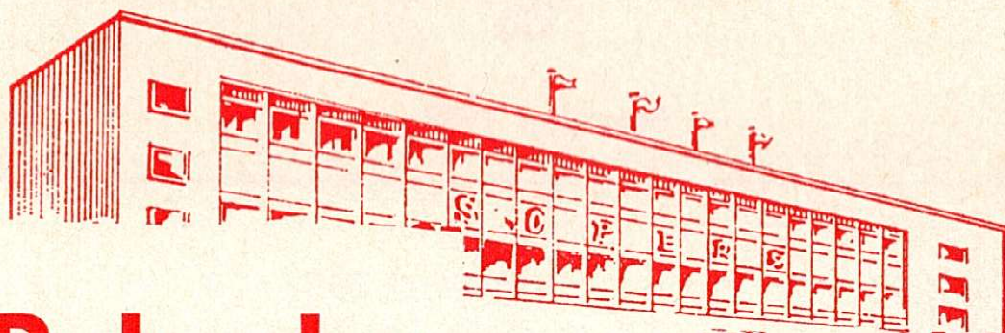

ROTHMAN'S ISTHMIAN LEAGUE CHALLENGE CUP FINAL BARKING v HENDON

Thursday 19th May, 1977. K.O. 7.30 p.m.

Good evening ladies and gentlemen and Welcome to Earlsmead Stadium! We bid a very special welcome to the players, officials and supporters of both Barking F.C. and Hendon F.C., who are competing in the final of the Rothman's Isthmian League Challenge Cup. We hope they enjoy their stay and look forward to a sporting, competitive and entertaining match, played in the true traditions of the Isthmian League. We also offer a warm welcome to the Officers of the League who are in attendance this evening.

We at Harrow Borough are proud to be offered the chance of staging this important Cup Final, one vital step in our steady progression into the top flight of senior non-league football, where acceptance by our fellow clubs is a necessary ingredient.

This is only the third season of the League Cup (formerly known as the League Subsidiary Cup), and the first time for which entry has been compulsory for all member clubs, from both divisions. The previous finalists were:—

Next season the format will again alter with the introduction of the third division.

A SEASONAL REVIEW

So we come to the end of another season. A season of immense change and much satisfaction. Enfield are the League Champions, for the second successive season, whilst Wycombe Wanderers finish as runners-up. Strangely enough the top three positions in Division 1 are exactly the same as for the previous season, with Dagenham occupying the third spot. Our congratulations must go to Tilbury who made such a big impression during their first season in that Division.

On the sad side two famous old clubs, Ilford (League members since 1905) and Dulwich Hamlet (League members since 1907) make the drop to Division 2 and will be travelling to Earlsmead next season. It is interesting to note that seven of the League's oldest clubs will have made the drop since the inception of the second division. They are:— Corinthian Casuals, Clapton, Ilford, Dulwich Hamlet, Oxford City, Bromley and St. Albans City.

Boreham Wood and Carshalton Athletic have gained deserved promotion from Division 2 after some tremendous performances during the past season. Our congratulations go to them and especially to our old friend, and Boreham Wood chairman, Bill O'Neill, whose club gained a record 103 points this season. Carshalton will gain promotion this season having actually obtained less points than during the previous season when they achieved third position. (87 as against 90). Ware and Finchley must apply for re-election.
